- The Blue Jays hung on for a dramatic 8-7 win in the series finale with Bradenton on Sunday.
- Dunedin struck first with RBI knocks from Victor Arias and Edward Duran in the third.
- Gage Stanifer delivered his best start of the season, firing five innings of one-run ball, striking out seven - both season highs.
- Tucker Toman and Manuel Beltre both homered to add insurance late in the game.
- Jean Joseph snapped out of a slump with a 3-5 performance.
- The Marauders got within two in the eighth with a 3-run homer from Shalin Polanco. Dunedin responded by scoring twice on a groundout to first that resulted in a controversial call that ruled Cristian Feliz safe at first.
- Bradenton opened the bottom of the ninth with five straight baserunners, but Felipe Bello stranded the tying run on first base to end the contest.

THE WEEK IN REVIEW

- The Blue Jays split their series with Bradenton, 3-3. Dunedin took the opener to extend their win streak to six, but then lost three straight before closing the series with back-to-back wins.
- The Blue Jays' pop took center stage, as the team hit seven homers in six games.
- All three Jays victories required a save. All but one game was decided by three or fewer runs.
- Dunedin's bullpen struggled, allowing 17 earned runs in 23.2 innings (6.46 ERA).

JAYS JUICE

After two more homers Sunday, the Blue Jays have homered in 12 of their last 14 games. Across that stretch, nine different players have gone deep. Dunedin is second in the Florida State League with 32 homers. Dunedin's 21 homers this month are the most in the FSL in May. In six games in Bradenton last week, the team went deep seven times.

TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

32 of the Blue Jays 45 games this season (71%) have been decided by four or fewer runs. Dunedin has an 15-16 record in those games. Dunedin has played 15 one-run games (7-8). Each of the Blue Jays' last six wins have required saves.

TAKE A WALK

This week's six game set pits the Florida State League's most walk-prone pitching staffs against each other. The Blue Jays have issued 232 walks to lead the league, while St. Lucie is not far behind with 229.

MAMAS BOY

Manuel Beltre has solidified his status as a mama's boy with his performances at the plate. On Mother's Day, Beltre went yard at Fort Myers on May 12. On Sunday, Mother's Day in the Dominican Republic, Beltre homered again.

RELYING ON RELIEF

Much of the Blue Jays' success this season has largely hinged on its bullpen, with distinct differences in relief performance in wins and losses. In wins, Jays relievers have pitched to a 3.03 ERA with a 1.19 WHIP. In losses, the bullpen has accumulated a 5.79 ERA with a 1.72 WHIP.

LATE MAGIC

Dunedin pushed in a run in four straight innings to finish the game on Sunday to secure the win. The Jays have tallied a run in the seventh or later in 16 of their last 18 contests. The Blue Jays hold a +8 run differential in the final three innings this season (81 runs scored, 73 runs allowed).

HOW ABOUT HERNANDEZ?

Alexis Hernandez had his best game of the season Saturday night, going 4-5 with a homer, double and 3 RBIs. Hernandez becomes the second D-Jay this season to collect four hits in a game, after Yhoangel Aponte collected two. After going homerless in his first 27 games, Hernandez went deep in back-to-back contests. With the four-hit night, Hernandez boosted his batting average from .169 to .205.
