Last season, the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders came to Werner Park to play the Omaha Storm Chasers (August 22-28) for the first time since the Chasers moved to the International League in 2021. The two teams split the series 3-3, with the RailRiders winning the first three, but Omaha taking the last three, including a doubleheader sweep on Sunday, August 28.

Prior to last season, the teams met for 12 games in what was the Triple-A alliance (1988-1991) when the Omaha Royals played in the American Association and the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre Red Barons played in the International League.

Omaha played 5 of those 12 games at what was then known as Lackawanna County Stadium, winning 2 of 3 in 1989 and split two games August 7-8 1990. (h/t Adam Marco)

MOOSIC, PENN. – The Omaha Storm Chasers tied Wednesday afternoon's game in the top of the ninth inning, but promptly lost to the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, 4-3 in the bottom of the 9th inning on a walk-off home run.

Center fielder Dairon Blanca opened the game's scoring in the top of the 3rd inning with a solo home run, his second long ball of the season ... the Chasers stayed ahead 1-0 until the 5th, when Tyler Gentry drew a bases-loaded walk to double the lead to two.

Omaha starting pitcher **Mike Mayers** cruised through four innings, holding the RailRiders to just a hit and two walks in that span ... Scranton/Wilkes-Barre turned things around in the 5th inning, as five straight reached against Mayers to open the fifth, and the RailRiders tied the game on a bases-loaded walk that ended Mayers'

of the Kalikiders tied the game on a bases-loaded walk that ended Mayers day.

While Jackson Kowar allowed the go-ahead run to score as he issued a bases-loaded walk as well to put Omaha down 3-2, he worked out of more trouble and threw a scoreless 6th inning. .. Collin Snider and Dylan Coleman put up hitless and scoreless 7th and 8th innings after Kowar, sending the game to the 9th with the RailRiders still leading the Storm Chasers 3-2.

Two walks and a hit batter loaded the bases for the Chasers in the top of the 9th inning with just one out, then Nick Loftin tied the game at 3-3 with a sacrifice fly to left field that scored Blanco.

The game did not stay tied for long, as Coleman surrendered a walk-off home run to designated hitter Michael Hermosillo, for a 4-3 loss and Omaha's third walk-off loss this season.

Blanco finished the day 2-for-3 with an RBI and two runs scored, also stealing his team-leading 18th base of the season.

NOTES AND NUGGETS ROLLING IN THE DEEP

After just 4.0 innings from **Mike Mayers** yesterday, Omaha starting pitchers have combined to throw 416.1 innings this seasons, the 5th-most among International League teams, however a 6.77 ERA from starters ranks as the worst in the 20-team league.

© Omaha starters have thrown at least 5.0 innings in 17 of 33 games this season, including 15 of the last 20, though Omaha starters have not gotten thorough four innings in the last four games ... in that 20-game stretch since April 18, the staff's 97.2 innings throw by Chasers starters are tied for the 4th-most of any Minor League club and tied-2nd in Triple-A.

© The last 20 games have featured five quality starts, from **Mike Mayers** (4/18 and 5/5), **Jonathan Heasley** (4/19), **Austin Cox** (4/27) and **Drew Parrish** (4/28).

© While they're generally going deep into games, Omaha starters are receiving an average of 2.36 runs of support per start ... they're 8-5 when getting a least 3 runs of support and 4-16 when getting 2 or less ... the starting staff has 7 games with 0 run support in their outing.

RALLY KILLERS

Omaha's infield has turned 34 double plays this season, while the offense has hit into 29, which rank tied for the 5th-most and 4th-most in the International League respectfully.

6 63 total double plays in 5torm Chasers games between those turned and hit into are the 2nd-most in the league, behind the Gwinnett Stripers (65).

6 Of those 63 double plays, 41 have been inning-ending double plays, the most of any team in the International League. The 22 inning-ending double plays the team has turned also lead the league, while they're second behind Charlotte in the most inning-ending double plays thit into.

7 4 double plays turned Tuesday was the 2nd-most they've turned in a game this year (5 on 4/1 @ IND) and yesterday's two made the 7th game this year they've turned multiple in one game.

WHEN THE HITS DON'T FALL

Omaha pitching allowed a season-low four hits in yesterday's game, but suffered the loss, the team's first loss of the season when allowing less than 6 hits.

Omaha has allowed 10+ hits in 16 of its 21 losses this season, with four losses with 6-9 hits allowed.

In 2022, Omaha lost just 1 game when allowing less than 5 hits, a 2-1 loss on August 14 @ Toledo, a feat the team had previously not suffered since June 2018 ... since 2005, Omaha is 180-27 (.870 winning %) in games where the team allows 5 hits or less.

The Chasers outhit the RailRiders 5-4 yesterday despite the loss ... since 2005, Omaha is 857-257 (.770 winning %) when outhitting their opponent.

BIG LEAGUE BUSINESS

Omaha has two Major League rehabbers right now: pitcher **Daniel Lynch** and outfielder **Drew Waters**, both opened the 2023 MLB season on Kansas City's 15-Day Injured List.

Lynch suffered a left shoulder strain (rotator cuff) and left his Cactus League start on March 23 @ San Diego ... has made two rehab starts already, one for Double-A Northwest Arkansas on Tuesday, May 2nd and most recently, on Sunday, May 7th for Omaha, as he threw 3.1 scoreless innings for the Chasers.

Waters begins his rehab assignment today after suffered a *left oblique strain* before Spring Training games began in February ... he began playing games in Extended Spring Training on April 17 before joining the Chasers yesterday.

- Mike Jirschele returns for his 15th season as Omaha's manager, his 18th season managing in Minor League Baseball and 32nd season overall with the Royals organization, named to the position of Storm Chasers manager on January 13, 2023, after previously managing Triple-A Omaha from 1995-97 and 2003-13.
- Jirschele served on the Kansas City Royals coaching staff as the Third Base Coach from 2014-19 and won the World Series in 2015. Jirschele most recently served as the bench coach under manager Chris Widger during the 2022 season with the Double-A Northwest Arkansas Naturals. He spent the 2021 season as Widger's bench coach for the High-A Central champion Quad Cities River Bandits and served as Special Assistant to the General Manager in 2020.
- In his second stint as Omaha's manager, over 11 years from 2003 to 2013, he led the team to four division titles, three consecutive trips to the Pacific Coast League Championship Series (2011-2013), two PCL titles (2011, 2013) and the team's first of two Triple-A National Championships in 2013.
- He earned the 2011 Mike Coolbaugh Award for outstanding baseball work ethic, knowledge of the game and skill in mentoring young players on the field and he is a four-time recipient of the Dick Howser Award (1992, 1994, 2005, 2011), recognizing outstanding work in player development within the Royals organization.
- Prior to his time with Omaha and Kansas City, he served as the Royals Minor League Infield Coordinator for four years, from 1998-2002, and he held managerial positions with Wilmington (1994), Rockford (1993) and the Gulf Coast Royals (1992).


