PLAYOFF BOUND

The Omaha Storm Chasers won the International League 1st Half title with a 49-24 record and 3.5-game lead on second-place Syracuse to end the half, the best Minor League team in the 1st half of the 2024 season.
Winning the first half in the league secures the Storm Chasers home field advantage in the International League Championship Series, a best-of-three series that will be played at Werner Park from September 24 to 26.
This September will mark Omaha's first appearance in the playoffs since 2014, when the Chasers won their 2nd of back-to-back Triple-A National Championships.
The Triple-A Omaha franchise has 17 playoff appearances in the last 55 years, including most recently four straight seasons: 2011 to 2014.

NOTES AND NUGGETS IN GOOD STANDINGS

While the standings reset for the start of the 2nd half on June 25, Omaha's enters today 27 games over .500 with an overall 83-56 record (.597 winning percentage).
Of 120 full season Minor League teams, Omaha's .597 winning percentage overall this year is the 11th-best in the Minors ... the Tennessee Smokies (Cubs Double-A) are the best team in Minor League Baseball at 86-48 (.642 winning %).
83 wins are the 4th-most of any team in Minor League Baseball this season, 6 behind Sugar Land ... Omaha is 1 of 10 Minor League teams with 80+ wins.
The Chasers were previously 1st or 2nd in the Minors in wins every day between May 25 and September 6 ... Omaha held sole possession of the best winning percentage in full-season Minor League Baseball for 30 days, June 5 to July 5.
The 2024 Storm Chasers are on pace for 88 wins ... the franchise record is 86 wins from the Omaha Royals in 1990 ... **this means the 2024 Chasers are 4 wins away from breaking the wins record.**
The best winning percentage in Triple-A Omaha history was .607 (85-55) in the inaugural 1969 season.

TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

82 of Omaha's 139 games this year have been decided by 3 runs or less (59%), including 33 of 56 losses in 2024 (59%), with 18 of 56 losses by just one run (32%).
Omaha is 26-18 in 1-run games this season ... the Chasers have the 5th-most 1-run wins of any Minor League team ... Akron leads the Minors with 33 wins by 1 run.
Omaha's 38 saves are 2nd in the International League lead, tied for the 3rd-most at the Triple-A level and rank tied 9th in Minor League Baseball ... **Evan Sisk's** 13 saves overall this year rank 4th in the league ... he has 11 of the team's last 12 saves.

I'M DIFFERENT, YEAH, I'M (RUN) DIFFERENT(IAL)

Omaha has outscored its opponents 735 to 617 this season, a +118 run differential.
A +118 run differential this year ranks as the 2nd-best mark in the International League and 3rd at the Triple-A level, behind Worcester (+136) and Sugar Land (+125).
Omaha is T-13th in Minor League Baseball in run differential ... the Midland Rockhounds lead the Minors in run differential at +172 (659 to 487).

RELIEF AID

Omaha's bullpen has been one of the best across the entire Triple-A level in 2024.
The Storm Chasers relievers lead all Triple-A bullpens with a 3.64 ERA, 1.32 WHIP and .215/.321/.339 opposing slash line ... the .215 opponents' batting average ranks T-11th among all 120 full-season Minor League teams.
Omaha's bullpen has combined to not allow a run in 40 games this year (11 times in August and already 4 times in 8 September games), roughly one in every 3.70 games in 2024 ... the bullpen also has 20 games without a walk this season, including 11 times in the 2nd half of the season.

COMEBACK KIDS

Omaha has 44 come-from-behind wins this season, meaning over half (54%) of this year's wins have been games where the Chasers trailed at some point.
Omaha has trailed for 3 innings or more in 17 of the 44 comeback wins.
The Storm Chasers have 7 wins where the club had to overcome multiple deficits.
Omaha has 12 victories in games where the Chasers trailed after the 6th inning.
The Storm Chasers have come back from down as many as 5 runs to win and have overcome a 3+ run deficit to win on 13 occasions.

