**JUMBO SHRIMP OFFENSE STRUGGLES IN 5-0 LOSS**  
The Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp mustered just one hit on Friday in a 5-0 loss to the Sugar Land Space Cowboys. The Jumbo Shrimp were no-hit through eight innings until **Kemp Alderman** singled to lead off the ninth. By that point, the Space Cowboys had a big advantage. Sugar Land plated three in the first on a two-run home run by **Cavan Biggio** and an RBI single by **Jax Biggers**. Biggio added an RBI single in the fifth. In the ninth, the Space Cowboys made it 5-0 on **Jack Winkler's** RBI single. **Josh Ekness** went 3.0 innings of relief for the Jumbo Shrimp.

### IT'S NOT HOW YOU START

At 1-6, Jacksonville is off to its worst start since at least the 2004 season. The good news for this year's Jumbo Shrimp is that the last time a Jacksonville club was in a similar spot was in 2022, when the Jumbo Shrimp started 1-5 and 2-7 before rebounding to finish that season 80-69 (.537). Heading into play on Saturday, Jacksonville has lost four in a row - in comparison, the 2025 Triple-A National Champion Jumbo Shrimp did suffer three losing streaks of at least four games during the regular season.

### GOOD MORNING, GOOD AFTERNOON, GOODNIGHT

Jacksonville has recorded double-digit strikeouts in all but one game thus far in 2026, with the lone exception being a nine-punchout performance on March 29 against Rochester. Jumbo Shrimp hurlers have tallied at least 14 strikeouts in each of the last four games, totaling 57 against 17 walks during that span. As a result, heading into play on Saturday, Jacksonville leads all of Triple-A with 86 strikeouts on the season. The club's pitchers have combined to fan 26.7 percent of opposing hitters (MLB average: ~24.1%).

### GET 'EM ON, GET 'EM OVER, GET 'EM IN

Jacksonville ranks last in Triple-A in batting average on balls in play (BABIP) at just .199, a figure far below the baseball-wide average in the range of .290-.300. The club's lack of luck has been most evident with the bases empty. With no one on, the Jumbo Shrimp rank last in Triple-A in batting average (.135), sporting a woeful .135/.268/.198/.466 line. Jacksonville has been only slightly better in the young season with runners in scoring position, hitting .140/.261/.281/.542 as a team.

### RECORDS ARE MADE TO BE BROKEN

Jacksonville set franchise-records in 2025 in stolen bases (305) and pitching strikeouts (1,344). The club also neared a pair of other records; The Jumbo Shrimp used a whopping 90 players last season, matching the club record set in 2024. Of those 90 players, 49 were pitchers, just two away from tying another club record set in 2024. Jacksonville logged 35 different starting pitchers, smashing the previous record of 28 set in 2024. At VyStar Ballpark, the club's 44 home victories in 2025 were their most at home since 2010 (also 44), while their 45 road triumphs were their most in recorded club history (since at least 2005).

### STRESS RELIEF

Jacksonville's bullpen was arguably the club's biggest strength in their 2025 championship run, with the club leading Triple-A in ERA (3.64) and batting average against (.214) while also throwing the fifth-most innings (700.2) of any bullpen at the level. However, through seven games in 2026, that strength has turned into an early weakness; the Jumbo Shrimp bullpen has surrendered 24 runs, 23 earned, on 33 hits (.235 BAA) in 36.1 innings for a 5.70 ERA that ranks 22nd in Triple-A. One positive is that Jacksonville relievers have combined for 54 strikeouts (13.4 K/9), more than any other bullpen at the level.

### MEN OF STEAL

In 2024, the Jumbo Shrimp mustered only 86 stolen bases, 29th in Triple-A and 119th out of the 120 MiLB teams. Jacksonville was not much better in the 2023 (124 steals, 20th in Triple-A) nor 2022 (114, 23rd in Triple-A) campaigns. In 2025, the Jumbo Shrimp swiped a franchise-record 305 bags, second-most in Triple-A and sixth-best in MiLB. Jacksonville, which had not finished in the top five at their level in stolen bases since at least 2005, had more games with multiple stolen bases (84) in 2025 than games with either one steal (32) or no steals (34) combined.

### SHRIMP BITES

Jacksonville has five hits or fewer in four of their seven games... The Jumbo Shrimp have lost each of their first two series of the season. It took Jacksonville nine sets last season to record their second series defeat... **Nathan Martorella** is tied for eighth in the IL in RBIs (7).

### ABOUT BRADLEY

-Blalock was high school teammates with fellow future major leaguer Parker Meadows at Grayson High School (Loganville, Ga.). The Boston Red Sox selected Blalock in the 32nd round of the 2019 MLB draft.

-After not playing in a game in 2020 because of the COVID-19 pandemic, Blalock wound up missing all of the 2022 season due to Tommy John surgery.

-The Red Sox traded Blalock on August 1, 2023 for infielder Luis Urias.

-On May 20, 2024, Blalock was promoted to the major leagues for the first time. However, he was optioned back to Biloxi on May 24, briefly becoming a phantom ballplayer (a player who spent time on an MLB active roster without ever appearing in a game). That designation changed on June 20, 2024, when Blalock made his major league debut for the Brewers with a scoreless inning against the Padres in San Diego.

-Blalock was traded for the second time in his career on July 27, 2024. He was sent along with right-handed pitcher Yujanyer Herrera to the Colorado Rockies for right-hander Nick Mears.

-The Rockies designated Blalock for assignment following the signing of right-hander Michael Lorenzen on January 18, 2026. He was traded to the Miami Marlins five days later for right-hander Jake Brooks.

-Blalock found Kevin Gausman's split change on the internet and used the grip as a model for himself. He liked the pitch's versatility as an option to both righties and lefties and the fact that it is both a "velocity and movement separator."

-Blalock struggled at Coors Field in Denver; he had a 2-4 record and 12.27 ERA in seven appearances, including six starts, at home (29.1 IP, 50 H, 40 R, 40 ER, 9 HR, 14 BB, 9 K, .388 BAA). He was slightly better in seven appearances, including six starts, on the road for Colorado, going 0-2 with a 6.44 ERA (29.1 IP, 35 H, 21 R, 21 ER, 8 HR, 9 BB, 18 K, .307 BAA).
