Today's Game: The Nashville Sounds and Toledo Mud Hens play game two of a six-game series this morning at Fifth Third Field. Nashville won game one of the series in extra innings last night, 6-4. Right-hander Jason Alexander starts for the Sounds against left-hander Joey Wentz for the Mud Hens.

Jason Alexander: 29-year-old Jason Alexander makes his ninth appearance and seventh start of the season tonight. The right-hander from Windsor, Calif. is 6-2 with a 2.66 ERA (40.2 IP/12 ER). Alexander last pitched on May 20 vs. Louisville and picked up the win. He tossed 5.0 shutout innings and struck out five. Alexander leads the International League with six wins and is 9th in ERA. He spent the 2021 campaign in the Marlins organization, going 1-1 with a 1.37 ERA (19.2 IP/3 ER) in seven games (6 starts) with Jacksonville (5), Double-A Pensacola (1) and FCL Marlins (1). Alexander was signed by the Brewers as a minor league free agent on November 28, 2021. He was originally signed as a non-drafted free agent by the Angels in 2017.

Joey Wentz: 24-year-old Joey Wentz starts for the Mud Hens in this morning's game. The left-hander is 0-2 with a 4.38 ERA in six games (all starts) with Toledo. He has also pitched in one game with Detroit in 2022. The last time Wentz was on a mound was May 17 in a start against Indianapolis. He tossed 5.0 innings and took the loss after allowing three runs on seven hits. He walked one and struck out five. His previous appearance was a start with Detroit on May 11 vs. Oakland and he allowed six runs on seven hits and two walks in 2.2 innings. In 2021, Wentz was 0-7 with a 4.50 ERA in 18 starts for Single-A Lakeland and Double-A Erie. The Tigers acquired him on July 31, 2019 from Atlanta in a trade for RHP Shane Greene. He was drafted by Atlanta in the Competitive Balance-A Round of the 2016 MLB First-Year Player Draft.

Superlatives...Last night the Sounds improved to 5-3 in series openers...2-2 in extra innings...12-6 on the road...21-9 against right-handed starters...26-0 when leading after 8...22-1 when out-hitting the opponent.

Slick Shortstop: Nashville SS/CF Brice Turang committed his first error in 30 games last night. Turang has a .983 fielding percentage at shortstop this year (2 errors in 116 total chances) and a perfect fielding percentage in 8 total chances while playing center.

W4: Nashville has won its fourth consecutive game for the fourth time this season and looks to make it a season-best five wins in a row this morning. They also won four straight games April 16-20, April 28-30 and May 14-18.

It's Gonna be May: The Nashville bats have come alive after the team hit .247 in the month of April. The Sounds lead the International League with a .281 batting average in the month of May. The team is also second in OPS (.800) and second in walks (95).

Red Hot Reyes: Infielder Pablo Reyes has hit safely in seven consecutive games with another huge game last night. Reyes is hitting .520 (17-for-29) with 9 runs, 4 doubles, 3 home runs, 11 RBI, 1 walk and 2 stolen bases during the streak. He has five multi-hit games during the streak including a pair of four-hit games.

Super Mario: Sounds catcher Mario Feliciano had another four-hit game last night (second of the season) and extended his team-high on-base streak to 12 games. During the on-base streak, Feliciano is hitting .442 (19-for-43) with 5 runs, 2 doubles, 4 RBI and 4 walks.

Lucky Number Seven: The Sounds have won every series they have played this year (7). It's the first time since at least 1987 the team has won its first seven series in a season (team records date back to 1988).

Earn It: Nashville's team ERA sits at 2.98 (371.0 IP/123 ER) after last night's extra-inning win. The 2.98 ERA is the best mark across Triple-A Baseball, far ahead of Iowa with a 3.46 ERA. Nashville's six shut-outs also leads Triple-A Baseball.

The Future Brew Crew: Nashville opened the 2022 season with four players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects. Infielder Brice Turang is the No. 4 prospect, left-handed pitcher Ethan Small is the No. 7 prospect, catcher Mario Feliciano is the No. 21 prospect and right-handed pitcher Dylan File is the No. 25 prospect.