BEST OF THE BEST

With the Omaha Storm Chasers having a franchise-best year, the season has also seen several players set new career-bests.
John Rave has led the charge of having career year, setting personal bests already in runs (88), hits (120), doubles (30), triples (5) and home runs (20) ... he is also on base for the best average (.347), slugging percentage (.478) and OPS (.827) of his career ... Rave has played in 122 games this season, his career high is 124 last year.
Cam Devanney has set a personal best for runs batted in (71) this year, as has **Nate Eaton** (59 RBI) ... Eaton has also beat a career-best in home runs (16) this season ... Eaton's 23 steals tied his career high of 23 in a season.

- Lorenzen is making his 1st start with Omaha, his 5th Minor League start and his 29th overall appearance this season ... currently on Major League rehab with a left hamstring strain, suffered in the 2nd inning of his start August 27 @ Cleveland.

LAST OUTING: TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 10 VS. ARKANSAS (DOUBLE-A)

Sent to Double-A Northwest Arkansas at the beginning of this week and opened Tuesday's game for the Naturals, the first of 8 pitchers in the game ... threw 38 pitches over 1.2 innings ... 4 singles to the first 5 hitters of the game placed 2 runs in the top of the 1st inning, a 23-pitch inning ... allowed a walk and single to open the 2nd inning, before 2 groundouts wrapped up his outing.

2024 HIGHLIGHTS

- Signed a one-year deal with Texas at the end of Spring Training, March 22 ... six days later, he landed on the Injured List with a right neck strain that kept him out of big league action through mid-April ... made 3 rehab starts in Triple-A, reinstated April 15 made his Rangers debut in Detroit, where he threw 5.0 shutout innings in a 1-0 victory against his former club.

CAREER NOTES

- Named an American League All-Star with Detroit, set Major League career highs in innings (153.0), starts (25), strikeouts (111) and wins (9) between the Tigers and Phillies.

MLB CAREER

- Has accumulated a 11.8 bWAR in his 10-year Major League career ... 92 of 366 games he's pitched in the big leagues have been starts, including 66 of 71 since 2022 ... has pitched in MLB for Cincinnati (2015-21), the Angels (2022), Detroit (2023), Philadelphia (2023), Texas (2024) and Kansas City (2024).

QUICK NOTES

2024: Opened the season with Omaha and 24 of 31 Triple-A appearances have been scoreless, including a span of 12 outings in a row, 14.2 scoreless innings between April 23 and June 4 ... contract was selected by Kansas City June 10, pitched in 5 games (3.2 IP), landed on the 15-day injured list June 20 with a right lat strain, transferred to the 60-Day IL July 5 ... sent to Omaha on rehab August 6, allowed runs in 4 of 8 games ... DFA'd 9/5, sent outright 9/7.
Joins the Royals in 2024 to mark his 4th MLB organization ... spent parts of the first 7 seasons of his professional career from 2014-20 with Seattle before being traded to San Diego for two seasons (2020-21) and spending two seasons with Boston (2022-23) ... signed as a minor league free agent with the Royals last December.
Over parts of 6 Major League seasons, he has appeared in 119 MLB games (all in relief) with a 8-7 record and 4.03 ERA (52 ER in 116.0 IP) and 129 strikeouts to 60 walks ... his last MLB outing was on April 16, 2021 vs. Los Angeles (NL) ... has had five Injured List stints since reaching the Majors, including four for right arm injuries ... spent all of 2022 and most of 2023 rehabbing from Tommy John Surgery he underwent in April 2021, after pitching just two games that season with the Padres.
In 2023, he made 8 rehab appearances between the FCL Red Sox (R) and Greenville Drive (A+), with 7 strikeouts in 12.0 innings during July and August.

