Dayton took a 1-0 lead in the second when Victor Ruiz reached on an error, moved to third on a James Free double, then scored on a Miguel Hernandez groundout. In the third the Dragons loaded the bases on three straight singles with nobody out, but they could only push across one run after the Captains turned a double play and registered another groundout. Another Captains error hurt them in the fourth inning. After another Free double, Hernandez singled to center. After Quentin Holmes fired home Hernandez moved to second. Bryan Lavastida fired to second but the throw went back into center field and under Holmes glove for an error allowed Free to score. A sacrifice fly later in the frame drove in Hernandez to put the Dragons on top 4-0. Lake County mustered one run in the top of the eight on a Brayan Rocchio walk. He advanced to second on a wild pitch, then scored on a George Valera single to make the score 4-1.

SPUTTERING OFFENSE: Since the Captains scored 13 runs on July 17th at Lansing the offense has gone quiet. Since then Lake County has scored the third fewest runs in the league (42) and second from the bottom in OPS (.646). The pitching staff has also allowed the second most runs (71) and recorded the second highest ERA (5.42).

DRAGON SLAYERS: José Tena, Aaron Bracho, Joe Naranjo, and Will Brennan have done the most damage of any Captains against Dayton pitching this year. Tena is 10-for-31 (.323) with a homer, three doubles and a triple. Bracho has recorded a .973 OPS with two homers and five walks against Dayton. Naranjo has gone 7-for-20 (.350) with a home run and seven walks. Brennan has gone 8-for-23 (.348) with two homers, two doubles and 10 RBI.

SUPER NOVA: Victor Nova has hit .305/.408/.593 (1.002 OPS) in the month of July. Over the first two months of the season, he hit .179/.295/.241 (.536 OPS) with one home run in 37 games. Nova, however, is currently in the midst of a home run drought. After hitting four homers in the first six games of July, Nova has not homered since July 10 at Fort Wayne.

LEADERBOARD: Captains OF **Will Brennan** and INF **José Tena** are neck-and-neck on the High-A Central League leaderboards. Tena is eighth in average (.289) and tied for eighth in doubles (16). Brennan is sixth in batting average (.290) and second in doubles (22).

TAKE YOUR BASE: George Valera ranks fifth in the High-A Central League (minimum 160 PA) with a 16.4 BB%.

CONTACT HITTERS: Will Brennan has the eighth-lowest SwStr% (8.3) and the 12th-lowest K% (16.0) in the High-A Central League (minimum 160 PA). Bryan Lavastida has the seventh-lowest K% (15.2%).

HOME COOKIN' TASTES BETTER: The Captains are 20-10 at home, compared to 19-26 on the road. Captains pitchers have experienced the biggest home/road disparity. Lake County has a 3.79 ERA at Classic Park and a 4.79 ERA on the road.

ALUMNI UPDATE: 2017 Captains RHP Justin Garza became the 102nd former Captain to reach the major leagues when he debuted for Cleveland on June 27. A record 10 former Captains have made their major league debuts this year – OF Ka'ai Tom (2016), RHP Luis Oviedo (2018-19), LHP Sam Hentges (2016), RHP Louis Head (2012-13), RHP Nick Sandlin (2018), INF Ivan Castillo (2014), Jean Carlos Mejia (2018), RHP Eli Morgan (2018), INF Ernie Clement (2018) and Garza. That breaks the record for the most former Captains to debut in a single year, besting the nine alumni that debuted in 2013 and 2016.

DEFENSIVE FLEXIBILITY: The Captains' have shuffled their defenders in 2021. Lake County has used four different first baseman, six different second baseman, six different third basemen and two different shortstops. Raynel Delgado, Brayan Rocchio and José Tena have each played three different infield positions. Victor Nova and Daniel Schneemann have played two different infield positions and left field.

LAST TIME OUT: Espino worked five innings on the mound against Great Lakes last Friday, battling with former top Dodgers picks Clayton Beeter and Bobby Miller. Espino allowed four runs on two home runs with four strikeouts in his five innings of work, but was outdueled by the Loons. Miller and Beeter combined for seven no-hit innings and ten strikeouts while the Loons finished off their franchise's first no-hitter in a 14-0 win.

PROSPECTING: Espino ranks as Cleveland's #2 prospect according to FanGraphs, #4 by MLB.com and #3 by Baseball America.

TOP PICK: Cleveland drafted Espino with their first round pick (24th overall) in the 2019 MLB Draft. The right-hander earned a \$2.5 million signing bonus. He was committed to play at Louisiana State University before signing with Cleveland.

SCOUTING REPORT: "Espino works at 94-97 mph and can touch triple digits with his fastball, imparting running life on his four-seamer and heavy sink on his two-seamer. He backs up his heat with a pair of batmissing breaking balls, with his low-80s slider sharper and grading better than his high-70s curveball. His changeup is more of a work in progress that gets too firm at times but also features some promising sink." (Source: *MLB.com*)

SCOUTING GRADES: Fastball – 70; Slider – 60; Curveball – 55; Changeup – 50; Control – 50; Overall – 50 (Source: *MLB.com*)

PANAMA → GEORGIA: Espino was born and grew up in Panama, but moved to the United States when he was a sophomore in high school and pitched for Georgia Premier Academy in Statesboro, GA. As Mandy Bell wrote in her *MLB.com* article on Espino, Espino spent time in the U.S. for baseball when he was 10 and decided then that he wanted to move there. When Daniel was 15, he went to his parents and told them he needed to move to the United States to pursue his baseball dreams. When asked about his decision to move to the U.S., Espino said "My mom and dad wanted me to finish high school first and then worry about the next, but I love playing baseball. I had the opportunity to [visit America] when I was 10 years old and I loved it. Now, the sacrifice is paying off (Source: *The Record-Courier*).

PANAMANIAN ROLE MODEL: Espino idolized Panamanian star and Hall of Fame closer Mariano Rivera as a child.

FIRST SINCE FRANCISCO: When he advanced to Mahoning Valley in 2019, Espino became the first high schooler promoted by Cleveland to the Short Season level since Francisco Lindor in 2011.

2020: Pitched at Classic Park, which was Cleveland's alternate training site, before doing remote development prior to the fall instructional league. Espino did not pitch at instructs due to a minor shoulder injury (Source: *FanGraphs*).

2019: Made his professional debut in the Rookie Level Arizona League and posted a 1.98 ERA before being bumped up to Short Season Mahoning Valley. Espino posted a 6.30 ERA with the Scrappers over three starts. Though he made nine starts and did not make any relief appearances, Espino never pitched more than four innings in a single professional game during his debut season.
