Tonight's Game: The Sounds face off against the Tides in the penultimate game of the regular season this evening at Harbor Park. Nashville took advantage of a fantastic outing by Mitch White and turned it into their first win of the series by a 5-3 final. Right-hander Chad Patrick goes for his 14th win of the season, facing off against right-hander Justin Armbruster at 5:35 p.m. central.

Chad Patrick: The 26-year-old makes his 26th appearance (24th start) for the Sounds this season. Nashville is 20-3 in games in which Patrick has started. He leads Triple-A in ERA (2.95), wins (13), WHIP (1.10) and win percentage (.929) and is second in opponents batting average (.219). He tossed six scoreless innings in his last outing on September 15 vs. Memphis while tying a career high with 12 strikeouts. Despite this, he left in a tie 0-0 game, getting a no-decision. Patrick has 10 quality starts on the season. He is riding a 12-game winning streak with his lone loss of the season occurring on May 3 vs. Norfolk. The Crown Point, Indiana native attended Purdue Northwest University where he was drafted in the fourth round by the Diamondbacks in 2021. He was traded at the 2023 trade deadline in exchange for Jace Peterson which landed him in Oakland and was traded again in the offseason for Abraham Toro to end up with Milwaukee. A win tonight would make Patrick the first Sounds pitcher with 14 wins in a season since Rodney Bolton in 1995.

Justin Armbruster: The 25-year-old gets the ball for his 29th appearance and 26th start of the season for the Tides. He is 5-10 with a 7.56 ERA (114.1 IP/96 ER) and one save. After having an extremely rough month of August (1-3, 12.46 ERA, 17.1 IP, 24 ER), Armbruster is 1-1 with a 4.50 ERA (14.0 IP/7 ER) in September. He entered in relief and got the win in his last performance on September 14 at Durham, going four innings while holding the Rays affiliate to one run (earned). Though looking for what would be his third win of the season at Harbor Park, Armbruster does have a 5.09 ERA at home compared to a 10.13 ERA on the road. The Washington state native held Oklahoma City to one run in five innings in the Triple-A Championship Game at Las Vegas Ballpark on September 30, 2023 - helping the Tides take home the title that night. A 12th round pick by Baltimore in 2021, Armbruster pitched collegiately at the University of New Mexico.

Emptying the Tank: Last night, Sounds starter Mitch White became just the fourth starter to get through seven innings this season. He threw a season high 99 pitches and 71 strikes - the 99 pitches are his most since June 6, 2022 with Los Angeles-NL vs. Washington (102), while the 71 strikes were his most since July 12, 2018 with Double-A Tulsa at Northwest Arkansas (78).

Yoho, Big Season Blowout: Craig Yoho picked up his first save at the Triple-A level, tossing a scoreless ninth inning and getting Nashville the 5-3 win. The right-hander boasts a 1.17 ERA (23.0 IP/3 ER), and has 46 strikeouts since joining Nashville on August 6. Between three levels, he has a 0.94 ERA (57.2 IP/6 ER) with 101 strikeouts. Earlier this week, Yoho was named a Midwest League All-Star for the season despite pitching his last game with High-A Wisconsin back on May 28.

Clarke Crushing: Wes Clarke hit an opposite field blast for his 17th home run as a Sound and 20th on the season in last night's win. The power hitter trails only Brewer Hicklen (22 HR) among Brewers minor league hitters.

Guitar Heros: Last Sunday, the Nashville Sounds presented the 2024 player awards. Brewer Hicklen and Isaac Collins were both awarded the team MVP award. Chad Patrick received the Pitcher of the Year honor. Vinny Capra was voted the Sounds Fan Favorite Player by fans on social media. Kevin Herget was also honored as the Community Player of the Year. Also, the team recognized athletic trainer Jeff Paxson on winning his second straight International League Trainer of the Year award.

Patrick is a Star: Chad Patrick dominated hitters once again last Sunday, striking out a dozen Redbirds across six scoreless innings in a no-decision. Patrick leads Triple-A in ERA (2.95), wins (13), WHIP (1.10), and win percentage (.929) and ranks among Triple-A qualified leaders in opponent batting average (T-2nd, .219), strikeouts (T-2nd, 138) and innings pitched (7th, 131.1). It was his 10th quality start of the season - he is one of seven pitchers in Triple-A with double-digit quality starts. The Sounds are 20-3 with Patrick on the mound. After Robert Gasser's 166 strikeouts last season, the Sounds have had a pitcher reach 135+ strikeouts in back-to-back seasons for the first time since 2002-2003 (Salomon Torres 136 in 2022, Ryan Vogelsong 146 in 2003).

The Sweet Life: Manager Rick Sweet is in his fourth consecutive season as the Sounds manager (5th overall) and his 34th season as a manager in MiLB. Sweet is the winningest manager in Nashville Sounds history - he has 397 wins in Nashville. This is his 11th season as manager of the Brewers' Triple-A affiliate and boasts a 758-650 record (Nashville in 2014, Colorado Springs from 2015-18, San Antonio in 2019 and Nashville 2021-). Overall, Sweet has a career managerial record of 2,351-2,170 - that's the fifth most wins in MiLB history and second among active managers (only Buddy Bailey with Single-A Myrtle Beach has more).

AGAINST OPPONENT: This is Patrick's second career start against Norfolk. His only outing against the Tides was his lone loss of the season on May 3. He gave up two runs (one earned) and had nine strikeouts.

- Tossed three scoreless innings in Sounds debut on April 7 vs. St. Paul
- Held Omaha to a couple of hits and a run over six innings for first quality start of season on April 19
- Picked up first win despite allowing a couple of home runs on April 26 at Louisville (5.1 IP, 8 H, 5 R, 5 ER, 3 BB, 6 K)
- Has won nine starts without taking a losing decision, dating back to May 16 at Jacksonville...has a 2.73 ERA (66.0 IP/20 ER), a 1.05 WHIP and .212 opponent batting average in that span
- Currently leads the International League in ERA, wins, WHIP (1.10) and win percentage (.929)...also ranks among league leaders in opponent batting average (2nd, .219), strikeouts (T-2nd, 138) and innings (6th, 131.1)
