# FRISCO DROPS 7-6 THRILLER TO TULSA

The Frisco RoughRiders fell to the Tulsa Drillers 7-6 on Thursday night from Riders Field. Tulsa (1-2, 27-45) tallied the first two runs in the top of the first when Noah Miller clipped a two-run triple to put the Drillers up 2-0. Frisco (2-1, 40-31) then answered in the bottom of the first when Josh Hatcher rolled an RBI groundout, trimming Tulsa's lead to 2-1. In the bottom of the second, Aaron Antonini tapped an RBI groundout then Aaron Zavala muscled a three-run home run, giving the RoughRiders a 5-2 lead. The Drillers responded in the top of the third when Kendall Simmons clobbered a grand slam, lifting Tulsa in front 6-5. Miller then added an RBI single in the top of the seventh, extending the lead to 7-5. In the bottom of the ninth, Antonini lined an RBI single to cut the Drillers lead to 7-6. But with the tying run on second and go-ahead run on first, Tulsa reliever Antonio Knowles struck out Zavala to record his fifth save of the season. Drillers starter Peter Heubeck (2-4) picked up the win, allowing four earned runs while walking four and striking four. RoughRiders starter Josh Stephan (5-3) took the loss, allowing five earned runs while whiffing four across three innings.

## **DEFENSE WINS CHAMPIONSHIPS:**

After the RoughRiders committed 20 errors in 23 April games, which was sixth in the league, they have the fewest in the league, committing just 31 errors in their last 48 games. Their 47 double plays turned since May 1st also paces the league. Their 44 stolen bases allowed are the fewest in Double-A and are the third-fewest in Minor League Baseball.

NO SWING AND A MIESES:
Riders outfielder Luis Mieses has showed off the power this year. He is on pace to set a career-best in home runs as he has 11 so far.
His career-best is 15 (in both 2022 and 2021). He is tied for third in the Texas League with his 11 home runs while his .463 slugging percentage is fourth in the Texas League.

### **DRIVERS, START YOUR ENGINES:**

RoughRiders starting pitchers lead Double-A over the last 15 games with a 2.76 ERA, a mark which is the eighth-best in all of Minor League Baseball. In addition to pitching well, they are also pitching deep into ballgames. They are averaging 5.1 innings per start, the most in Double-A and seventh in the minors. **Josh Stephan** threw back-to-back 7.0-inning starts for the first time in his career over the last two weeks while he and **Kohl Drake** threw back-to-back 7.0-inning starts for the first time since 2018 last week. Overall, the RoughRiders lead the league with a 2.50 ERA in the last 15 games with only four home runs allowed.

Frisco struggled in their series against San Antonio last week, hitting .228 (47-for-206)/.287/.325/.612 with only 15 runs scored, the second-fewest in the Texas League. Their 80 strikeouts were also the most last week in Minor League Baseball. Frisco went just 8-for-45 with runners in scoring position last week. On Wednesday, the Riders struck out 19 times, which is a franchise record for their most strikeouts in a nine-inning game. All three walk-off losses for Frisco have been at the hands of the Missions this season. On the two-week road trip, the Riders scored just 36 times (3.0 per game).

The RoughRiders have had 11 different pitchers record a save in 2025. Frisco was the first team in Minor League Baseball to accomplish the feat this season. **Gavin Collyer** are leads the team saves (six) for the Riders, a mark that is tied for fourth in the Texas League. Their 24 saves are tied for the third-most in all of Minor League Baseball, just trailing Triple-A Jacksonville's 25 and Double-A Montgomery's 25. Their 4.12 bullpen ERA is fourth in the league. In June, their 3.04 reliever ERA is third in the Texas League.

Rangers top prospect **Sebastian Walcott** has been displaying the power as of late. In his last 37 games, he has blasted six home runs while slashing .259/.349/.441/.790 with eight doubles, 20 RBIs, 20 runs scored and 20 walks to 32 strikeouts. This season, his walk rate of 12.5 percent is a career high while he is striking out at just 21.6 percent, a career low. His 16 doubles lead the league and his 24 extra-base hits are second in the league. In his last 18 games, he is hitting .284 (19-for-67)/.372/.328/.700 with three doubles, six RBIs, 10 walks, 16 strikeouts and five stolen bases. This season, he is on pace for 31 steals over 131 games, which would best his prior career high of 27 last year. The only teenagers since 2005 to steal 30 or more in Double-A are **Elvis Andrus** (51, 2008), Jackson Chourio (43, 2023), Nelson Rada (35, 2024) and Mike Trout (31, 2011). Chourio was the only one on that list with 30+ stolen bases and double-digit home runs (22).

# **DOUBLE-A DOUBL-A RON:**

Aaron Zavala has been on fire at the plate for the Riders. After a dreadful start, batting just .077 (2-for-26) through 10 games, he is hitting .283 (52-for-184)/.390/.451/.841 over his last 50 games. He is second in the Texas League in walks (45) and is fifth in OBP (.388). In his last 24 games, he is hitting .268 (26-for-97)/.343/.433/.776 with two doubles, four home runs and 10 RBIs. In his Frisco career, he has earned 201 walks over four seasons (302 games), which is second in franchise history. He is just six walks away from tying the franchise record for walks, held by **Guilder Rodriguez** with 206 from 2009-2015 (527 games). His seven home runs this season are his most since his career-best of 16 in 2022.



## **ABOUT RYAN**

-After High School, he started his college career at Chattanooga State Community College in Chattanooga, Tennessee. He then transferred to Mercer University, where his brother, Taylor, had previously pitched from 2016-2021.

-Played college summer ball in 2022 for Brewster of the Cape Cod League, going 1-0 with a 2.84 ERA (2 ER/6.1 IP) in four app

-In 2022, went 5-5 with 4.54 ERA and 5-4 with 6.96 ERA in 2023. In two-years at Mercer, he totalled 141 strikeouts over 132.2 innings. After he was signed, the Rangers reworked his pitch locations using data analytics.

## **2025 SEASON**

-As of 4/18/25, Lobus has only had one career appearance without a strikeout in his professional career  $(8/14/23 \, \text{vs. A-WSX})$  while pitching in the Arizona Complex League.

-Started with Low-A Down East and moved up to Double-A Frisco by the end of the season.

-His 35.8% strikeout rate ranked 2nd in all of MiLB under the same parameter to only Matt Wilkinson of the CLE system

-Recorded at least one strikeout in each of his 27 outings, registering in double-digit K's three times
