On this day in 2022, the Sounds routed the Bats, 17-1, at Louisville Slugger Field. Ahead 4-0 after five innings, Nashville piled on seven runs in the sixth and three each in the eighth and ninth innings in the runaway tribatting average (T-2nd, .219), strikeouts (T-2nd, 138) and innings pitched (7th, 131.1). It was his 10th quality start of the season - he is one of seven pitchers in Triple-A with double-digit quality starts.

The Sounds are 20-3 with Patrick on the mound. After Robert Gasser's 166 strikeouts last season, the Sounds have had a nitcher roach 135 a triboaction between the same and mind minings in the full was (Tribus and Brian unph. Jonathan Davis, Sal Frelick and Brian Navarreto each had a home run, while Josh Lindblom struck out nine in seven scoreless innings. Cam Robinson took it the rest of the way and threw an immaculate inning to seal the deal in the ninth.

The Sweet Life: Manager Rick Sweet is in his fourth consecutive season as the Sounds manager (5th overall) and his 34th season as a manager in MiLB. Sweet is the winningest manager in Nashville Sounds history - he has 397 wins in Nashville. This is his 11th season as manager of the Brewers' Triple-A affiliate and boasts a 758-650 record (Nashville in 2014, Colorado Springs from 2015-18, San Antonio in 2019 and Nashville 2021-). Overall, Sweet has a career managerial record of 2,351-2,170 - that's the fifth most wins in MiLB history and second among active managers (only Buddy Bailey with Single-A Myrtle Beach has more).

AGAINST OPPONENT: This is Patrick's second career start against Norfolk. His only outing against the Tides was his lone loss of the season on May 3. He gave up two runs (one earned) and had nine strikeouts.
