### INDY BITS

**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** Henry Davis launched a solo home run in the bottom of the first inning, but three homers in three consecutive innings by the Omaha Storm Chasers handed the Indianapolis Indians a 4-2 loss at Victory Field on Saturday night. Following a lengthy rain delay, Davis launched his seventh home run this season to begin the scoring. Omaha then took a lead it would not relinquish with a two-run homer from CJ Alexander in the third inning, followed by solo shots from Cam Devanney and John Rave in the fourth and fifth innings, respectively. All three Storm Chasers homers came against Nick Dombkowski. Indianapolis got one run back in the bottom of the eighth inning courtesy of an RBI single by Jack Suwinski. Carlos Hernández then stranded the game-tying run on first base to end the comeback attempt.

**DAVIS DINGER:** Henry Davis put the Indians on the board in the bottom of the first inning last night with his seventh home run in his last 16 games. Davis has joined outfielder Matt Gorski in hitting the ball hard since May 16, logging a .328 batting average (19-for-58) with 16 runs, 14 extra-base hits, 15 RBI, a .443 on-base percentage and 1.253 OPS. During that time, he has reached base safely in 14 of 16 contests. Davis' seven home runs in 22 total games with Indianapolis were his first of the season after three doubles were his lone extra-base hits in 23 games with Pittsburgh to begin the season. Since joining Indy on May 7, he is hitting .286 (22-for-77) with a .433 on-base percentage, .649 slugging percentage and 10 hit-by-pitches, which is the most by a player in professional baseball with less than 35 games played.

**MAY PLAYER OF THE MONTH:** Matt Gorski yesterday was named the Indians' May Player of the Month. His nine home runs in May are the third-most by an Indians batter in a single month since 2005 and are the most since Michael Ryan launched 10 in July 2007. In 23 May games, he led International League leaders with 28 RBI and three triples while ranking among qualifiers in home runs (T-1st, 9), slugging percentage (2nd, .720), extra-base hits (T-3rd, 15), total bases (T-3rd, 59), runs (T-4th, 21) and OPS (5th, 1.050).

**GORSKI'S GOOD:** Matt Gorski, a native of Fishers, Ind., carried a scorching-hot May into June last night, going 2-for-3 with a run for the lone multi-hit performance by an Indian in last night's loss. The slugger has hit the cover off the ball since May 16, batting .333 (20-for-60) with 17 runs, three doubles, two triples, nine home runs, 25 RBI, a .377 on-base percentage and .900 slugging percentage.

**AT THE VIC:** Last night's loss was Indy's fifth on the homestand, marking the first time in five home series that the Indians have been handed a loss at Victory Field. The Indians won each of their first three homestands (4-2 vs. Memphis, 5-1 vs. St. Paul, 4-2 vs. Buffalo) before splitting last homestand with the Toledo Mud Hens, 3-3. Indianapolis' first series loss at home comes on the heels of their first road trip with more than one win, splitting a six-game series at Iowa from May 21-26.

**APRIL FLOWERS, MAY SHOWERS:** The Indians went 11-17 in the month of May, their worst record in the calendar month since going 11-18 in May in 2003. They alternated months with winning and losing records in 2023, finishing below .500 in April, June and August with winning records in May, July and September. The 2024 Indians are on the same trajectory, going 12-10 in April ahead of May. Despite the losing record, the Indians led the International League in batting average (.273) while ranking among team leaders in hits (2nd, 252), triples (2nd, 8), total bases (3rd, 411), on-base percentage (5th, .361) and RBI (T-5th, 147) in 28 May games.

**TONIGHT:** The Indians conclude their seven-game homestand vs. the Omaha Storm Chasers, Triple-A affiliate of the Kansas City Royals, today at 1:35 PM ET. Closing out the series today for Indianapolis will be RHP Drake Fellows (0-0, --), who was promoted from Double-A Altoona yesterday ahead of his Triple-A debut today. Countering for Omaha will be southpaw Anthony Veneziano (2-1, 4.08), who earned the win in Game 2 of Thursday's doubleheader with 1.0 inning in relief. He has made four appearances (two starts) vs. Indianapolis in his career, going 2-0 with a 3.29 ERA (5er/13.2ip) and 11 strikeouts.

**WELCOME, FELLOWS:** Right-handed pitcher Drake Fellows was promoted from Double-A Altoona yesterday and will make his first Triple-A start today after beginning the season with High-A Greensboro. He's been an effective arm in the Pirates farm system this season, going 2-0 with a 2.96 ERA (9er/27.1ip) and 29 strikeouts in nine appearances (two starts) between the two levels this season. He stunned Double-A batters in five appearances (two starts), logging a 1.59 ERA (3er/17.0ip) and 18 strikeouts in May. On May 17 at Akron, he fanned a career-high seven batters across 4.0 shutout frames. Fellows traded to Pittsburgh from San Diego in the three-team deal that saw Joe Musgrove to the Padres and Endy Rodriguez to the Pirates from New York (NL).

**THIS DATE IN 2012:** When Jeff Clement went up to the plate against Syracuse in the bottom of the seventh inning, a triple to center field secured a cycle for the Indy first baseman, just the third recorded by an Indian in the Victory Field era. His night started in the second inning with a double to center off Syracuse starting pitcher Tanner Roark. In his second at-bat, he stroked a soft line drive to center field for a single. Clement's sixth home run of the season came in the sixth inning to left field, putting him a triple shy of the cycle. The fly ball to center not only recorded Clement's cycle, it also extended the Indians lead over Syracuse and led to their 7-3 win.
