#### FROM THE CROWS NEST

**TRENDING UPWARD:** Despite sending the tying run to the plate late, the Bradenton Marauders fell 6-3 in their series opener with the Clearwater Threshers on Tuesday night. Clearwater starter Luke Gabrysh was stellar, tossing five shutout innings while limiting the Marauders to just one hit. The Threshers provided run support for him early when Eduardo Tait pummeled a first-inning homer. Pitching dominated the middle third of the game as both sides traded scoreless innings until the back-third of the game when Bradenton began to rally by pushing across two in the seventh and one in the eighth.

KG SAYS HELLO: 2024 first-round pick Konnor Griffin has led off in all of his 33 games played in 2025. In the first inning this year, he is slashing .323/.364/.581 with two home runs and four extra-base hits. Over his last three games, he has homered on the first pitch of the game's first frame twice, including Tuesday night versus No. 71 overall prospect Trey Yesavage. Moreover, while jumping on the first pitch in general this year, he is 11-for-18 (.611), with five of those hits coming in the first inning (5-for-7).

CASTILLO TAKES THE BALL: Right hander Carlos Castillo toes the rubber for game two of the series versus the Threshers. In seven starts, he's posted a 5.32 ERA and punched out 22 hitters through 23.2 innings. Last time out, Castillo allowed four runs (three earned) over three frames at Dunedin last Thursday. Over his last two starts, he's been charged with eight earned runs over 6.1 innings. Before then he had allowed six over 17.1 frames of work to begin the year. He also faced Clearwater on May 2, and allowed two runs over two innings (Carter Mathison 2-R HR). His sinker averages at 92 miles per hour, and opponents are hitting .265 against it. His changeup has yet to allow a hit this year - he primairly uses it against lefties.

SCOUTING THE THRESHERS: The Clearwater Threshers enter the week at 21-18 in third place in the FSL West. Last week, they dropped four of six versus second-place Lakeland. Despite dropping their first four games of the week, the Threshers took to final two games by a combined score of 12-3. In the series, the two played tightly each tight, both scoring 17 runs each. As a staff, they rank third in ERA (4.07), fifth in strikeouts (403) and are tied with St. Lucie for the league's lowest opponents' batting average (.221). They've also allowed 30 home runs this season, tied for the second most in Single-A. They don't run a lot, having stolen the least amount of bases in the FSL (23). They feature five ranked prospects including Eduardo Tait (No. 4), Dante Nori (No. 6), Griffin Burkholder (No. 7), Aroon Escobar (No. 13) and Carter Mathison (No. 27). Tait is ranked No. 77 Overall by MLB Pipeline and 66 by MLB Pipeline. Escobar was recently named No. 100 by Baseball America.

**RUN AT YOUR OWN RISK:** The Marauders have been one of the best teams at controlling the running game this season. Their 30 stolen bases allowed are the fewest in Single-A. In the process, they've limited opponents to a .612 stolen base percentage, the lowest in the FSL and second best in Single-A (.001 points behind Charleston). Marauders catcher **Derek Berg** has posted a 1.90 average pop time to second base this year, the quickest mark in the FSL (would rank 11th in MLB). As a result, he has thrown out 12 of 24 potential base stealers, the best rate of any qualified catcher in the FSL. In the month of May, he has cut down 6 of 8 potential base stealers, including 3 of 3 at Clearwater on May 4.

ROUND OF A.PLAZ: While Pirates No. 28 prospect Axiel Plaz is second on Bradenton in hitting (.306), and leads in RBI (27) and average exit velocity (92.0 mph), his increase in contact at the plate has turned heads. Through 29 games, his whiff rate is down four percent (28.3%) and his strikeout rate has dropped by 12 percent (17.5%) while maintaining elite batted-ball quality. This year he is batting .355 and slugging .645 on pitches in the zone. His 49 percent Hard-Hit rate is first among qualified FSL catchers. He is slashing .333/.380/.733 with five home runs in May. He is 12 hits away from matching his total from last year in 140 less plate appearances.

MARAUDERS MASHERS: Bradenton's starting lineup features some of the highest ranked batted-ball quality in all of the Single-A level. Axiel Plaz and Konnor Griffin's 49% Hard-Hit Rates (percent of batted balls with exit velocity of 95 mph+) are tied for fifth among players with at least 90 plate appearances in the FSL this season. Derek Berg slots in at 12th (45.5%) and Braylon Bishop ranks 14th (44.9%). Moreover, Griffin's 114.2 mph single on April 8 vs PLM is the second hardest batted ball in Single-A this year. He's recorded 30+ batted balls of 100 mph or harder.
