LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn dropped their 2nd-straight contest on Sunday afternoon, 11-6, to
Jersey Shore... BlueClaws scored 6 runs in the top of the 9th to take the lead for good. Top of the 9 Shore... Blued 1 hour and 7 minute de dur lead on RBI singles from SS Erick Brito and 2B Hao-Yu Lee, respectively...Brito finished with 3 hits, 2 doubles, and 2 RBI, while Lee had 2 hits and 2 RBI...Cyclones took the lead in the home 8th on a RF Stanley Consuegra sacrifice fly and a double steal of home from LF Oma De Los Santos and DH Abraham Almonte...Consuegra and Almonte each powered home runs...Consuegra blasted a 2 -run shot in the 4th and Almonte poked a solo homer in the 1st.

RAINDROPS KEEP FALLING ON MY HEAD: Brooklyn endured their longest rain delay of the 2023 season on Sunday afternoon...The Cyclones and BlueClaws had a 1 -hour and 7 -minute stoppage in the top of the 9th due to torrential rain...Only 4 prior games had featured a delay of any kind in 2023 ... Brooklyn's previous long delay this campaign came with a 29 -minute halt prior to first pitch on May 13 at Wilmington...In all, the Cyclones first 4 delays accrued a combined total of 59 minutes.

LUCKY NUMBER SEVEN: On Thursday and Friday, RHP Tyler Stuart and RHP Blade Tidwel became the first pair of Cyclones starters to toss 7.0-plus innings in consecutive games during the 2022 season...It was the first time Brooklyn had their starting pitcher toss 7.0 -full frames in consecutive contests since three arms did it in three-straight days in 2022...RHP Luis Moreno (September 7), RHP Dominic Hamel (September 8), and RHP Jeffrey Colón (September 9) all

BEND, BUT NO TE-BRAKE: RHP Dylan Tebrake has been nearly untouchable since being reinstated from Brooklyn's injured list...Since being activated on May 14 , the 23 -year-old has registering 34 strikeouts ( $13.91 \mathrm{~K} / 9$ )...That equates to a $39.5 \mathrm{~K} \%$ (34/86) and $11.6 \mathrm{BB} \%(10 / 86)$.. Since moving to a relief role, Tebrake is 2nd among SAL relievers in opposing OPS (.391) and hits-per-9 innings (3.72), tied for 2nd in strikeouts (34), 4th in WHIP (0.91) and ERA (1.23), and 5th in strikeouts per-9 innings (13.91).

URNING THE TID-E: RHP Blade Tidwell is in the midst of his best stretch of baseball in 2023...The 22 -year-old has tossed 3 -straight quality starts dating back to June 17 at Aberdeen...Tidwell has earned the win in all 3 outings, permitting just 2 run on 10 hits over 20.0 innings...He has walked only $4(5.6 \mathrm{BB} \%$ ) and struck out $26(36.6 \mathrm{~K} \%)$ in those contests... He whiffed a career-high and team-season-best-matching 11 on Friday vs. Jersey Shore...This whiffed 10 on May 4 vs. Aberdeen. Over his last 8 starts dating back to May 17 at Hudson Val ley, Tidwell is $5-0$ with a 1.34 ERA ( 6 ER in 40.1 IP) with just 20 hits allowed...The Loretto, Tenn. native has walked 24 and struck out 59 ( $36.6 \mathrm{~K} \%$ )...Tidwell's holding opponents to a meager . 46 batting average (20-137) against him...Tidwell leads the South Atlantic League in batting average against (.146) and is 2nd in strikeouts (59) and ERA (1.34) since that date (min. 30.0 IP)...On the season, the Loretto, Tenn. native is 2 nd in the SAL in batting average against (.185),
tied for 4th in strikeouts ( 86 ) and wins (5).

PITCHING IN: Since the start of a 4-game winning streak at Hudson Valley on May 17, the Cyclones' pitching staff has, statistically, been the most dominant in Minor League Baseball.. 42 games, holding a 22-20 record in that span...The Yankees' High-A Hudson Valley (2.86) is 2 nd in the minors. The 20 record in that span...The Yankees High-A Hudson Valley (2.86 a of $28.2 \%$ and a walk rate of $11.6 \%$...Additionally, Brooklyn pitching has permitted the fewest (6.82) in that time period...RHPs Blade Tidwell (1.34) and Tyler Stuart (1.43) hold the 2nd and 3rd best ERA's in MiLB during that time (min. 40.0 IP ).

