FRES-NOTES

GRIZZLIES SAIL PAST THE PORTS LATE: The Fresno Grizzlies (20-16) sunk the Stockton Ports (14-21) 4-2 Friday night from Banner Island Ballpark. The Grizzlies improved to 69-25 all-time against the Ports (8-2 record this season) with a 38-8 all-time record (8-2 this year) at Banner Island Ballpark. Seven of Fresno's last eight games have been decided by one or two runs, which includes all three of their wins in this series (5-2 record in that span). In the top of the fifth, Fresno cut the deficit to 2-1 when Fadriel Cruz powered a solo tater to right field, his second tank of the year. The Grizzlies knotted the game up at two in the top of the sixth after a designed double steal. Aidan Longwell stopped halfway between first and second, allowing GJ Hill to race home. Hill logged a walk and swiped two bags en route to the run. In the top of the ninth, Fresno loaded the bases, putting pressure on Stockton. Braylen Wimmer mustered an infield single, Andy Perez worked a 12-pitch walk and EJ Andrews Jr. dropped a bunt single down the third base line. That brought Cruz to the dish, who poked an infield single past the pitcher, driving in the go-ahead run. A double play recorded Perez, nudging the Grizzlies ahead for good, 4-2. Grizzlies starter Jack Mahoney yielded a no-decision after five and two-thirds innings of work. Mahoney allowed a pair of runs (one earned), on four hits and two walks while whiffing three. He gave way to Collin Baumgartner, who retired all four batters he faced. Baumgartner punched out two before handing the ball off to Bryson Hammer (2-1). The southpaw was awarded the win after two electric frames, striking out two as well. The duo managed three and one-third innings of scoreless baseball, combining for four strikeouts.

STOCK-PILING SOME STATS: The Fresno Grizzlies and Stockton Ports (Oakland Athletics Single-A affiliate) continue their six-game series tonight at Banner Island Ballpark. This is the second of five series between the clubs in 2024 and the second set in Stockton. The Grizzlies are 69-25 all-time (18-12 last year, fourth most wins all-time in a single-season vs. one team) against the Ports with a 38-8 all-time record (8-4 last year) at Banner Island Ballpark. In 2022, Fresno went 26-4 against Stockton with a +123 run differential (239-116). Those 26 wins broke the team record for the most victories against an opponent in a single season.

COUPET GETS THE NOD: Tonight, the Grizzlies hand the ball to LHP Isaiah Coupet. Coupet was selected by the Rockies in the 4th round (Pick 109) of the 2023 MLB Draft out of Ohio State. The lefty joined Fresno for three games at the tail end of the 2023 season, all in relief. Coupet is known for generating more than 3,000 RPM on both his slider and curveball.

AN ACE IN JACE: Grizzlies' RHP Jace Kaminska has been lights out over six starts this season. Kaminska is 2-1 with a 1.52 ERA and 0.91 WHIP, with the latter two ranking first in the California League. In 29.2 innings, he has allowed five runs (all earned), on 21 hits, six walks and two hit-by-pitches while punching out 34. Kaminska has started consecutive shutouts, giving Fresno five shutouts this season. He has tossed 12 straight scoreless innings, allowing nine hits and three walks while striking out 13.

HERRERA IS HIM: Grizzlies' LHP Welinton Herrera has nine consecutive scoreless outings from April 12-May 14. Herrera has tossed 13 innings, allowing six hits, two walks and one hit-by-pitch while striking out 25.

RISP IS A RISK: In the month of May, the Grizzlies hold a 7-9 record with 44 total runs scored (2.75 runs a game). A big reason for the lack of offense is the Grizzlies' inability to score with runners in scoring position (RISP). Over the 16 games in the month, Fresno is 27-for-134 (.201) with four different instances where the team went 0-fer with runners in scoring position. They have also left 128 runners on base in May.

JAKE IS DEFINITELY NOT ON THE "SNIDE"R: Grizzlies OF Jake Snider has had a fantastic season (32 games), going 28-for-96 (292 AVG/.489 OBP/.469 SLG/.958 OPS) with two homers, two triples, seven doubles, 18 RBI, 21 runs (one walk-off run), 32 walks, seven hit-by-pitches and seven stolen bases. The Louisville product is ranked first in the Colifornia League with 32 walks and tied for first with a .489 OBP. Snider's triple on April 24th against San Jose was his 12th in a Grizzlies uniform, putting him one triple shy of joining the Grizzlies Top 10 Career Records. Juan Melo and Roger Kieschnick are tied for ninth all-time with 13 triples.

A+ FROM ANDY PEREZ: Grizzlies INF Andy Perez has also had an outstanding season (35 games), going 41-for-141 (291 AVG/.342 OBP/.461 SLG/.803 OPS) with four homers (one grand slam), three triples, six doubles, 21 RBI, 17 runs, 11 walks and two stolen bases. The Cuban native is ranked among the Top 10 in six different California League categories. He is ranked tied for third in hits (41), tied for eighth in total bases (55), tied for eighth in extra-base hits (13), tied for eighth in homers (4) and 10th in slugging percentage (.461). Perez had hit safely in his first 18 games and 23 of first 24 games to start the season, his longest hit streak while in a Fresno uniform. It was the second longest hit streak in the Grizzlies/Rockies affiliation since Drew Romo in 2021 (21 games, July 6-August 15) and it was the longest active streak in Minor Lague Baseboll at the time. Perez went 26-for-76 (.342 AVG/.383 OBP/.579 SLG/.962 OPS) with three homers (one grand slam), three triples, three doubles, 18 RBI, 12 runs, five walks and two stolen bases in that hit streak stretch. Like Snider, Perez's triple on April 24th against San Jose was his 10th in a Grizzlies uniform, putting him three triples shy of joining the Grizzlies Top 10 Career Records. Juan Melo and Roger Kieschnick are tied for ninth all-time with 13 triples.

2024 (pro): Enters 2nd professional season with the Colorado Rockies organization...Can generate more than 3,000 RPM on both his slider and curveball...Favors his low-80s slider, which has 2-plane depth, but his mid-70s curveball is a plus pitch in its own right...Fastball sits at 89-91 MPH and tops out at 93 MPH...Also owns a sinking mid-80s changeup

2023 (pro): Pitched in just 5 games after being selected by the Rockies in the 4th round of the 2023 MLB Draft out of Ohio State...Was ranked as the Rockies #25 overall prospect on MLB.com after the draft...Became the 115th Buckeye to be drafted since 1966 and highest drafted since Dillon Dingler (2020)...6th player to be selected by Colorado and joins Ryan Feltner in the system...Over 2 relief appearances with the ACL Rockies, tossed 2 scoreless innings, issuing 1 walk while fanning 3...Assigned to Fresno on September 5... Struck out a batter and induced a double play in Fresno debut September 5 vs. Modesto...Fanned lone batter he faced September 6 vs. Modesto...Came in with 2 runners on and no outs in a tied game, left both runners stranded September 8 vs. Modesto.
