THIS DATE IN HISTORY

On April 28, 2012, the Sounds won at Iowa, 3-0, to snap a 10-game losing streak. Mike Fiers tossed six shutout innings to help erase the skid while Brooks Conrad had a double, triple, and a pair of walks.

Today's Game: The Nashville Sounds and St. Paul Saints battle in game three of the six-game series tonight. Right-handed pitcher Caleb Boushley goes for his third win of the season for the Sounds. Right-handed pitcher Ronny Henriquez starts for St. Paul.

Caleb Boushley: 28-year-old Caleb Boushley makes his fifth start of the season. He is 2-2 with a 3.79 ERA (19.0 IP/8 ER). The Hortonville, Wis. native last pitched on April 23 vs. Charlotte. He allowed two hit and a run (ER) for his second win. He pitched five innings, walking two hitters while striking out six. Boushley went 5-11 with a 5.21 ERA (80.0 IP/52 ER) between Triple-A El Paso (16) and Double-A San Antonio (8) in the Padres organization. He was drafted by Milwaukee in the Triple-A Phase of the 2021 Rule 5 Draft. Originally, Boushley was drafted by San Diego in the 33rd Round of the 2017 MLB First-Year Player Draft out of Wisconsin-La Crosse.

Ronny Henriquez: 21-year-old Ronny Henriquez gets the ball for St. Paul in game three. The right-handed pitcher is 0-0 with a 0.00 ERA (3.0 IP/0 ER) in one previous appearance. He is the No. 14 prospect in the Twins organization according to MLB.com. Henriquez entered in relief on April 21 at Toledo. He did not allow any hits or runs in 3.0 innings. He walked one batter with four strikeouts. The Bonao, Dominican Republic native was traded to the Twins on March 12, 2022 (with 3B Isiah Kiner-Falefa) in exchange for C Mitch Garver. Henriquez split the 2021 season between High-A Hickory and Double-A Frisco in the Rangers farm system. He combined to go 5-7 with a 4.71 ERA (93.2 IP/49 ER) in 21 outings (16 starts). Henriquez was signed as a free agent on July 3, 2017, by the Rangers.

Brice is Nice: Shortstop Brice Turang singled in the 10th inning yesterday to extend his hitting streak to seven games. During the seven-game streak, Turang is hitting .452 (14-for-31) with 3 runs, 4 doubles, 7 RBI and 2 walks.

Dahl's Turnaround: Outfielder David Dahl had a rough start to the 2022 season, hitting .071 (1-for-14) through the first four games. Since then, Dahl has reached base in 10-straight games and has hit safely in eight of those 10. During the 10-game stretch since April 12, Dahl is hitting .385 (15-for-39) with 9 runs, 2 doubles, 2 home runs, 8 RBI and 4 walks.

Three and Counting: The Sounds turned in their third straight series win to start the season by taking five of six from Charlotte. The last time a Nashville club won its first three series of the season was in 2003. Back in '03, the Sounds played Iowa and Albuquerque, and went 6-0 with a pair of three-game sweeps after both finales were postponed due to rain. They then went on the road to Iowa and won three of four. The Sounds returned home to welcome Memphis for a four-game series and swept the Redbirds to improve to 13-1 on the season.

Mistakes Happen: A dropped fly ball by Pablo Reyes (E-7) brought Nashville's errorless streak to an end after 101 innings yesterday. The last error they had committed prior was on April 14 at Gwinnett. The Sounds boast the best fielding percentage in the International League at .989.

Earn It: Nashville's team ERA sits at 2.54 (177.0 IP/50 ER) after the extra-inning loss yesterday afternoon. The 2.54 ERA is the lowest in Minor League Baseball, ahead of Single-A Lake County's 2.69 ERA.

Magnifico Mejía: J.C. Mejía pitched a season-high 2.0 scoreless innings to force extras yesterday, adding a couple more strikeouts. In seven relief appearances, he boasts a 1.08 ERA (8.1 IP/1 ER) with 12 strikeouts.

Still on Hold: Nashville relievers have amassed 18 holds this season which is tied for the most in the International League. Lehigh Valley also has 18 holds, while Columbus has 15.

How Sweet It Is: Sounds manager Rick Sweet begins his third season overall and second consecutive season at the helm of the Nashville club. Sweet led the Sounds to a 70-58 record in 2021 and a 77-67 record in 2014. He has served as the manager for Milwaukee's Triple-A club since the 2014 season.

The Future Brew Crew: Nashville opened the 2022 season with four players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects. Infielder Brice Turang is the No. 4 prospect, left-handed pitcher Ethan Small is the No. 7 prospect, catcher Mario Feliciano is the No. 21 prospect and right-handed pitcher Dylan File is the No. 25 prospect.
