ABOUT LAST NIGHT: OF Joe Suozzi crushed a grand slam and RHP Dominic Hamel tossed five innings of one-run ball as the Brooklyn Cyclones evened the series with Wilmington with an 8-1 victory in game two. Brooklyn took an early 2-0 lead but scored six runs in the top of the fourth against the Blue Rocks. C Jose Mena stayed hot, collecting two more hits and is now 5-8 with four RBIs over the first two games of the series.

DIVISION ON THE LINE: Including today, the Cyclones have 28 games remaining and five series: six at Wilmington, six vs. Hudson Valley, six at Jersey Shore, six vs. Wilmington, and six at Winston-Salem. Brooklyn is vying for a playoff spot with a second half division title in the North Division of the South Atlantic League, sitting a 1/2-game behind Hudson Valley for first place.

FEELING BLUE: Brooklyn has dropped 10 of 17 games against Wilmington this season with a run differential of -16. The Cyclones have only fared worse against Aberdeen (5-13) this season but in those games, Brooklyn has been outscored by 15.

MASTERS OF THEIR DOMAIN: The Cyclones have allowed the fewest runs in the league in the second half and overall. Brooklyn ranks first in the North Division with a +25 run differential head of Hudson Valley's +23. The Cyclones have allowed just 136 runs over 38 games (3.6 runs/game) in the second half. The next-closest team is Hudson Valley, allowing 4.1 runs per game in the second half.

ROAD WARRIORS: OF Alex Ramirez and OF Stanley Consuegra have done big damage away from Maimonides Park this summer. At home, the pair have combined to hit just 28-139 (.201) with 12 doubles, a triple, and two home runs. On the road, the two have combined to hit 29-86 (.337) with four doubles, one triple, and six home runs.

vs. WILMINGTON: The Washington Nationals affiliate now hosts the organization's No. 1 prospect OF Robert Hassell III after the OF Juan Soto and INF Josh Bell deal between Washington and San Diego. The Blue Rocks are also home to seven other Top 30 prospects: No. 10 RHP Gerardo Carrillo, No. 14 INF Yasel Antuna, No. 16 OF Jeremy De La Rosa, No. 18 LHP Mitchell Parker, No. 22 C Drew Millas, and No. 25 LHP Dustin Saenz.

PROMOTIONS: C/INF Nic Gaddis and OF Rowdey Jordan were both promoted to Double-A Binghamton on Monday. Gaddis, the Mets' 16th round selection in 2019 earned his second promotion to Double-A, while Jordan, New York's 11th round pick in 2021, leaps up to Double-A for the first time.

HELP IS ON THE WAY, DEARY: Three players were promoted from Low-A St. Lucie to High-A Brooklyn ahead of this week in Delaware. No. 25 Mets prospect RHP Christian Scott, INF William Lugo, and RHP **Jeffrey Colon** have all been added to the roster.

PEROZA PRODUCING: Since July 9, INF Jose Peroza has a OPS of .852 over his past 24 games with an 11-game on-base streak. The Mets No. 29 prospect has been on base in 22 of the past 24 games, hitting .299 with a .392 OBP.

RA-RA RAMIREZ: No. 4 Mets prospect OF Alex Ramirez is ranks second behind Triple-A INF Brett Baty with 106 hits -- one behind Baty's 107. The 19-year-old Dominican leads the organization with seven triples.

SUOZZI SWATTING: OF Joe Suozzi has hit three homers over his past 13 games, hitting .311 with a .970 OPS. In the stretch, Suozzi is 14-for-45 with 10 RBIs. Suozzi is tied with OF Jaylen Palmer for the team lead in home runs with seven long balls.

NICE TO MEET ASKEW: Former Clemson Tiger Keyshawn Askew makes his second start for the Cyclones.

PROMOTION!: Askew made 13 appearances with Low-A St. Lucie and four starts, tossing 46.1 IP and posting a 1.93 earned run average. Askew struck out 64 batters and walked 19, allowing six hit batters and three home runs. In his final outing before the promotion, Askew struck out eight Palm Beach Cardinals on July 30th.

INJURED LIST STINT: Askew made four appearances with $\frac{1/8}{7/14}$ Low-A St. Lucie this spring before landing on the injured list, missing April 28-June 6.

MEET THE METS: The Mets selected Askew in the 10th round in 2021 out of Clemson University in the Atlantic Coast Conference, signing him for \$125K. Askew was one of six Tigers selected last year. Only Seattle SS James Parker was selected higher (eighth round).

COLLEGE: Was a weekend starter for Clemson in 2021, working his way back from missing the first 12 games of the season with a leg injury. Made a total of 21 starts and 33 appearances across three years with Clemson.
