vs. the Charlotte Knights (Chicago White Sox) at Coolray Field. It is the 11th of 18 meetings between the two clubs this season, and the 11th of 12 games to be played in Giveaway, presented by Coolray Heating & Cooling (first 1,500 fans receive the giveaway).

VS. CHARLOTTE: Gwinnett is 75-62 (.541) in 137 games vs. Charlotte all-time at Coolray Field, including 7-3 (.625) in 10 games in 2022. The Stripers are 7-5 in season home series vs. the Knights dating back to 2009, including 3-1 over the last four seasons (2017-21).

BEST FOR LAST: The Stripers improved to 4-0 in twin bills with a pair of last-at-bat wins last night, raising their record to 10-5 (.667) in last-at-bat decisions.

- Game 1: Travis Demeritte's bases-loaded walk in the seventh notched a 3-2 walk-off win (GWN now 4-4 in walk-off decisions). It was Demeritte's first career walkoff RBI with Gwinnett, and his second career last-at-bat GWRBI (3-run double for 9-7 win on 4/12/19 at LOU).
- · Game 2: Ryan Casteel's two-out, two-run single in the sixth plate the decisive runs in a 3-0 triumph. It was Casteel's first career last-at-bat GWRBI with Gwinnett.

MULLDOZING: Kyle Muller recorded the fourth complete game of his career in game one last night, logging 7.0 IP (6 H, 2 R, 2 ER, 1 HR, 0 BB, 8 SO) for the win. It was his first CG since 7/23/19 with Double-A Mississippi at Jackson (6.0 IP, 3 H, 2 R, 0 ER, 3 BB, 6 SO in 2-0 loss).

- · IL Leaderboard: Muller leads the league in strikeouts (110) and ranks among the top five in ERA (2nd, 2.95), WHIP (2nd, 1.08), innings (2nd, 88.1), complete games (T-2nd, 1), BAA (3rd, .217), and starts (T-5th, 15).
- Pitcher of the Month: On 7/7, Muller was named the IL Pitcher of the Month for June. All five of his starts during the month were quaity outings, and he went 2-1 with a league-low 1.87 ERA (7 ER in 33.2 IP), .171 BAA, and 11.49 SO/9.0 IP ratio (43 SO).

KINGS OF THE "K": Stripers pitchers lead the International League in strikeouts with 831 in 82 games (10.13 SO per game). That's seven behind Round Rock of the Pacific Coast League (838 SO in 82G) for the most in Triple-A. Gwinnett has not led Triple-A in strikeouts since 2011 (club record 1,223 SO in 143G). Kyle Muller (1st, 110), Tucker Davidson (5th, 78), and Huascar Ynoa (T-8th, 72) all rank among IL leaders in strikeouts.

CAN'T TOUCH TONKIN: Michael Tonkin threw 1.2 innings (2 H, 0 R, 2 BB, 3 SO) last night, extending his team-best scoreless innings streak to 12.2 IP spanning his last 12 outings. In that stretch, he's posting a 0.71 WHIP (6 H, 3 BB), .136 BAA, 14.92 SO/9.0 IP ratio (21 SO), and three saves (3-for-3). In 26 games overall, Tonkin is 3-0 with a 1.98 ERA (6 ER in 27.1 IP), .186 BAA, 14.82 SO/9.0 IP ratio (45 SO), and six saves (6-for-7, T-11th in IL).

CASTEEL IN THE CLUTCH: Ryan Casteel is batting .300 (12-for-40, 4 2B, 3 HR, 7 R, 12 RBI, 1.029 OPS) in 13 games since 6/4. Of his 20 hits this season, 13 have gone for extra bases (65.0%), including five doubles, one triple, and seven homers. For his Gwinnett career, 49.1% of his hits have been for extra bases (27 of 55), including 11 doubles, one triple, and 15 homers.

TONIGHT: The Stripers play game five of a six-game series **DEMERITTE ALWAYS ON:** Travis **Demeritte** has reached base safely in 172 of 202 career games (85.1%) with Gwinnett since 2019, batting .277 (193-for-698, 50 2B, 4 3B, 43 HR, 131 R, 139 RBI, 16 SB, .914 OPS). He is Georgia. Tonight is the World Champions Affiliate T-Shirt one of three players in Gwinnett history with two 20-homer seasons, joining Stefan Gartrell and Ernesto Mejia.

