#### LRST TIME OUT

**Rochester, NY (June 13)** -Scranton/Wilkes-Barre dropped both games of a doubleheader to the Rochester. The Red Wings took the first game 6-3 and walked-off the second contest 8-7. The RailRiders had four homers on the day including two from Estevan Florial for a team-high sixteen on the season.

#### GAME 1 - ROC 6, SWB 3

The first five batters for Rochester reached successfully at the start of the contest. After Derek Hill was hit by a pitch, Jake Alu and Victor Robles singled to load the bases. A hit, a walk, and a sacrifice fly drove in three for an early lead. Scranton/Wilkes-Barre got back in the game with two runs in the third. Jamie Westbrook walked and Jesus Bastidas doubled to put them both in scoring position. Back-to-back RBI singles from Michael Herмосillo and Estevan Florial made it 3-2. In the bottom half, Carter Kieboom led off with a walk. A two-run shot from Jake Noll and an RBI single from Hill gave them a 6-2 advantage. The RailRiders inched back thanks to Franchy Cordero's solo homer in the sixth. That was as much as the team could muster with a final score of 6-3.

Randy Vasquez (L, 1-7) pitched 2.2 innings allowing six runs on seven hits. He walked three and struck out four. Aaron McGarity got the final out of the third and tossed a five pitch fourth. Colten Brewer and Matt Bowman each threw a clean frame. Willy Peralta (W, 2-4) tossed five innings allowing just two runs on six hits. He struck out five. Andres Machado let up a solo homer in his frame. Tyler Danish (S, 5) closed it down in the ninth.

#### GAME 2 - ROC 8, SWB 7

Elijah Dunham smoked a home run in the first inning for an early 1-0 lead. The RailRiders tacked on another in the third. Jesus Bastidas doubled and raced home on Estevan Florial's sacrifice fly. Rochester plated three runs in the fourth. Matt Adams doubled in Carter Kieboom. Travis Blankenhorn's two-run shot gave them a 3-2 advantage. The next frame the Red Wings recorded four consecutive base knocks. Jake Alu batted in one run and Kieboom chipped home two of his own. Rochester led 6-2. The visitors chipped away at the lead with three runs in the sixth. Florial smashed his team-leading 16th home run of the season. Oswald Peraza recorded his first triple and came home on Andres Chaparro's sacrifice fly. It was 6-4 after six. In the top of the seventh, the RailRiders rallied back. Bastidas and Wilmer Difo legged out singles to get aboard. Florial swatted his second home run of the game deep to left field. It was his fifth run batted in the contest for a 7-6 SWB advantage. In the bottom half, the Red Wings were there to take the win. Alu and Matt Adams singled to put two on. Franmil Reyes laced a double up the left field line to walk things off for Rochester 8-7.

Johnny Brito got the start for SWB letting up six runs on seven hits. He struck out five. Greg Weissert (L, 1-2) struck out the side in the sixth. He let up two runs on three hits in the seventh. Paolo Espino tossed five innings allowing two runs on two hits. Sean Doolittle let up a pair of runs in his frame. Jose A. Ferrer (W, 3-3) gave up three runs on a home run in the seventh.

#### NEWS & NOTES

**CALLED UP** - Josh Maciejewski finished his rehab assignment in Hudson Valley and was promoted to SWB to begin the road series. The 27-year old began then season on the Injured List, but pitched in three contests with the Renegades. This is the lefty's fourth time in Triple-A and he is set to be an impactful piece of the bullpen.

**WALK OFF STATS** - The RailRiders have walked-off three games for wins at PNC Field and have been walked off against three times on the road. Last night after taking the lead in the top of the seventh, the Red Wings got a two-run double from Franmil Reyes to steal away the win. St. Paul and Lehigh Valley have also notched walk off wins. Jesus Bastidas, Ben Rortvedt, and Michael Herмосillo have each recorded hits to end the game in the home half for SWB.

