





Jose Chacin threw three perfect innings with five strikeouts in his start. McIlwain drove in two of the Ponies' three runs.

Starting Strong: The Binghamton Rumble Ponies have sent Luis Moreno, Christian Scott, Dom Hamel, Junior Santos, David Griffin, and Jose Chacin to the mound to start the first six games of this series at Akron. The six starters this series have combined to throw 30.2 IP and have allowed just seven runs and six walks, with 36 strikeouts. Moreno, Scott, and Hamel all earned the win in their respective starts. The Ponies have outscored the RubberDucks 26-17 in this series.

Mets Trade Eduardo Escobar to Angels: The New York Mets traded infielder Eduardo Escobar to the Los Angeles Angels for two right-handed pitching prospects, **Landon Marceaux** and **Coleman Crow**. Marceaux is now ranked the Mets' No. 18 overall prospect, according to MLB Pipeline, and has been assigned to Binghamton. The 23-year-old was drafted by the Angels in the 3rd round in 2021 out of LSU. He made 12 starts for Double-A Rocket City this season. Crow is now ranked the No. 11 overall prospect in the Mets top 30. The 22-year old was a 28th round pick in 2019 out of Pike County High School (GA). In four starts for Double-A Rocket City this season, he went 2-0 with a 1.88 ERA, 31 K, and a 0.63 WHIP.

Big BMac: Outfielder **Brandon McIlwain** tied the game 3-3 with a solo home run in the top of the ninth inning on Saturday night at Akron. It was his seventh home run of the season. He drove in two runs for the second time in a game this series. McIlwain has hit five homers in June after hitting just two over April and May.

No Runs, Nolan: Right-handed reliever **Nolan Clenney** tossed three scoreless innings with just two hits allowed and three strikeouts on Saturday night at Akron. Clenney has not allowed an earned run in an outing since June 1, which spans across six-straight outings. Clenney has allowed just two earned runs in his last 11 outings and he has not allowed an earned run in 10 of his past 11 appearances. He lowered his ERA with Double-A Binghamton to 3.80 on the season in 16 total appearances.

Last Start: Marceaux tossed six innings and allowed three runs on seven hits with two walks, while tying a season high with six strikeouts. His last start was Friday at Double-A Chattanooga.

2022: Made 18 starts across two levels in the Angels organization, with 16 starts coming for High-A Tri-City and two starts coming for Double-A Rocket City. He carried a 4-5 record with a 2.65 ERA with High-A Tri-City. Across the two levels, Marcaeux went 4-6 with a 2.98 ERA and 73 strikeouts in 90.2 innings. He was the Northwest League Pitcher of the Month in July 2022.

BACKGROUND: Marceaux was traded from the Los Angeles Angels to the New York Mets in the Eduardo Escobar deal on June 23. He ranks as the Mets' No. 18 overall prospect, according to MLB Pipeline. He was drafted in the third round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of LSU. Marceaux was the Friday night starter for the Tigers and held a career 14-9 record with a 3.23 ERA in 35 starts. He was a 2021 Second Team All-American and Second Team All-SEC selection. Finished top 10 in the SEC in ERA, innings pitched, and strikeouts as a junior in 2021. Originally drafted in the 37th round of the 2018 draft by the New York Yankees out of Destrehan HS, but did not sign. He was the No. 1 player in Louisiana in the 2018 high school class by Perfect Game and Prep Baseball Report.

Transactions: Acquired via trade with the Los Angeles Angels and assigned to AA Binghamton on June 23.

Reid Brignac - Manager - 2nd season with Binghamton - 4th year in the Mets organization.

In 2022, Brignac led a team that saw five players make their major league debut with the Mets after starting the season with the Rumble Ponies (Francisco Álvarez, Brett Baty, Jose Butto, Nate Fisher, and Bryce Montes de Oca), tied for the second-most in franchise history. This past fall, Brignac was one of two Mets staff members selected to be a part of the Arizona Fall League coaching staff, serving as the manager of the Peoria Javelinas. Following his retirement as an active player in 2018, Brignac was the manager of the St. Lucie Mets (Low-A) in 2021 before coming to Binghamton last year. As a player, Brignac appeared in parts of nine seasons in the major leagues with the Tampa Bay Rays, Colorado Rockies, Atlanta Braves, Philadelphia Phillies, New York Yankees, and Miami Marlins. He was drafted by the Rays in the second round of the 2004 MLB Draft.

AJ Sager - Pitching Coach - 1st season with Binghamton - 2nd year in the Mets organization. Sager served in the same role for the Brooklyn Cyclones (High-A) last season. Sager previously spent twenty seasons with the Detroit Tigers organization, including six seasons as the pitching coach with Triple-A Toledo. He pitched for parts of five seasons in the major leagues, playing for the San Diego Padres, Colorado Rockies, and Detroit Tigers as part of a 12-year professional career. In 123 major league appearances, the right-hander was 12-15, with five career saves and a 5.36 ERA.

Darin Everson- Hitting Coach - 1st season with Binghamton - 1st year in the Mets organization.
