TODAY'S HEADLINES

LAST TIME OUT: The Saints held a 6-5 lead after seven innings on Sunday, but could not hang on as they were walked off for the seventh time this season dropping 7-6 and losing their ninth consecutive game. The Saints took a 2-0 lead in the first inning on a two-run home run from Michael Helman. Indianapolis responded with a three-run second inning, taking the lead. Rylan Bannon connected on his first home run with St. Paul in the sixth inning, giving the Saints a 6-4 lead going into the bottom of the sixth. Indianapolis scored the game's next three runs, including home runs in the eighth and ninth innings, the last of which was a walk-off blast to beat St. Paul 7-6.

ON THE SKID: The Saints have dropped their last nine games, their longest losing streak of the season and the second-longest streak in franchise history. There has been only one other skid of eight-or-more games, the franchise-record 11 consecutive losses from May 8-20, 2022. During this eight-game skid, the Saints have been out-scored 52-37 and been out-hit 91-69.

S All nine losses have been decided by three-or-fewer runs. The tying run has been at the plate or on base in seven of the nine losses, with the only exceptions being the 6-5 walk-off loss on Wednesday and the 7-6 walk-off loss on Sunday

\$ The nine-game skid is tied for the second-longest losing streak in the IL this season. There have been only two 10-game losing streaks this year: Norfolk from April 7-18 and Toledo from June 12-22.

SWEPT UNDER THE RUG: The Saints were swept in a six-game series for the fourth time in franchise history on Sunday in Indianapolis. All four sweeps have come on the road: August 24-29, 2021 @ Toledo, May 10-15, 2022 @ Columbus, July 9-14, 2024 @ Louisville and August 13-18, 2024 @ Indianapolis. In the series following a sweep, the Saints have, in order, dropped 2-4 (@COL), 1-5 (@OMA), and swept 3-0 (@TOL)

HAPPY BIRTHDAY AARON!: Aaron Rozek will be celebrating his 29th birthday on the mound tonight. Rozek will become the third Saints pitcher to start a game on his birthday, joining Drew Strotman (September 3, 2021) and Cole Sands (July 17, 2022). In total, eight Saints pitchers have thrown on their birthday with the club going 4-4 when the birthday boy takes the mound.

WALK-OFF WOES: For the seventh time this season, the Saints were walked off, losing their series finale in Indianapolis 7-6. The Saints' seven walk-off losses are tied for the third-most in the IL in 2024, trailing Toledo's eight and the 10 losses by Jacksonville. The Saints' seven walk-off losses this year are the third most in a season in franchise history, trailing the nine from 2021 and the record 13 losses in 2022.

LOVE LEFTIES LATELY: Early in the season, the Saints struggled against lefthanded pitching, but have turned it around since the start of June. Below is a comparison of how the Saints have hit left-handers before and after June 1:

ELECTRIC EELES: Since joining the Saints on July 4, he has constantly found ways to get on base, sporting a .426 on-base percentage in Triple-A. He's reached base in 29 of the 34 games he's played in, drawing 17 walks and been hit by a pitch six times. He is fifth among full-season minor league players in on-base percentage at .444 across three levels. Of the four players ahead of him, only two have played

SUMMERTIME SEVERINO: In Yunior Severino's 61 games since May 21, he has hit .326 (75-for-230), with 12 home runs, drawing 40 walks, owning a .949 OPS. In that time, Severino ranks third in the league in batting average, OPS, and RBI (48) fourth in on-base percentage (.419), seventh in slugging percentage at .530 and 75 hits. His 40 walks since May 21 are the ninth-most in the league.

TWINS UPDATE: The Twins dropped their series opener in San Diego, 5-3 yesterday. Zebby Matthews took his first Major League loss, giving up two runs over 5.0 innings, walking two and striking out one. Matt Wallner had the Twins' lone extra-base hit, going 1-for-2 with a double
