NOTES AND NUGGETS

ST. PAUL SLUGGING

The Storm Chasers' 15-12 win Sunday at CHS Field was one for the history books, both as a team and individually.

- Abraham Toro hit for the 6th cycle in modern Omaha history on Sunday, finishing the day 5-for-6 with 6 RBI ... he singled in the 2nd inning, tripled in the 3rd, hit a 2-run homer in the 5th and connected for a go-ahead 3-run double in the 8th to finish his cycle, later adding an RBI single in the 10th ... Sunday was Toro's 3rd career 5-hit game, while 6 RBI and 11 total bases set a new career high.
- 15 runs and 24 hits as a team were season-highs for Omaha ... 24 hits rank tied 6th-most in a game in modern Omaha history (since 2005), matching the Chasers' total from August 23, 2025 @ Columbus ... Toro's 5-hit game was the first since Rodolfo Durán went 5-for-5 (all singles) on September 3, 2024 @ Memphis.
- The 5-run deficit (trailing 10-5 after the 4th on Sunday) was Omaha's largest comeback win (by runs trailed) since coming back from down 5-0 on June 25, 2025 @ Indianapolis ... of Omaha's 137 comeback wins since 2023, this was just the 8th where the Chasers overcame a deficit of 5+ runs.

GOOD TIMES, BAD TIMES

- 2026 has been a roller coaster ride for Omaha, with up and down stretches.
- Of 12 series played this season, Omaha has won 5, lost 6 and split 2 ... The Storm Chasers have an 8-16 record over their last 24 games.
 - Omaha had a winning April, with a 13-12 record on the month ... with a 13-14 record in May, the Storm Chasers were one win away from having a winning record in back-to-back months for the first time since July and August 2024.
 - Omaha has been under .500 following 48 of their last 49 games (since April 24) and the Storm Chasers have spent just 18 days at or above .500.

COMEBACK KIDS

- The Storm Chasers have 20 comeback wins this season, while Omaha also has blown a lead in 22 losses.
- 20 comeback wins are tied for 5th-most in the International League, tied 9th in Triple-A ... 22 blown leads are tied for 2nd-most in the league, tied 5th in Triple-A.
 - The Storm Chasers have led at some point in 10 of their last 16 losses, including 3 games where the team led for over half the game.
 - In the last 39 games (since May 9), Omaha is 18-21 ... they have trailed at some point in 13 of 18 wins and led at some point in 12 of 21 losses, meaning 25 of Omaha's last 39 games have been a comeback win for one of the two teams ... in this stretch, 12 of 18 wins have been decided by 3 runs or less, while 15 of 21 losses have been decided by 3 runs or less ... 14 of the 39 games have been decided by 1 run ... Omaha's 15 losses by 1 run are the most in Triple-A.

YOU GO, WE GO, LUGO

- Matthew Lugo has been Omaha's best hitter in June since joining the Storm Chasers at the start of the month.
- Since the Royals claimed Lugo off waivers from the Angels on June 2, he has hit .381 (24-for-63) with 13 extra-base hits and 19 RBI in 15 games.
 - Lugo's 1.181 OPS since June 2 (min. 60 PA) ranks 5th in the International League ... his 17 RBI in 12 games since June 9 are also the 5th-most in the International League in that stretch.
 - Lugo has hits in 13 of 15 games with Omaha – including an extra-base hit in 10 of 15 – and has reached base in 14 of 15 ... he's driven in a run in 9 of 15 games, with 5 multi-RBI games ... he enters tonight's game on an 8-game hitting streak, with a .410 average (16-for-39) and 6 multi-hit games (4 straight) since June 13.

JUNE BUGS

- Beyond the offensive success from Matthew Lugo, he's had good company in Omaha's lineup in the month of June.
- Abraham Toro has hits in 14 of his 16 games, batting .355 (22-for-62) with 4 doubles, 3 triples, 4 homers and 18 RBI for a 1.122 OPS.
 - Peyton Wilson has hits in 12 of 15 games this month, batting .349 (22-for-63) this month with 9 doubles, 6 RBI and 7 walks for a .906 OPS, this month.
 - Josh Rojas has hits in 9 of his 11 games in June, batting .295 (13-for-44) with 3 doubles, 2 homers and 11 RBI for an .847 OPS.

TODAY'S START

- ✓ Bailey Falter is making his **2nd start** with the Storm Chasers this year, his **12th appearance with Omaha** and his **17th overall appearance** in 2026.
- ✓ Playing his **12th professional season** this year, the Royals are his 3rd MLB organization ... has played parts of 6 Major League seasons with Philadelphia (2021-23), Pittsburgh (2023-25) and Kansas City (2025-26).
- ✓ Falter will be making his 3rd start against the Clippers but 7th appearance against a Guardians affiliate ... he's faced Cleveland once in the Major Leagues and had 2 rehab starts in Columbus last year.

THE FALTER FILES

- ✓ **GETTING BACK ON TRACK:** Falter made the Royals' Opening Day roster and pitched in 2 games before he landed on Kansas City's injured list (*left elbow inflammation*) ... he appeared in 9 games with Omaha on a rehab assignment, but pitched to a 14.21 ERA (10 ER in 6.1 IP) in 3 games after returning to Kansas City and was subsequently designated for assignment and sent outright to the Minors.
- ✓ **TRIPLE-A TALENT:** Falter pitched in 9 games for the Storm Chasers while on a rehab assignment from April 15 to May 14 ... he struggled in his first game, but in the next 8 (April 19 to May 14), he worked a 1.46 ERA (2 ER in 12.1 IP) and ended his rehab stint with three straight scoreless appearances.
- ✓ **STARTER'S ORDERS:** Falter has primarily been used as a starter since his **2015** professional debut, totaling 189 starts between the Major and Minor Leagues compared to 47 relief appearances ... 74 of his first 75 minor league outings were starts (**2015-19**), as were 106 of 116 combined MLB and MiLB appearances from **2022-25** ... after making just 1 start in 22 MLB outings in **2021**, he returned to a starting role in **2022** ... Kansas City used him as a starter in his first 2 appearances after the trade from Pittsburgh before shifting him to the bullpen ... his 3 MLB appearances in **2026** came in relief ahead of a pair of opener starts prior to his DFA.

LAST OUTING: THURSDAY, JUNE 18 @ St. Paul [G1]

- ✓ Made his 1st start and 2nd appearance since being sent outright to Omaha, throwing a season-high 4.0 innings and 61 pitches ... worked around a walk for a scoreless 1st inning, before surrendering lone runs in the 2nd (sacrifice fly) and 3rd (*Gabriel Gonzalez* solo home run) ... stranded a leadoff single on base in the 4th inning for a scoreless frame ... did not come out for the 5th inning.

2026 HIGHLIGHTS

- ✓ Made the Royals Opening Day roster and pitched in 2 games, allowing 5 runs on 8 hits in 3.1 innings (13.50 ERA) before he was placed on the Injured List.
- ✓ Was on the Royals' 15-day Injured List from April 2 to May 15 ... appeared in 9 games out of the Storm Chasers' bullpen while on a rehab assignment before his activation
- ✓ Designated for assignment by Kansas City on May 27 and sent outright to Omaha on June 2

CAREER NOTES

2025:

- ✓ Split the year between the Pirates and Royals organizations, appearing in 26 games (24 starts) at the Major League level ... began the season with the Pirates and made 22 MLB starts, posting a 3.73 ERA (47 ER in 113.1 IP) with a 1.18 WHIP before moving to Kansas City.
