Tonight's Game: The Sounds take on the Bats in game five of the six-game series tonight. After trailing 5-0 through five and a half innings, the Sounds rallied for a walk-off win with Isaac Collins' double scoring Freddy Zamora and Joey Wiemer in the ninth. Right-hander Jakob Junis makes his second start on MLB rehab assignment with Nashville tonight. He'll face off against Carson Spiers of Louisville.

Jakob Junis: The 31-year-old makes his third start of the season and second of the homestand. He's appearing with Nashville for the first time on Major League rehab assignment from Milwaukee. The right-hander retired all six batters faced on June 4 vs. Louisville while striking out three on 21 pitches (15 strikes). Junis was placed on Milwaukee's 60-day injured list on May 6 after being hit in the neck with a ball during batting practice on April 22 at Pittsburgh and was hospitalized. He was already on the injured list at that point, having been placed on the injured list with right shoulder impingement after his first start on April 6. Junis signed a one-year contract with the Brewers on February 7. He has pitched in the big leagues with the Royals (2017-2021) and Giants (2022-2023). Junis was originally selected in the 29th round of the 2011 First-Year Player Draft out of Rock Falls High School in Illinois.

Carson Spiers: The 26-year-old makes his ninth start and 10th appearance with the Bats. He is 3-1 with a 2.51 ERA (46.2 IP/13 ER) in Triple-A and 0-0 with a 3.29 ERA (13.2 IP/5 ER) in four appearances with Cincinnati this season. Spiers last pitched on June 1 vs. Iowa. He turned in a quality start, holding the I-Cubs to a pair of runs (both earned) on four hits with no walks and seven strikeouts in a no decision. Spiers had made three appearances between May 17-27 before being optioned back to Louisville. He faced the Sounds in the series in April at Louisville Slugger Field and got the win on April 25, holding Nashville to three runs (2 ER) in seven innings with six strikeouts. Carson is the nephew of former Brewers infielder Bill Spiers, who played for Milwaukee from 1989-1994 after being taken in the first round by the Brew Crew in 1987. Also like his uncle, Spiers attended Clemson University where he was signed as an undrafted free agent in 2020 by the Reds.

Collins Plays Hero: Outfielder Isaac Collins had himself a night at the plate, adding three RBI, two doubles and two runs scored. He ended last night's game with a double deep in the right-center field that scored the tying and game-winning runs in the ninth. Collins has hit safely in five straight games and is batting .474 (9-for-19) with three doubles, nine RBI, four walks, two stolen bases and four runs scored in that span. He 18 doubles is the second-most in the International League. Collins also ranks among league leaders in runs (T-3rd, 42) and extra-base hits (T-4th, 27).

Bullpen Beat: Tyler Woessner was stellar in a rare outing out of the bullpen last night, holding the Bats to a run in four innings last night. Nashville's pen leads Triple-A in ERA (3.14), WHIP (1.30), and is second in opponents batting average (.213) with a 21-7 overall record.

Mejia Mashing: Francisco Mejia added his fourth multi-hit game in his last five games with a pair of knocks and an RBI last night. Since May 24, Mejia is batting .324 (11-for-34) with two doubles, three home runs, six RBI and six runs scored over the span of eight games.

He Gets On Base: Outfielder Joey Wiemer extended his on-base streak to 10 games after walking twice last night. Since joining the Sounds' lineup from Milwaukee on May 28, Wiemer has a .447 on-base percentage with 10 hits and 11 walks in 36 at-bats.

Meek to Mil: Reliever James Meeker became the sixth player to make his Major League debut after being called up from Nashville by the Brewers this season, working a scoreless ninth in the Brewers' 10-0 win over Detroit. Since 2021, 22 Sounds have gotten the call for the first time and made their debuts in MLB with Milwaukee. Meeker began the season with Double-A Biloxi before getting promoted to Nashville on April 21. He is 1-0 with a 3.48 ERA (20.2 IP/8 ER) and 20 strikeouts for the Sounds in 14 appearances this season.

The Sweet Life: Manager Rick Sweet is in his fourth consecutive season as the Sounds manager (5th overall) and his 34th season as a manager in MiLB. Sweet is the winningest manager in Nashville Sounds history, earning his 321st victory in the 2023 season finale vs. Jacksonville. This is his 11th season as manager of the Brewers' Triple-A affiliate and boasts a 716-611 record (Nashville in 2014, Colorado Springs from 2015-18, San Antonio in 2019 and Nashville 2021-). Overall, Sweet has a career managerial record of 2,308-2,131 - that's the fifth most wins in MiLB history and second among active managers (only Buddy Bailey with Single-A Myrtle Beach has more).

Sounds Manager Rick Sweet ranks fifth among Minor League managers in wins. He has the second-most among active managers, trailing Single-A Myrtle Beach manager Buddy Bailey.

LAST OUTING: Junis made his Sounds debut on rehab assignment in the series opener vs. Louisville. He retired all six batters faced, including three via strikeout. The Sounds would go on to shut out the Bats.

AGAINST OPPONENT: Before the series opener, Junis' only prior outing against the Bats came on June 17, 2021 at Werner Park in Nebraska. He struck out five and held Louisville to two hits over three scoreless innings in the start. It was his second start with the Storm Chasers after being optioned by Kansas City on June 7.

2024 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS:

- Made Brewers debut on April 2 vs. Minnesota
- Placed on the injured list with right shoulder impingement on April 6. During Milwaukee's batting practice on April 22, Junis was hit in the neck with a batted ball on the warning track and taken to the hospital. Junis was moved to the 60-day injured list on May 6.
