FISHER CATS SPLIT SECOND CONSECUTIVE DOUBLEHEADER WITH SOMERSET: Following a split of the doubleheader on Thursday night, the Fisher Cats split another doubleheader on Saturday before rain forced the cancellation of Sunday's series finale. It was the tale of two very different games, as the Fisher Cats held Somerset to just three hits in game one before being held to just two hits of their own in game two.

TIME TO PONY UP? The Fisher Cats are facing off with a Binghamton team that has struggled to begin the season. The Rumble Ponies lost their first 10 games, and lost 14 of their first 15 games, and to date have only mustered four wins on the year. This series marks the first time Binghamton faces off with a team in the AA-Northeast Northeast division, having previously played four times against AA-Northeast Southeast divisional foes. The Fisher Cats are 148-151 all time against the Rumble Ponies, and could even up the all-time record this series.

IT'S MILLER TIME: RHP Troy Miller, who is scheduled to start Thursday's game, threw five full scoreless innings in his Double-A debut against Somerset. After his initial proposed debut was rained out, Miller wound up dealing in the second game of a double-header, recording three strikeouts.

BOB LIPMAN'S THIS DATE IN FISHER CATS HISTORY: June 1, 2010---After letting an early 7-1 lead evaporate at Reading, the Fisher Cats scored just enough late for a 12-10 win over the Phils. Shawn Bowman (3-for-4, 4 RBI) and Brian Jeroloman had late homers to lift New Hampshire.

MANCHESTER BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS: This week, Buffalo will be hosting the Syracuse Mets in Trenton. Vancouver will face Eugene in a battle of two of the league's best teams. Dunedin returns to TD Ballpark to face Bradenton; Dunedin had been temporarily displaced as the Toronto Blue Jays were using their stadium. The Blue Jays open up a series with the Miami Marlins at Sahlen Field in Buffalo, returning to their 2020 home for the first time this season.

COMING UP: The Fisher Cats get their first look at Binghamton (New York Mets) this week before heading to face a familiar foe, the Portland Sea Dogs, next week.

ROSTER MOVES: **May 27:** Outfielder Brock Lundquist activated from IL and catcher Rodrigo Vigil placed on development list. **May 29:** RHP James Dykstra placed on the 7-day Injured List.

ON THE HILL: Kyle Johnston gets the start for the Fisher Cats in lieu of his scheduled start on Sunday, which was rained out. Johnston is coming off of his most impressive outing of the season, in which he carried a no-hitter into the fifth and only conceded one hit, lowering his era to 1.47 on the year in the process. For the Rumble Ponies, Tony Dibrell will get the start. Last time out, Dibrell picked up his first decision of the year, a loss against Akron in which the former fourth-rounder went four innings, giving up three runs (all earned). Dibrell started off the season in the bullpen and has recently been moved into a starter's role.
