FRISCO SCORES DOUBLE-DIGIT RUNS FOR THIRD TIME IN FOUR GAMES TO WIN OVER WICHITA:

The Frisco RoughRiders scored nine runs in the third inning and claimed a 10-7 win over the Wichita Wind Surge on Friday, stranding the tying run at the plate in the ninth inning at Riverfront Stadium. Frisco (14-11, 45-48) reached double digits in runs for the third time in four games. Wichita (10-15, 38-55) held Frisco in check Thursday for one run on five hits, but the RoughRiders surpassed that in the third inning alone with nine runs on eight hits. **Thomas Saggese** and **Kellen Strahm** led the way with three hits apiece including RBI hits in the third. **Justin Slaten** came out of Frisco's bullpen and induced a ground ball to end the game and take the save. **Noah Bremer** got a no-decision in his start for Frisco. The right-hander allowed a pair of two-run home runs in the second inning, then came back out in the third with a 9-4 lead and went two more scoreless innings. **Grant Wolfram** (7-0) delivered two innings without a score for the win, while **Reid Birlingmair** allowed one run in two innings. Marco Raya (0-2) held Frisco hitless in the first two innings of his start but recorded just one out in the third inning and was pegged with eight earned runs and the loss. The Riders also scored nine runs in the first inning on Tuesday to set a season-high. Frisco amassed nine runs both times without a home run. Saggese had the lone RBI after the third inning, singling to center field to score **Luisangel Acuña** in the eighth. Acuña had doubled and stolen third base to set up Saggese's team-leading 78th RBI and Acuña's team-leading 68th run of the year. The nine-run third inning started with singles by Acuña, Saggese and **Liam Hicks**. **Aaron Zavala** picked up an RBI on a walk, **Josh Hatcher** brought in two more runs on a single to take the lead and Strahm rammed a ball to left field for two more RBIs. A pitching change for Wichita did not slow down Frisco; **David Garcia** singled for a run off of Carlos Luna and **Evan Carter** doubled off the wall for the ninth run.

OFFENSE, OFFENSE AND SOME MORE OFFENSE:

The RoughRiders set multiple season highs in their 19-10 win over the Wind Surge on Wednesday. Their 19 runs, 19 hits and six home runs were all season bests while it was also the longest game of the season at three hours and 31 minutes. In the ninth inning, Frisco went back-to-back-to-back for the first time this season (**Trevor Hauver**, **Josh Hatcher** and **Scott Kapers**). Over their last four games, Frisco has hit .329/.397/.547/.944 with 13 doubles, two triples, six home runs, nine steals and 14 walks while averaging 10 runs per game.

GENTLEMEN, START YOUR ENGINES:

The RoughRiders have struggled on the starting pitching side of things this season. This year, Frisco has a 6.28 starting pitcher ERA which is the highest in recorded franchise history (dating back to 2005) and last in the Texas League. They have used 17 different starting pitchers, more than the 14 they used all season in 2022 and just under the 19 they used the whole year in 2021. Frisco has not had a start of more than 5.1 innings since June 10th, when **Ryan Garcia** went seven innings. Over those 38 games since June 11th, the Riders' starters' ERA is 7.75 (1.16ER/134.2IP) while the bullpen has a 4.51 ERA (98ER/195.2IP). Over the 38 games, the Riders have the third-best offense in the league by OPS (.784) and have hit 37 home runs (5th in the Texas League).

HATCH IS THE RIGHT MATCH:

Since coming to Frisco in June from High-A Hickory, **Josh Hatcher** has been a run-producing machine. In his 22 games, he has driven in 26 runs and in July, Hatcher is hitting .306/.352/.500/.852 with four homers and 22 RBIs in 16 games.

WELCOME BACK, CARTER:

Evan Carter has been fantastic since returning from the Injured List on June 21st against Springfield. Over his last 30 games since his return, he has 10 multi-hit games, batting .314 (37-for-118)/.410/.568/.978 with five doubles, two triples, seven home runs, 25 RBIs and 25 runs scored.

THOMAS THE TANK ENGINE:

Thomas Saggese has been incredible for the RoughRiders on offense. Over his last 42 games, he is hitting .355/.432/.633/1.065 with 11 home runs and 43 RBIs. The California native is currently fifth in the league in batting average (.314), second in RBIs (78), first in hits (115), fourth in doubles (22), second in runs (67) and first in total bases (188).

