

• LAST TIME OUT: Cedar Rapids 7, Lake County 5: The Kernels opened up a 7-0 lead and never looked back in a win over the Captains Wednesday afternoon. Matthew Clayton (1-5, HR, 4 RBI) blasted a grand slam for his first high-A home run in the win, while Walker Jenkins (3-5, 3B, R), Gabriel Gonzalez (2-3, RBI) and Misael Urbina (2-4, RBI, BB, R) all posted multi-hit games. On the mound, Ty Langenberg (W, 6.0 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 3 K) posted six scoreless innings in the victory, for his third CR quality start and Rafael Marcano (SV, 1.0 IP, 1 H, 1 K) continued his strong string of pitching earning his first save since 2019.

- THE SERIES: Cedar Rapids and Lake County open up their second series with each other. The Captains took down the Kernels in their first meeting of the year in the beginning of June winning four of the six games and outscoring CR 39-21 across the set. The Kernels enter their first series in Eastlake since 2022, four games out of a playoff spot, with just 12 games to go.
- THE PLAYOFF PUSH: Every year since 2013, CR has made the Midwest League postseason. With 10 games to go, Cedar Rapids sits four games back of Quad Cities with the tie-breaker in hand.
- TROUBLE WITH RISP: Since the start of the series with South Bend two weeks ago, Cedar Rapids is hitting just 26-130 (.200) w/RISP hitting .259 without, the Kernels finished the set in Dayton just 13-60 with RISP (6-11 on SAT) and began the series vs Lake County 4-15 in that stat.
- EARLY SEASON STRUGGLES: Over its last five sets, Cedar Rapids is a combined just 4-14 across the first four games of the series. In weekend games, the Kernels are 5-1 across that span.
- AUGUST BLUES: With the loss on Tuesday, the Kernels drop to 8-16 in the month of August. On the mound, CR starting pitching is just 2-13 in the month with a 5.51 ERA, while the offense is hitting .227 across the 23 games (entered the month hitting .244 on the season, LC has the lowest AVG in the month at .214) with 11 HR the fourth-fewest in the league (Lake County 9).
- FIRST ROUND REUNION: Twins 2024 1st round pick Kaelen Culpepper joins Twins top prospect and 2023 1st round pick Walker Jenkins, the #4 prospect in MLB in high-A Cedar Rapids after receiving a promotion from single-A Fort Myers. Culpepper is the first player to join the Kernels in the same year he was drafted since Brooks Lee in 2022, while Jenkins is the highest Twins draft pick to play in CR since Royce Lewis (2017 and 2018).
- RELIABLE RAFAEL: After posting two scoreless innings in the loss on Sunday, Rafael Marcano continues his great stretch of pitching. Over his last 12 outings, 24 innings dating back to 6/25, Marcano holds just a 1.50 ERA with a .180 BAA and 25 strikeouts compared to just seven walks.
- RED HOT RUBEL: After missing 11 games with a wrist injury, Rubel Cespedes went 1-12 in his first three games back from the IL but has been on fire since. Cespedes is hitting .304 (41-135) with 4 HR and 23 RBI in his last 35 games. Cespedes went 16-45 on his season-long 11 game hitting streak that ended Thursday night, and currently has hits in 14 of his last 15 games.
- MR. 317: With the win on 5/9 in South Bend. Kernels' manager Brian Dinkelman collected his 317th win with the Kernels. The victory makes the Kernels bench boss the winningest manager in Cedar Rapids' modern franchise history (since 1949) passing Jake Mauer's 316. Dinkelman currently has 363 wins.
- STARS OF TOMORROW: 7 of the Twins' top 30 prospects currently stand on the Kernels roster: OF Walker Jenkins (1, 4 in MLB), INF Kaelen Culpepper (7), OF Gabriel Gonzalez (10), INF Rayne Doncon (20), LHP Connor Prielipp (23), INF Danny De Andrade (24), INF Rubel Cespedes (25).