2024: Tied 6th in the league in wins (9) ... opened the year in Omaha's rotation and made 16 starts across 2 stints with the Storm Chasers, with 5 quality starts ... called up to Kansas City on April 29 to make a start at Toronto, but took the loss in 2.2 IP (4 ER on 6 H) and was optioned the next day ... made his first relief appearance of the season July 19 vs. IND, a scoreless inning ... his first 4 relief appearances this year were scoreless and 10 of 16 total with Omaha ... recalled to Kansas City 7/30, optioned 8/1 without getting in a game ... threw an immaculate 7th inning 9/7 @ Memphis, in his hometown.
Opened 2023 at NW Arkansas (AA), earned his first promotion to Triple-A on 6/20, made 14 appearances (12 starts) for Omaha with 3 of his last 4 starts with the Storm Chasers being quality starts ... earned his first big league call-up on 9/19, called up by the Royals for the first time 669 days after being added to the 40-man roster (on 11/19/2021), made his MLB debut 8 days later on 9/27 at Detroit as the Royals' opener ... allowed a solo homer to Miguel Cabrera in the 2nd inning, Miggy's final MLB homer.
Underwent Tommy John Surgery on 6/1/2021 ... returned to the mound 6/17/2022 with the Arizona Complex League Royals (R) ended the year at NW Arkansas (AA).
Father, Mark, threw the lone perfect game in the history of the University of Memphis program and pitched 2 seasons (44 games) in the St. Louis Cardinals system (1989 & 1991).

2024: Opened the year with NW Arkansas (AA) and made 24 appearances (7 starts) for the Naturals, going 2-3 with a 2.78 ERA (25 ER in 58.1 IP) ... struck out 81 batters in Double-A (12.50) and made 12 scoreless appearances, including 1 start ... all 7 starts at Double-A came in a 10-appearance span between April 14 and June 8 ... transferred to Omaha August 5 ... 6 of 10 Storm Chasers appearances have been scoreless.
Spent most of 2023 with Quad Cities (A+), but pitched in 3 games at NW Arkansas (AA) to end the season as well ... between the two levels, struck out 99 strikeouts across 76.1 innings pitched with a 3.66 ERA (31 ER) ... pitched for Surprise in the Arizona Fall League and went 2-0 with 18 strikeouts across 12.0 innings, while earning the victory in the championship game with 2.0 innings of 1-run ball and 3 strikeouts.
Pitched 3 years collegiately at Mississippi State University, where he won the 2021 College World Series with the Bulldogs ... selected in the 30th round of the 2018 MLB Draft by Tampa Bay, but elected to attend college instead of sign ... also selected in the 8th round of the 2016 Ontario Hockey League draft.

2024: Opened the year on Omaha's Injured List ... assigned to NW Arkansas (AA) on April 16 and pitched 5.1 scoreless innings for the Naturals (4 outings) ... assigned to Omaha for his 4th season with the Chasers on April 29 ... has largely pitched in relief this year, with 5 opener starts ... 18 of 33 appearances with Omaha have been scoreless ... has 11 outings of 2.0 innings or more, 7 of them out of the bullpen ... had an opt-out with his contract July 11, re-signed with KC July 16 ... worked 15.0 straight scoreless innings between June 6 and July 23.
Opened the 2023 season with Omaha and pitched in 5 games (4 starts) before his contract was selected by Kansas City on May 3, threw 2.0 scoreless innings in MLB Debut on 5/4 vs. BAL ... totaled 3 stints with each Omaha and Kansas City by the end of the season ... 4 of 12 appearances with Omaha were scoreless, including 3 starts.
Began MLB career retiring 35 of his first 39 batters across 6 relief appearances, allowed 4 walks ... 39 batters without allowing a hit marked the longest streak in the Expansion Era.
Spent the entire 2022 season with Omaha ... made 29 appearances (24 starts) for the Storm Chasers with a 4.21 ERA (69 ER in 147.1 IP) and 105 strikeouts.