RISING WATERS: Atlanta Braves' No. 1 prospect Drew Waters went a combined 3-for-7 (1 R, 1 SB) last night. After posting a .664 OPS over his first 29 games from 5/3-6/15, he owns an .771 OPS (.264, 19-for-72, 1 2B, 2 3B, 2 HR, 10 R, 6 RBI, 4 SB) over his last 18 games since 6/17.

- 2022 Season: In 47 total games, Waters is batting .251 (46-for-183, 6 2B, 3 3B, 5 HR, 26 R, 16 RBI, 5 SB, .707 OPS), including .379 (4 2B, 1 HR, .938 OPS) vs. LHP and .192 (2 2B, 3 3B, 4 HR, .600 OPS) vs. RHP.
- GWN Career: Since making his Triple-A debut in 2019, Waters is batting .248 (172-for-694, 33 2B, 4 3B, 18 HR. 113 R, 64 RBI, 36 SB, .710 OPS) in 176 games.

SHEW-MAKING IT HAPPEN: Braden Shewmake has hit safely in 14 of 17 games since 6/7, batting .297 (19-for-64, 3 2B, 2 HR, 6 R, 10 RBI, 2 SB, .790 OPS) in that span. In 60 games overall on his Triple-A debut, he is batting .269 (60for-223, 11 2B, 1 3B, 5 HR, 29 R, 18 RBI, 6 SB, .722 OPS).

DELINO DE-STEALS: Delino DeShields Jr. ranks tied for 12h in the IL in stolen bases with 16 (16-for-23, 69.6%). He has three multi-steal games this year (2 SB on 4/19 at JAX, 5/10 at DUR, and 5/28 at NOR). Between MiLB and MLB, DeShields has 421 career steals in 1,323 games.

TUI TO THE FUTURES GAME: On 7/7, MLB announced the rosters and coaching staffs for the 2022 SiriusXM MLB All-Star Futures Game on 7/16 at Dodger Stadium. Stripers manager Matt Tuiasosopo has been selected as the third base coach for the National League Team, led by former MLB manager Mike Scioscia. Tuiasosopo will be the first active Gwinnett coach to particiate in a Futures Game.

TARNOK TO TRIPLE-A: On 7/8, RHP Freddy Tarnok was promoted to Gwinnett from Double-A Mississippi. Atlanta's No. 7 prospect according to MLB.com, Tarnok went 2-2 with a 4.31 ERA (30 ER in 62.2 IP), .228 BAA, and 10.77 SO/9.0 IP ratio (75 SO) in 15 starts for the M-Braves. Over his final four Double-A starts from 6/18-7/7, he went 1-0 with a 1.71 ERA (4 ER in 21.0 IP), .184 BAA, and 31 strikeouts.

• Triple-A Debuts: When Tarnok pitches, he'll be the seventh player to make his Triple-A debut for Gwinnett this year, joining OF Justin Dean, OF Greyson Jenista, INF Braden Shewmake, RHP Victor Vodnik, RHP Allan Winans, and RHP William Woods.

PROSPECTING: Gwinnett's active roster features seven listed on the MLB.com Braves Top 30 Prospects list: OF Drew Waters (1), LHP Kyle Muller (2), RHP Bryce Elder (3), INF Braden Shewmake (4), LHP Tucker Davidson (6), RHP Freddy Tarnok (7), and RHP Victor Vodnik (11).

MANAGER MATT TUIASOSOPO

Matt Tuiasosopo is in his second season as the manager of the Stripers in 2022 ... He was named the seventh manager in Gwinnett history on 3/30/21, making him the first former Gwinnett player to manage the club (played OF/1B from 2016-17) . In 2021, he guided the Stripers to a 71-58 record (3rd in Triple-A East Southeast Division) ... On 5/4/21 at Charlotte, he became the youngest manager in Gwinnett history (34 years, 11 months, 25 days) ... On 6/9/22 at Jacksonville, he became the fourth manager in Gwinnett history to reach 100 career wins ... On 7/7/22, was selected as the third base coach for the NL Team for the 2022 SiriusXM MLB All-Star Futures Game (7/16 at Dodger Stadium) ... Began his career with Class-A Rome in 2019, earning Atlanta's Bobby Cox Award for MiLB Manager of the Year.
