SOMERSET PATRIOTS NOTES

- The Somerset Patriots fell to the Erie SeaWolves 9-7 on Tuesday night in game three of a six-game series at TD Bank Ballpark.
- RHP Blane Abeyta (5 IP, 6 R, 5 ER, 5 H, 4 BB, 5 K) took the loss in his 13th start of the season.
- **2B Anthony Seigler** (2-for-4, 3 RBI, HR, 2B, 2 R, BB) put Somerset on the board with an RBI double in the 2nd inning, before his two-run homer in the 9th inning cut the deficit to two runs.
 - Seigler's 7 HR this season, all of which have come over his last 15 games, match his singleseason high set in 97 games in 2022.
 - Seigler, who celebrated his 25th birthday on Thursday, has reached base in eight of his last nine games.
 - Over his last 15 games, Seigler has posted a 1.006 OPS with 7 HR, 13 RBI, 11 R, 8 BB.
 - All seven of Seigler's home runs this season have come at home, where he owns a .794 OPS compared to a .529 OPS on the road.
- **C Jesus Rodriguez** (2-for-6, RBI) tallied his first Double-A hit and RBI in the contest with an RBI single in the 9th inning.
 - Playing in his second Double-A game on Thursday, Rodriguez put together his first multi-hit performance with Somerset and his 22nd total multi-hit game this season.
 - Rodriguez leads the Yankees farm system with a .329 AVG and 72 H, while his .411 OBP places second.
- SS Alexander Vargas (2-for-5, RBI, R, 3B) recorded his fourth multi-hit game at the Double-A level.
 - Over his last seven games, Vargas is 7-for-21 (.333) with 1 HR, 2 RBI, and 5 R.
- CF Spencer Jones (2-for-5, RBI, BB, SB) added a pair of hits including an RBI single in the 7th.
 - o In the month of June, Jones is slashing .286/.354/.486 with 3 HR, 17 RBI, and 13 R.
 - Jones stole his team-leading 17th base in the contest, which is T-3rd most in the Eastern League.
 - The Yankees No. 2 prospect recorded his 14th multi-hit game of the season and third multi-hit game over his last five.
- DH Elijah Dunham (2-for-3, 2 R, 2 BB) clocked in his eighth multi-hit performance of the season.
 - Dunham has reached base in each of his last five games, over which he is 7-for-18 (.388) with 5 R, 5 RBI, 5 BB and 4 XBH.
 - In eight games with Somerset in June, Dunham is slashing .296/.424/.519 with 1 HR and 6 RBI.