**FLO'S FLYING** - Estevan Florial had his second multi-homer game of the season last night to total 17 homers on the year. He has done this in the 47 games he is played in this year. The most Flo has ever hit in a season is 18 in 2021 when he split time between Somerset, Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, and New York.

**HOMER HEAVEN** - The RailRiders were the first International League team to hit 100 home runs and they now have 108. Rochester has 64 as a team. The New York Yankees have totaled 104. The RailRiders have launched a half a dozen homers in two contests in this season. SWB homered 20 times against Charlotte, topping the 16 they hit last season against Omaha. Estevan Florial leads the team with seventeen.

**RUNNING RAILRIDERS** - Scranton/Wilkes-Barre has swiped 74 bases this season, seventh in the International League. Wilmer Difo and Estevan Florial lead the team with 13 steals. Rochester has just 61 snags as a team with Richie Martin in charge with 16. Last summer, the RailRiders stole 172 bases which was a season-high record.

**WHO'S ON FIRST** - The RailRiders have had seven different first basemen this season. Billy McKinney leads the way with 23 starts, while Andres Chaparro has made 18 starts there. Mickey Gasper and Jake Bauers have also played their hands at first base this season. Rodolfo Duran and Carlos Narvaez each made their first professional start at the corner this season and now have each defended there three times. Franchy Cordero also played a handful of frames at first.

**ANOTHER YEAR DOWN** - Scranton/Wilkes-Barre has four birthdays in June. Oswald Peraza turns 23 on June 15 while the following day Will Warren turns 24. On the 18th of the month, Jamie Westbrook turns 28 and finally Michael Feliz turns 30 on June 28.

**ATOP THE YANKS FARM** - The RailRiders will showcase top prospect outfielder Elijah Dunham (#16 per MLB prospect rankings in the Yankees system) in his first Triple-A season. Will Warren (#7) and Randy Vasquez (#12) are set to be essential parts of the starting rotation after also making their debuts with Scranton/Wilkes-Barre this summer.

**PROSPECT RANKING:** Currently ranked #7 by Baseball America, #7 by MLB Pipeline, #6 by Fangraphs

**2023 HIGHLIGHTS:** Has had 4 appearances with 8 strikeouts...Quality start in first Triple-A outing

**WHERE'S HE AT:** Warren began the season at Double-A Somerset, after six starts received the promotion to Triple-A on May 17

**GOT THE INVITE:** At Spring Training in March he tossed 2.0 innings in one appearance...no runs on one hit

**FARMHAND FAVORITE:** Ranked second among Yankees farmhands in games started, fourth in innings pitched, tied for fourth in wins, seventh in strikeouts, ninth in WHIP (1.25) and 10th in ERA

**WHICH PITCH:** Labeled as having the "Best Slider" among Yankees farmhands after 2022 season...NY helped him upgrade it over the course of the season and add a newfound sinker

**GRAYSON CRAWFORD'S TAKE (AA PITCHING COACH):** "With Will, opening up both sides of the plate has been a big focus of ours through spring training and into now with both fastballs, not just the two seam. Will's two-strike execution has been much improved from last year. That's showing in the amount of strikeouts that he's been able to get so far. I think he's definitely knocking on the door (for Triple-A). We're going to focus on what we can control in the process here and he's doing a good job of that. I think he's going to control the success that he has based off of his execution. He's walked some batters, but a lot of that was early just trying to strike more people out instead of maybe just pitching to contact like he's done in the early part of his career. I think you have to learn how to miss bats and we're seeing progress."

**HITTING THE ZONE:** Can work the top and bottom of the strike zone and both sides of the plate...sound delivery...working on command

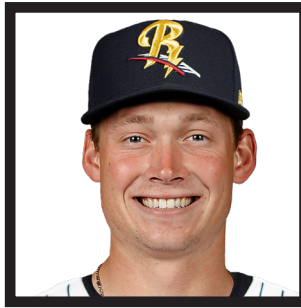
