the Memphis Redbirds (St. Louis Cardinals) at AutoZone Park. It is the 13th of 27 games to be played between the two clubs this season, and the seventh of 15 games to be played in Memphis.

**VS. MEMPHIS:** Gwinnett is 3-0-3 in six series all-time vs. Memphis since first meeting in 2021. The Stripers are 10-8 (.556) in 18 games all-time at AutoZone Park, including 3-3 (.500) in six games so far this season.

ALL-STAR PRESENCE: Led by former Gwinnett manager Brian Snitker (2014-16), the National League roster for the 2022 MLB All-Star Game on 7/19 included seven Gwinnett alums: OF Ronald Acuña Jr. (2017-18, 2022), DH William Contreras (2021-22), C Travis d'Arnaud (2021), 1B Freddie Freeman (2010, 2013, 2015, 2017), P Max Fried (2017-18), 3B Austin Riley (2018-19), and SS Dansby Swanson (2017). The America League - void of any former Gwinnett players - won 3-2 at Dodger Stadium.

TUI AT THE FUTURES GAME: On 7/17, Stripers manager Matt Tuiasosopo served as the third base coach for the National League in the 2022 SiriusXM MLB All-Star Futures Game at Dodger Stadium in Los Angeles. He was the first THE ELDER STROLLS: Bryce Elder turned in his second Gwinnett coach ever to participate in a Futures Game. The NL, led by former MLB manager Mike Sciocia, lost 6-4 to the American League (OAK's Shea Langeliers was MVP). Coach Devon Travis guided the Stripers to a 2-1 record as acting manager in Tuiasosopo's absence.

JULY TRENDS: Through 15 games this month, the Stripers are 8-7 with an even differential (tied 42-42). Eleven games have been decided by three runs or less (GWN is 6-5). Four of the team's nine shutout losses have come in July.

- **Dominant Arms:** Gwinnett pitchers lead Triple-A in July in ERA (2.79), WHIP (1.02), BAA (.206), and fewest runs (42), and are second in fewest walks (36).
- Struggling Bats: Gwinnett hitters rank last in Triple-A in July in runs (42), homers (5), OBP (.305), SLG (.319), and OPS (.624). The team's .231 average ranks 27th.

KINGS OF THE "K": Stripers pitchers lead the International League in strikeouts with 894 in 90 games (9.93 SO/game). That's nine more than the second-place team, Worcester (885 SO in 90G). Gwinnett has not led the IL in strikeouts since 2011 (club record 1,223 SO in 143G). Entering play, Kyle Muller (1st, 117), Tucker Davidson (4th, 89), Huascar Ynoa (8th, 77), and Bryce Elder (T-15th, 71) all rank among the IL top 20 in strikeouts.

**DESHIELDS AMONG LEADERS:** Delino DeShields Jr. ranks among the IL top 15 in stolen bases (T-8th, 19) and walks (T-12th, 43). He has reached base safely in 50 of 62 games (80.6%) with a plate appearance this season, batting .256 (46-for-180, 6 2B, 1 HR, 28 R, 18 RBI, .709 OPS).

CAN'T TOUCH TONKIN: Michael Tonkin tossed a scoreless ninth on 7/17 vs. Durham (1.0 IP, 0 H), extending his scoreless innings streak to 15.2 over his last 14 games since 6/5. It's the fifth-longest scoreless streak in the IL this season, a span in which Tonkin is posting a 0.57 WHIP (6 H, 3 BB), .113 BAA, 13.79 SO/9.0 IP ratio (24 SO), and four saves (4-for-4). Overall, he's 3-0 with a 1.78 ERA (6 ER in 30.1 IP), 0.99 WHIP, .171 BAA, and team-high seven saves (7-for-8, T-6th in IL) in 29 outings.

**TONIGHT:** The Stripers open a three-game series against **OFFENSIVE ODDS & ENDS:** Hernan Perez has tallied three straight multi-hit games since 7/14, batting .583 (7-for-12, 1 2B, 3R, 1RBI, 1.250 OPS). It's the second-longest multi-hit game streak on the club this year, trailing only Chadwick Tromp's four-game streak from 4/29-5/4. Alex Dickerson is batting .300 (12-for-40, 2 2B, 1 3B, 3 R, 4 RBI, .741 OPS) in 12 games in July. Ryan Goins is batting .349 (22-for-63, 6 2B, 6 R, 9 RBI, .850 OPS) in 19 games since 6/14.

