FIRST THINGS FIRST: Springfield and NW Arkansas enter tonight's game tied for 1st place in the North Division ... are 0.5 game ahead of Wichita/Arkansas ... 23 games remain in the 1st Half.

THE OZARKS SERIES: Tonight's game is the 8th of 24 in the season series vs. NWA and 8th of 15 at Hammons Field ... SGF is 2-5 overall ... the next series will be played in Springfield, July 1-3.

TEK BRO: RHP Tekoa Roby (2-2) makes his 9th start of the season and 2nd vs. NWA ... pitched 6.0 innings for 1st time this season in last start, 5/22 at TUL ... allowed 2 runs on 4 hits with 6 strikeouts and no walks ... recorded 1st quality start ... is 0-1 with a 10.80 ERA (4ER/3.1IP) in 1 start vs. NWA this season.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Springfield allowed a season-high 15 hits in a 7-3 loss to the Naturals on Wednesday night ... NWA broke a 3-3 tie with 2 runs in the 8th ... RHP Max Rajcic allowed 3 ER and a season-high 8 hits over 5.0 IP in a no-decision ... OF Chase Davis went 2x4 with a 2B.

HEY CHIEF: OF Josh Baez is poised to make his Double-A debut with Springfield after joining the club from Peoria (A+) ... 21-year-old was hitting .317 with 4HR, 24RBI, 20SB and an .887 OPS in the Midwest League ... ranked top-10 in the league in AVG, runs, hits, SB, and OPS ... was drafted by STL in the 2nd round in 2021 out of high school in the Boston area.

WEEK ENDS AT BERNIE'S: C Leonardo Bernal was named Texas League Player of the Week for the week of 5/20-25 ... hit .500 (10x20) with 3 HR, 13 RBI and a 1.522 OPS in 5 games at TUL ... raised season BA from .215 to .265 and OPS from .712 to .855 ... was 1st weekly award of his career and 1st this season for a Cards position player ... joins RHP Max Rajcic and LHP Pete Hansen as SGF's weekly winners ... 1st catcher to win for SGF since 2015 (Mike Ohlman) ... has hits in 9-straight games and is hitting .313 with 5 HR and 18 RBI in May (hit .208 in April).
