NEWS & NOTES

LAST TIME OUT: CHIEFS 9, RIVER BANDITS 8

Trailing by six early, Michael Dattalo's go-ahead three-run homer in the top of the ninth lifted the Chiefs over the River Bandits for their largest comeback win of the season last night at Modern Woodman Park...Chiefs starter Leonel Sequera struggled early, allowing three runs in each of the first two innings and the Chiefs trailed 6-0...Luis Pino RBI's single got the Chiefs on the board in the third before Josh Kross' leadoff homer in the fourth, cutting the deficit to 6-2...Sequera allowed six runs on seven hits over four innings, walking two and striking out four...The Chiefs erased the deficit in the sixth on Sammy Hernandez's RBI double, Christian Martin's two-run double and Pino's RBI single to tie the game 6-6...Quad Cities answered back with a run in the bottom of the sixth and eighth, making it 8-6...In the ninth, River Bandits reliever L.P. Langevin surrendered a leadoff base hit to Pino and walked Jalin Flores...With two runners on and no outs, Dattalo launched an opposite-field three-run go-ahead home run to right-center field, giving the Chiefs their first lead of the night, 9-8...Despite issuing a one-out walk in the bottom of the ninth, Rubén Menes retired the final two batters to earn his first High-A save...

SECOND-HALF COMPARISON

Peoria's last playoff team (2023) was 7-5 in the second half entering the All-Star break. The 2026 Chiefs head into the final game before the midsummer break at 8-11 in the second half. Peoria is five games back of first place (BEL + WIS).

OFFENSIVE TRENDS

- From June 16-July 5, the Chiefs hit .212 with nine home runs. This week, Peoria is hitting .277 with five homers.
- The Chiefs' 114 home runs this season are eight shy of tying their franchise record of 122 homers in a single season set in 2002 (Yadier Molina hit seven of them).
- The Chiefs had been held under five runs in 20 of their last 26 games through Wednesday's loss and are 5-31 when scoring fewer than five runs. However, Peoria has posted 23 runs across the last three games, averaging 7.67 RPG.
- Peoria has grounded into 28 double plays over its last 28 games, the most in High-A and tied for the third-most in MiLB and MLB in that span.

BULLPEN BOUNCEBACK

After allowing 26 earned runs in 14.2 innings (15.95 ERA) with 13 walks over the first three games of the series, the Chiefs' bullpen has settled in. In Peoria's two straight wins, relievers have surrendered just three earned runs over nine innings (3.00 ERA), walking two and striking out eight.

HOMER WOULD BE PROUD

Former Chief **Jordan Walker** has announced that he will participate in the 2026 Home Run Derby on Monday in Philadelphia. In 55 games with the Chiefs in 2021, Walker hit eight home runs. Walker is the first Chiefs alum to participate since **Albert Pujols'** final appearance in 2022. **Javier Baez** (PEO '12) participated in 2018. **Josh Donaldson** ('08) was a two-time contestant. **Rafael Palmeiro** was the first former Chief to participate, in 1998.

THAT'S A LOT OF RUNS

The Chiefs allowed double-digit runs in three straight games to begin this series for the first time since the High-A era began in 2021. Peoria has allowed 53 Quad Cities runs on 70 hits, with 25 of those knocks going for extra bases. Peoria relievers have allowed 30 of those runs in 23.2 innings. In last week's series loss to Wisconsin, the Chiefs allowed 27 runs in six games.

GOOD THINGS COME IN TWOS

Jack Gurevitch became the Chiefs' fourth player this year to hit two home runs in a single game with his two long balls on Thursday. Tre Richardson III did it twice in the same week, Cade McGee has two instances and José Suárez also did it. Peoria had just two players (Joshua Báez; Zach Levenson) hit multiple homers all of last season. The six instances this year for the Chiefs are their most since the High-A era began in 2021.

TRENDING CHIEFS

- **Michael Dattalo** hit his first High-A home run last night, a go-ahead three-run homer in the top of the ninth.
- **Josh Kross** hit his first home run since June 11 in Friday's win. He backed it up with another leadoff shot last night.
- **Luis Pino** recorded his second consecutive three-hit game last night, and just third three-hit performance of the season.
- **Sammy Hernandez** is riding a 22-game on base streak. In that stretch, he's batting .362 with a 1.138 OPS.
- **Christian Martin** recorded multiple RBIs for the first time in High-A with a two-run double last night.

SCOUTING REPORT

- Works with five pitch mix: FB (up to 99), CV (low mid 80s), SL (upper 80s, up to 90), CH (upper 80s), 2-SM

Baseball America - Cardinals No. 25 prospect: "The 6-foot-5 Odle has good size and a simple, repeatable operation that stays connected through release. He only generates moderate extension, delivering the ball from a higher three quarters arm slot. ... Odle's four-seam fastball sits 96-98 mph touching 99 mph with above-average ride and good plane to the plate. His curveball is his primary secondary pitch with heavy two-plane movement..." Added to top-30 in May

MLB Pipeline - Cardinals No. 13 prospect: "Odle benefited from overeager Single-A hitters early this season and quickly ran into control issues in his move to High-A, where opponents were more disciplined against all pitch types. He can rush his delivery a bit, leading to a loss of fastball command up and to the arm side, but in general, there should be enough control to keep the starting dream alive. His combination of heat and breakers would absolutely play in shorter stints if a bullpen move eventually comes."