> **DEMERITTE ALWAYS ON:** Travis Demeritte has reached base safely in 174 of 207 career games (84.1%) with Gwinnett since 2019, batting .274 (196-for-715, 52 2B, 4 3B, 43 HR, 131 R, 140 RBI, 17 SB, .905 OPS). He is one of three players in Gwinnett history with two 20-homer seasons, joining Stefan Gartrell and Ernesto Mejia.

scoreless start of the year on 7/15 vs. Durham, working 7.0 innings (6 H, 0 BB, 5 SO) in a no-decision. Over three starts in July, he's 2-0 with a 1.74 ERA (4 ER in 20.2 IP), 1.02 WHIP, .219 BAA, and two quality starts.

• IL Leaderboard: Elder leads in GO/AO ratio (2.27) and ranks among the top 15 in WHIP (6th, 1.19), BAA (7th, .237), innings (T-13th, 79.0), and strikeouts (T-15th, 71).

**MULLDOZING:** Kyle Muller notched his team-leading ninth quality start of the season on 7/14 vs. Durham, working 6.0 innings (7 H, 2 R, 2 ER, 0 BB, 7 SO) in a no-decision (GWN lost 5-3). Over his last eight starts since 6/2, Muller is 3-2 with a 2.25 ERA (13 ER in 52.0 IP), 0.88 WHIP, .202 BAA, 10.56 SO/9.0 IP (61 SO), and seven quality starts.

· IL Leaderboard: Muller leads in strikeouts (117, 7th in MiLB) and ranks among the top 10 in WHIP (2nd, 1.08), innings (T-2nd, 94.1), CG (T-2nd, 1), ERA (3rd, 2.96), BAA (4th, .223), and GO/AO ratio (8th, 1.28).

FERGUSON DEBUTS: 28-year-old RHP Tyler Ferguson has logged two scoreless relief outings (2.0 IP, 0 H, 1 BB, 4 SO) since joining Gwinnett for his Triple-A debut on 7/12. He is riding a 10-game scoreless streak (10.2 IP, 0 H, 1 HB, 3 BB, 18 SO) since 6/16 with Double-A Mississippi.

TARNOK QUALITY IN TRIPLE-A DEBUT: Making his Triple-A debut on 7/13 vs. Durham, Freddy Tarnok pitched 6.0 innings (2 H, 1 ER, 1 HR, 1 BB, 4 SO) for the win. He is the first Gwinnett pitcher to log a quality start in his Triple-A debut since Jeremy Walker on 9/2/18 vs. Charlotte (win, 8.0 IP, 3 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 6 SO in 2-0 victory).

Dominant Stretch: Including his final four starts with Double-A Mississipi from 6/18-7/7, Tarnok is 2-0 with a 1.67 ERA (5 ER in 27.0 IP), .167 BAA (16-for-96), and 11.67 SO/9.0 IP ratio (35 SO) over his last five starts.

**PROSPECTING:** Gwinnett's active roster features six listed on the MLB.com Atlanta Braves Top 30 Prospects list: LHP Kyle Muller (1), RHP Bryce Elder (2), INF Braden Shewmake (3), LHP Tucker Davidson (5), RHP Freddy Tarnok (6), and RHP Victor Vodnik (10).

#### MANAGER MATT TUIASOSOPO

Matt Tuiasosopo is in his second season as the manager of the Stripers in 2022 ... He was named the seventh manager in Gwinnett history on 3/30/21, making him the first former Gwinnett player to manage the club (played OF/1B from 2016-17) . In 2021, he guided the Stripers to a 71-58 record (3rd in Triple-A East Southeast Division) ... On 5/4/21 at Charlotte, he became the youngest manager in Gwinnett history (34 years, 11 months, 25 days) ... On 6/9/22 at Jacksonville, he became the fourth manager in Gwinnett history to reach 100 career wins ... On 7/16, he served third base coach for the NL Team for the 2022 SiriusXM MLB All-Star Futures Game at Dodger Stadium ... Began his career with Class-A Rome in 2019, earning Atlanta's Bobby Cox Award for MiLB Manager of the Year.