RELIEF READY: The Cyclones' relief staff has been exquisite at quelling fires in 2023...Enter ing Monday, Brooklyn has the best bullpen ERA (3.20) in the entire South Atlantic League, and 2nd lowest throughout Minor League Baseball...The Rangers' Single-A Down East leads (3.17) Wilkin Ramos (1.54) is 6th in ERA among SAL relievers (min. 30.0 IP).

POWER OF PAUL: RHP Paul Gervase garnered a career-high 6 strikeouts over 3.0 spotless innings of relief on June 9 vs. Greenville and has tossed 6 -straight scoreless outings since
that date (11.0 IP)...Gervase averages 13.78 strikeouts-per- 9 -innings and holds a $34.7 \%$ strikethat date

FINISHING STRONG: After suffering a walk-off defeat in 3-of-4 games to start a road series in Aberdeen, Brooklyn closed out the month of June with a flourish...Starting with Saturday, June 17's win over the IronBirds, the Cyclones won 8 -of-11 contests to finish the season's third
month...In that time, the Cyclones had the South Atlantic League's lowest ERA (2.00) and batting average against (.165)...Brooklyn's 8 -3 mark was tied for the 2nd-best record in the circuit in that time frame...Only Hickory (10-1) had a better win percentage.
STU-PENDOUS: RHP Tyler Stuart tossed 7.0 more innings of 1 -run ball on Thursday, earning his 3rd win...He set career-highs in innings pitched ( 7.2 ) and strikeouts ( 11 ), in his previous start on June 22 vs. Hudson Valley...The 23 -year-old was the first Cyclone to record 11+ strikeouts
in a single game since RHP Carson Seymour accomplished the feat on July 15, 2022, vs. Greensboro...Stuart was also the first Brooklyn arm to work into the 8th inning since RHP Conner Grey tossed 8.1 innings vs. Jersey Shore on July 16, 2021...The Southern Miss alum was the first Cyclone to work $7.0+$ innings and record $10+$ strikeouts in a single game since LHP all qualifiers in the SAL, High-A, and all of Minor League Baseball in ERA (1.42) Double-A Pensacola's LHP Patrick Monteverde (1.93) is 2nd in the minors...The Kankakee, III. native leads the league in LOB\% (89.1\%), is 2nd in FIP (3.04), 3rd in WHIP (1.06), 4th in xFIP (3.40), 5th in innings pitched (69.2) and batting average against (.206), 8th in strikeouts (79), and 9th in strikeout rate (28.4\%) and walk rate (7.9\%).
vs. JERSEY SHORE: Brooklyn continues their 12-game homestand, finishg with 6 contests against the Phillies High-A affiliate...The BlueClaws possess 5 of new York's top 30 prospects per Baseball America: RHP Orion Kerkering (6), INF Hao Yu Lee (7), OF Gabriel Rincones (10), C Caleb Ricketts (19), and RHP Tommy McCollum (23). Brooklyn and Jersey Shore are meeting at Maimonides Park for the first time since the opening series of 2023 Brooklyn captured 2-of-3 games...The Cyclones are 6-8 against the BlueClaws in the first 14 meetings of the campaign... Dating back to 2021, Brooklyn is 43-33 all-time against Jersey Shore (.566).
CAPTAIN KEVIN: C Kevin Parada has picked up the pace offensively over the last few weeks... OPS and 146 wRC+ in 20 games Prada has accrued 10 lashing $.299 / .357 / .558$ with a .91 home runs, 15 RBI, 6 walks, and a hit-by-pitch...The Pasadena, Calif. native had a 10 -game hit ting streak ( 15 -for-39; .385/.429/.821) and a 15 -game on-base streak (.333/.397/.632) snapped on Saturday...The former Georgia Tech Yellow Jacket enters Monday tied for 6th in the South Atlantic League in doubles (15), tied for 7th in extra-base hits (26) and total bases (110), and tied for 9th in hits (65).