AMBUSH EARLY AND OFTEN:

Thomas Saggese has been fantastic on first pitches this season, first in the Texas League (min. 11 at-bats) with a .563 average (18-for-32) when he puts the first pitch of an at-bat in play. He has a 1.463 OPS on the first pitch, which is first in the league as well. **Luisangel Acuña** has also been great, hitting .453 (29-for-64) on the initial offering while his 29 hits on the first pitch lead the league and are fourth in the minors.

SPEED KILLS:

Luisangel Acuña leads the league in steals with 42 and is on pace for a career-best 62 swipes. Acuña is on pace to set a single-season record for the Riders, as **Elvis Andrus** has the record with 54 swipes in 2008. The RoughRiders are fifth in Texas League steals with 121 bases in 146 attempts (84 percent).

ONE HOME RUN, PLEASE. AND MAKE IT GRAND:

The RoughRiders have had a knack for grand slams this year with **Evan Carter** hitting Frisco's ninth grand slam of the season. They are one of two teams with at least nine grand slams in all of Minor League Baseball. Seven different players have accounted for the grand slams (**Liam Hicks**, **Luisangel Acuña**, **Jax Biggers**, **Dustin Harris**, **Trevor Hauver**, **Thomas Saggese** (3) and **Evan Carter**). On July 5th, the Riders allowed their first grand slam this year, becoming the final Texas League team to do so.

ACUÑA MATATA:

RoughRiders infielder **Luisangel Acuña** has been on fire at the plate. The Rangers No. 3 prospect has reached safely in a Riders' season-high 25 games in a row, batting .364/.424/.495/.919. He is fourth in the Texas League in batting average (.315), tied for first in hits (114), second in doubles (25), first in runs (68) and first in steals (42).

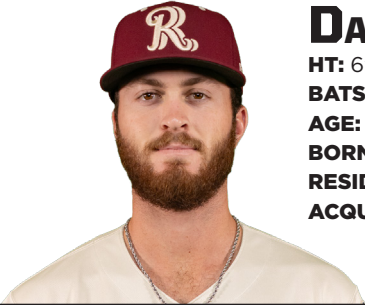

ABOUT DANE

-Went to Brenham High School in Brenham, Texas (between Austin and Houston). His senior year of high school, he went 5-2 with a 1.79 ERA.

-Acker attended Rice for freshman season, going 5-2 with a 4.20 ERA and earned Conference USA All-Freshman Team honors. From there, transferred to San Jacinto College for sophomore season in 2019, going 10-0 with a 2.36 ERA in 14 starts. He struck out 97 batters in 76.1 IP.

-Drafted by the Arizona Diamondbacks in the 2019 23rd round, but did not sign.

-For his junior season, he went to Oklahoma University, making four starts in the COVID-shortened season, going 1-1 with a 3.51 ERA. At the Schrienes College Classic on March 1st against No.11 LSU, Acker threw the first Oklahoma no-hitter since 1989, striking out 11 batters to just one walk and two hit batters. He threw 117 pitches in the game.

-Acker was taken by the Oakland Athletics in the 4th round of the 2020 draft, one pick after Braves pitcher Spencer Strider.

2023 SEASON

-Ranked as the No. 22 prospect in the Texas system by MLB.com.

-In Double-A debut at San Antonio on July 3rd, allowed two-run inside the park homer in the third inning to Juan Fernandez, but struck out five.

-When he was promoted to Double-A Frisco on July 3rd, Acker had just thrown 53.1 career MiLB innings over 17 games with only 50.1 innings and 12 games in affiliated ball above the Rookie level.

-Finished out High-A time with a 1.65 ERA (3ER/16.1IP) in June.

-Induced ground balls at a 46.9% rate with High-A Hickory over his six starts.

-Earned first career MiLB win with five strong innings against San Antonio on July 18th.

2022 SEASON

-Acker returned from rehab in mid-July, throwing in the Arizona League before making four starts with Hickory, debuting with the Crawdads on August 21st.

-After the season, Acker participated in the Rangers' Fall Instructional League program.

2021 SEASON

-After trade to Rangers, Acker made two starts with the Down East Wood Ducks before his second ended with "Tommy John" surgery.

-Traded from the Oakland Athletics along with OF Khris Davis and C Jonah Heim in exchange for INF Elvis Andrus and C Aramis Garcia and cash on February 6th, 2021.
