

LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn emerged victorious in a wacky game on Thursday night over the BlueClaws, 6-4...All four of the Cyclones' runs came in the seventh frame or later...**Gilbert Gómez's** crew utilized a four-run seventh inning to seize the lead, all without the benefit of a single base hit...The four runs scored were Brooklyn's highest total output in a single frame this season, and the most since they put up three in Game 2 of last Saturday's doubleheader against Asheville... Oddly enough, the crooked number came after Brooklyn was held without a run for 21 straight innings...RHP **Noah Hall** hurled his best outing of the season, tossing five innings with only one run surrendered...Jersey Shore proceeded to the the game in the home seventh, but 2B **Wilfredo Lara** and 1B **Ryan Clifford** each came through with RBI singles to hand Brooklyn a 6-4 lead it would never relinquish.

WOODEN AIR CONDITIONER: Cyclones pitchers have created a ton of additional breeze via strikeouts in 2024...Entering play on Friday, Brooklyn has registered 133 strikeouts in 1011 innings, which is tied with Winston-Salem for the most in the South Atlantic League...Not only have the Cyclones racked up the punchouts, they have limited walks, too...Brooklyn enters the day tied for the third-fewest free passes (43) in the circuit...As a team, the 'Clones have a 31.1% strikeout rate and a 10.0% walk rate.

FELIP-IN' AMAZIN': LHP **Felipe De La Cruz** has tossed 8.1 shutout innings to start the 2024 season for the Cyclones...The 8.1 frames are the most by a New York Mets farmhand this year without allowing a run...The 22-year-old has permitted just four hits and two walks while striking out six...Since making his South Atlantic League debut last August 23, De La Cruz is 2-1 with a 1.78 ERA (5 ER in 25.1 IP) with seven walks and 23 punchouts...Since his Brooklyn debut, the southpaw leads in second the circuit in WHIP (0.87), ERA (1.78), and batting average against (170), and fifth in innings pitched (25.1).

CLIFF NOTES: IB/OF **Ryan Clifford** enters Friday's matchup on a personal and team season-high five-game hitting streak and nine-game on-base streak...Over the five-game hit streak since Saturday's doubleheader, the 20-year-old is 5-for-21 (.238) with two doubles, two RBI, and two walks...His on-base streak stretches since April 9...During that span, Clifford is 7-for-31 (.226) with four extra-base hits — including a home run — three RBI, and five walks.

LONG ARM OF THE LAW: RHP **Justin Lawson** has been resplendent for the Cyclones out of the bullpen to start his professional career...The Mets' 15th-round pick in 2023 did not pitch after the draft but has tossed five shutout frames since debuting on April 9 vs. Asheville...The 23-year-old tossed three spotless frames for the save in his maiden appearance and needed just eight pitches for another save on Thursday...Lawson has thrown 73.7% (42/57) of his pitches for strikes and holds a 41.2% strikeout rate and a 5.9% walk rate.

GRAB SOME PINE: RHPs **Calvin Ziegler**, **Jordany Ventura**, **Sean Reid-Foley**, **Justin Lawson**, and **Ben Simon** united to punch out 18 Asheville batters in Sunday's walk-off victory...RHPs **Calvin Ziegler**, **Josh Hejka**, **Dakota Hawkins**, and **Joshua Corneilly** also combined to strike out 18 Wilmington hitters over 9.2 innings in April 7's loss at Wilmington...The 18 strikeouts by Cyclones pitching are the most for the franchise in a single game since July 23, 2016, vs. Aberdeen...RHP Justin Dunn (5), LHP **Kyle Regnault** (2), and RHP **Nabil Crismatt** (11) combined to whiff 18 IronBirds over 9.0 innings in a 7-2 win...The multiple contests with 18+ strikeouts are tied for the most by a Cyclones team since 2005...Brooklyn also accomplished the feat in a pair of extra-inning games in 2016 and in two nine-inning games in 2008...The single-game franchise mark for team strikeouts is 22 set in a 20-inning, 3-2 loss vs. Staten Island on June 17, 2016.