WALK THIS WAY: OF Alex Ramírez is 4th in the South Atlantic League in walks (17) and pitches per-plate appearance (4.240) and tied for 10th in runs scored (16) since the beginning of June. Ramírez is scattered among the Cyclones' all-time leaderboard despite joining the team last July 4...Entering Monday, the Dominican native is 4th in franchise history in RBI (66) and is 25 behind INF Jose Peroza (91) for the all-time mark... He is also tied for 3rd in doubles (27) 5th in hits (121) and 6th in total bases (180)

MARATHON MEN: Brooklyn is in the midst of their longest stretch without an off day for the 2023 season...The Cyclones will play 12 games in 12 days from Wednesday, June 28, until Sunday, July 9...Brooklyn completes their 2-week homestand with a 6 -game series at Maimonides a 6 -game set at Frawley Stadium against the Blue Rocks starting Brooklyn is 2-3 during the stretch...Following the 12 games in 12 days, Brooklyn will have a 4 -day break for the Major League All-Star Game before returning to Coney Island on Friday, July 14, to open up a brief 3 -game home series vs. Greensboro.
ON THE MEND: Brooklyn currently has 2 players on their roster undergoing rehab assign ments: RHP Sean Reid-Foley and OF Abraham Almonte...Reid-Foley was added to the roste on Wednesday and has made 2 appearances out of the bullpen...The 27 -year-old has allowed run on 1 hit over 1.2 innings, striking out 2...Almonte joined Brooklyn on June 20...The 34-year stolen bases...RHP Elieser Hernández completed a Major League rehab assignment for Brook Iyn on Monday and was transferred to Triple-A Syracuse.

OH MY, OMAR: OF Omar De Los Santos has added 29 stolen bases in 2023 and remains among the best base stealers in Minor League Baseball since the beginning of 2022...The Dominican native has accumulated 99 stolen bases in that span, which is 4 th most in Milb. Only Aberdeen OF Luis Valdez (105), Marlins farmhand INF Nasim Núñez (103), and D'Backs bases 2nd with 41...Omar is already 3 swipes shy of matching INF Walter Rasquin's franchise recor for single-season stolen bases (32) which was set back in 2017.
DOWN TO THE WIRE: RF Omar De Los Santos provided Brooklyn their 6th walk-off win of 2023, scoring on a wild pitch in June 25's victory vs. Hudson Valley...DH Kevin Parada delivere a bases-loaded RBI single in the bottom of the 9th on June 7 vs. Greenvilie.... Jose Mena added game-winning single in the bottom of the 9th on May 26...1B Chase Estep provided registered a walk-off RBI single in the 11th vs. Wilmington on April 22 and LF Omar De Los Santos garnered a game-winning single in the 10th vs. Aberdeen...The Cyclones have at least 1 walk-off win in each home series this year...Brooklyn garnered 4 walk-off wins through the en tirety of the 2022 campaign...In addition to 6 walk-off wins, the Cyclones have suffered 9 walk off defeats after June 16's loss at Aberdeen...20.5\% (15-of-73) of Brooklyn's games this seaso have ended in walk-off fashion, including $22.5 \%$ (9-of-40) of all defeats and $42.9 \%$ ( 9 -of-21) of road losses... $35.6 \%$ ( 26 -of- 73 ) have been determined by just 1 run.

 Butto (23), RHP Luis Montas (24), OF Rowdey Jordan (25), and RHP Matt Allan (30) In all 15 of-30 members of BA's Top 30 have experience playing on Coney Island.

LAST TIME OUT: Took his 3rd-straight no-decision in a scheduled abbreviated start at Aberdeen last Sunday...Retired all 6 batters he faced...Tossed 18 pitches and 12 strikes (66.7\%)...Relieved by RHP Benito García in the bottom of the 3rd with the game scoreless...Cyclones scored multiple runs in each of the final 3 innings to defeat the IronBirds, 7-3.

HOME AWAY FROM HOME: Despite Maimonides Park's pitcher-friendly tendencies, Foster has faired slightly better away from Coney Island in 2023...The 24 -year-old holds an 1-2 mark, but a 4.45 ERA ( 16 ER in 32.1 IP) with 16 walks and 27 strikeouts in 8 road starts...At home, Foster is $1-2$ with a 6.32 ERA (11 ER in 15.2 IP), 9 walks, and 15 strikeouts.

2022: Composed a 4-2 record with a 1.86 ERA ( 13 ER in 63.0 IP), 12 saves, and 84 strikeouts in 29 appearances at McNeese State University...Named Southland Conference Reliever of the Year...Recognized on the All-Southland Conference First Team...Selected by the New York Mets in the 14th round...Signed on August 1 for $\$ 40,000$...Assigned to the Florida Complex League Mets, but did not pitch.

START ME UP: Foster is slated to make the 11th start of his season and pro career on Monday night...The 24 -year-old did not start at McNeese State in 2022 and only made 4 total over 3 seasons...During 2 campaigns at Wharton (Texas) County Junior College registered just 8 starts in 23 appearances...Prior to this season, his last official start came on February 28, 2021, for McNeese State vs. Prairie View A\&M University.