SEASON NOTES

LAST TIME OUT: Tossed third scoreless start as a Chief, allowing no runs in 4.1 innings in Peoria's 4-0 loss last Sunday versus Wisconsin...Struck out seven batters, the most he's set down in the fewest innings pitched with Peoria...

ESCAPE THE FIRST: Odle has given up five earned runs in 5.2 first innings with the Chiefs, good for a 7.94 ERA in the opening frame. From the second through the fourth inning, he's posted a sub-2.00 ERA in each frame.

THAT'S A LOT OF K'S: Has struck out six or more in 11 of 15 appearances this season...

NO-NO TALK: Became fourth Chief in High-A era and first since July 7, 2024 (Inohan Paniagua) to carry no hitter through six innings on June 20 vs Dayton.

ABOUT JACOB

ORIGIN STORY: Drafted by Cardinals in 14th round of 2023 draft out of Orange Coast CC... Opened career at UC-Irvine in 2022 but did not pitch. Transferred to OCC for 2023, made 13 appearances for the Pirates, pitching 14.1 relief innings to a 6.91 ERA... Grew up in family of Cubs fans...

JACOB, MEET TOMMY: Underwent Tommy John surgery and missed all of 2024 season after brief pro debut in 2023... Returned in May 2025.

WHAT HE'S SAYING: "[Before surgery] I never really took care of myself. I never lifted. I never really did any arm care. I (would) just kind of get up there and throw. But then coming back last year taught me a lot of what I need to do to feel good and ready and to maintain arm health."

BACK IN HIGH SCHOOL: Attended St. Augustine High School in San Diego... Alma mater of former Chief and current Blue Jays hitting coach David Popkins, plus five big leaguers.

COACHING STAFF

ROBERTO ESPINOZA

MANAGER

Roberto Espinoza, 37, returns to Peoria for his second season guiding the Chiefs and his 13th season coaching with the Cardinals organization. He is the lone returner from the team's 2025 coaching staff. Espinoza's career in baseball began as a catcher, as the Cardinals signed the Palo Aragua, Venezuela as an international free agent in 2006. Espinoza played five Minor League seasons, including parts of three seasons with the Quad Cities River Bandits. Espinoza began his coaching career in 2013 as the hitting coach for the Appalachian League's Johnson City Cardinals. The former backstop is no stranger to the big leagues, having served as a bullpen catcher for St. Louis in 2014 and as a coach during the stretch run of the 2020 season. Espinoza managed Johnson City from 2017 through 2019, winning the Appy League Championship in his final season. He spent the next four seasons (2021-24) managing the FCL Cardinals. He collected his 200th managerial victory on May 18, 2025 with Peoria's 7-1 win over Cedar Rapids.

MIKE HABAS

HITTING COACH

Mike Habas (HAH-biss), an experienced MiLB hitting coach, will spend his first season in the Cardinals organization with the Peoria Chiefs. Habas joins the Cardinals after spending the last two seasons with the Fredericksburg Nationals, helping guide the FredNats to the 2024 Carolina League title. The Chicago native began coaching in the professional ranks with the Gary SouthShore RailCats (2017-18) before spending four seasons with the Brewers (2019-2023). Habas played college baseball at South Suburban College, Moraine Valley College and North Greenville University.

MICHAEL OH

PITCHING COACH

Michael Oh, 28, joins the Chiefs for his second season in the Cardinals organization. The Northbrook, Illinois native began his time coaching in the pro ranks with the Palm Beach Cardinals last season, guiding a number of future Chiefs hurlers. Oh pitched four seasons of college baseball, one at North Iowa Area Community College, two at North Carolina and one at Charlotte. After completing his career with the 49ers in 2022, he was added to the Charlotte coaching staff as the pitching coordinator. He was promoted to pitching coach for the 2024 season, where he guided the 49ers to the program record 10.45 K/9 rate.

A familiar face to Chiefs fans, Wade Stauss will spend his first full season as a coach in Peoria. Stauss, 26, was signed by the Cardinals as an undrafted free agent in 2021 after four seasons at Southeast Missouri State. The catcher played 26 games with the Chiefs across two seasons, including a two-home run game on June 28, 2022 at Quad Cities. Stauss played at all four full-season levels of the Cardinals system and appeared in 138 games before transitioning to coaching prior to the end of 2025.

ATHLETIC TRAINER

Kily Gilbert is the Chiefs certified athletic trainer after she joined the Cardinals system in November after a previous stint with the Houston Astros. Gilbert originates from southern Oregon and attended Oregon State for her undergraduate and master's studies. She was a former intern for the San Francisco 49ers.