HAVE A DAY, KIDI: INF **Nick Lorusso** enjoyed his best day as a Cyclone in Sunday's series finale against Asheville...The 2023 9th-round selection by the Mets belted a game-tying solo home run in the third and then followed suit with a walk-off blast with Brooklyn down to its final out in the ninth...The walk-off home run was the first for the Cyclones since C **Hayden Senger** clubbed a game-ending three-run home run in the bottom of the 12th in Brooklyn's 6-5 win over Hudson Valley on May 23, 2021...Lorusso also sandwiched a double between his two home runs, setting a new career high with three base hits.

DE RECORD SETTER: OF **Omar De Los Santos** stole another base in Sunday's series finale and is 8-for-8 to start the season...The eight swipes are tied for second in the South Atlantic League and tied for seventh among non-Triple-A players...Entering Friday, De Los Santos is second on the Cyclones' all-time stolen base list (45)...He is three steals shy of matching UTL vs. JERSEY SHORE: Brooklyn will play their first full six-game road series of 2024 against the Phillies' High-A affiliate...Jersey Shore possess six of Philadelphia's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: OF Justin Crawford (4), SS Bryan Rincon (9), INF William Bergolla (12), OF Emaarion Boyd (17), OF Hendry Mendez (23), and LHP Samuel Aldegheri (24)...Last season, the BlueClaws won the season series against the Cyclones, 15-11, including a 11-6 record at ShoreTown Ballpark...Brooklyn leads the alltime series since 2021, 47-39 (.547).

Jaylen Palmer's (48) all-time record...Since the start of 2022, De Los Santos is seventh across the Minors for swipes (115)...He broke INF **Walter Rasquin**'s (32) franchise single-season stolen base record (37) in 2023.

KING STANLEY: OF **Stanley Consuegra** powered his first extra-base hit and home run, as well as earning his first RBIs of 2024 in Game 1 on Saturday... The 23-year-old is Brooklyn's all-time leader in all three categories with 43 extra-base hits, 29 home runs, and 94 RBI...On the final day of the 2023 regular season, he broke a tie with C **Francisco Álvarez** for Brooklyn's single-season home run record (23)...Consuegra also surpassed Álvarez (25) for the franchise record in career home runs on August 23 at Asheville...The Dominican native also broke the franchise's single-season record for extra-base hits (42) and tied the mark for RBI (63) set by **Ronny Mauricio** in 2021.

HOME OPENER: The Brooklyn Cyclones opened up their 66-game home schedule on Tuesday evening vs. Asheville with a 3-0 win...The shutout marked the first for Brooklyn in a home opener since a 3-0 victory in 11 years...The Cyclones last blanked an opponent in their home debut on June 20, 2013, vs. Aberdeen...RHP **John Gant** (5.0 IP), RHP **Tim Peterson** (2.2), and LHP **John Mincone** (11) combined for the win...The 'Clones are now 17-5 all-time in their first home game of the season.

YOUTH IS SERVED: Gilbert Gómez takes over as manager of the Brooklyn Cyclones in 2024...At 32 years of age, the Santo Domingo, DR. native is the youngest skipper in franchise history...After leading Single-A St. Lucie last summer, Gómez served as manager of Tigres del Licey in the Dominican Winter League (LIDOM)...Became the youngest manager to win a championship in LIDOM history and the second-youngest manager to win a championship in Series history...Gómez's younger brother, **Dariel**, played at Double-A Binghamton in the Mets' organization last summer and is currently with the Charleston Dirty Birds of the MLB Partner Atlantic League...Older brother, **José**, is a scout for the Tampa Bay Rays and general manager for LIDOM's Leones del Escogido...Older brother, **Héctor**, is a well-known baseball reporter...Gómez also played seven years in New York's farm system, posting a .662 OPS in 537 games.

FAMILIAR FACES: Out of the 30 players on the Cyclones' preliminary roster, 16 of them have previous experience playing on Coney Island...Jeffrey Colón, Joshua Cornielly, Felipe De La Cruz, Jordan Geber, Josh Hejka, Joey Lancellotti, and Jordany Ventura return to the bump, while Drake Osborn and Christian Pregent are holdovers behind the dish...Ryan Clifford, Mateo Gil, William Lugo, D'Andre Smith, and Junior Tilien are back in the infield, as Stanley Consuegra and Omar De Los Santos are set to roam the outfield.

GENIUNE DRAFT: Seven members of last summer's New York Mets' draft class will open the 2024 season with the Cyclones...Pregent returns to the roster, while second-round selection RHP **Brandon Sproat** and third-round pick. two-way player **Nolan McLean** are scheduled to make their High-A debuts... RHP **Noah Hall** (7th), INF **Nick Lorusso** (9th), RHP **Ben Simon** (13th), and RHP **Justin Lawson** (15th) round out the group...RHP **Dakota Hawkins**, who signed as an undrafted free agent, will also start the season in Brooklyn.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline...The 'Clones have four of the Top 30 per BA: **Ryan Clifford** (No. 5), **Brandon Sproat** (11), **Nolan McLean** (15), and **Calvin Ziegler** (29)...Plus five of the Top 30 per MLB: Clifford (4), Sproat (13), McLean (19), Ziegler (22), and INF **Wilfredo Lara** (23)... MLB Pipeline also considers Clifford the 93rd-best farmhand in all of baseball.

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor into the decision in Game 1 of last Saturday's doubleheader vs. Asheville...Did not allow a run on three hits over a season-high 4.1 innings...Walked one and struck out a season-best four...Called for a balk...Tossed 67 pitches and 46 strikes (68.7%)...Relieved by RHP **Dakota Hawkins** with the bases empty and one out in the top of the fifth and Brooklyn leading, 6-0...Cyclones went on to win the contest, 6-2...Brooklyn ultimately swept the doubleheader with a 3-1 win in Game 2.

FELIP-IN' AMAZIN': The southpaw has tossed 8.1 shutout innings to start the 2024 season for the Cyclones...The 8.1 frames are the most by a New York Mets farmhand this year without allowing a run...The 22-year-old has permitted just four hits and two walks, while striking out six...Since making his South Atlantic League debut last August 23, De La Cruz is 2-1 with a 1.78 ERA (5 ER in 25.1 IP) with seven walks and 23 punch outs...Since his Brooklyn debut, the southpaw is in second the circuit in WHIP (0.87), ERA (1.78), and batting average against (.170), and fifth in innings pitched (25.1).

PROSPECT RADAR: After a stellar 2023 season, De La Cruz was deemed the New York Mets' No. 39 prospect entering the 2024 campaign by *Baseball America*.

WELCOME TO BROOKLYN: The 22-year-old joined the Cyclones from Single-A St. Lucie last year on August 22 and thrived over three starts...De La Cruz accumulated a 2-1 record with a 2.45 ERA (5 ER in 17.0 IP) with five walks and 17 strikeouts...The southpaw hurled quality starts in two of his three starts, including going all 6.0 innings in the lid-lifter of a doubleheader on August 31 at Greenville...After allowing a leadoff home run, De La Cruz retired 18 of the final 19 batters he faced, including sitting the last 11 down in order...The southpaw was credited with a complete game, the first for a Brooklyn pitcher since RHP **José Butto** accomplished the feat, tossing 6.0 innings in a 7-inning loss at Aberdeen in Game 1 of a twinbill on June 30, 2021...After making his SAL debut on August 23 at Asheville, De La Cruz ranked third in the circuit in WHIP (0.94), fifth in batting average against (.183), and sixth in ERA (2.65).

FELIPE FINISHES WITH A FLOURISH: De La Cruz racked up the strikeouts in bunches over his final month at Single-A...Over his final 8 appearances (7 starts), De La Cruz paced the Florida State League and all Single-A players in strikeouts (57)...Struck out 8 more batters than Clearwater's LHP **Danny Wilkinson** (49) who was second...De La Cruz went 1-2 with a 4.33 ERA (17 ER in 35.1 IP) with 18 walks (11.4 BB%) and 57 strikeouts (36.1%).

FLORIDA STATE FELIPE: De La Cruz was among the best strikeout artists in the Florida State League in 2023...Among FSL pitchers with 90.0 or more innings pitched, the 22-year-old led the circuit in strikeout rate (28.7%)...The southpaw also led the league in strikeouts-per-9 innings (11.36) and swinging strike rate (15.5%), while ranking 2nd in xFIP (3.68)...In 21 appearances (19 starts) with St. Lucie, De La Cruz was 3-6 with a 4.68 ERA (47 ER in 90.1 IP), 41 walks, and 114 strikeouts.
