#### RIDERS FALL IN OPENER TO CARDINALS:

The Frisco RoughRiders dropped their series opener against the Springfield Cardinals 7-2 on Tuesday night from Riders Field.

Springfield (28-24) jumped in front with a three-run top of the first. Leonardo Bernal clipped an RBI single, Joshua Baez rolled an RBI groundout and Jeremy Rivas ripped an RBI single to take a 3-0 lead. The Cardinals then added a pair of two-run homers when Bernal drilled a two-run shot in the top of the third and Ramon Mendoza added one in the top of the fourth. Frisco (31-20) relievers **Daniel Missaki**, **Bryan Magdaleno** and **Ryan Lobus** proceeded to throw five-straight shutout innings. In the bottom of the seventh, reigning Texas League Player of the Week Luis Mieses jolted an RBI double to cut the Cardinals lead to 7-1. The Riders then loaded the bases in the bottom of the ninth. Josh Hatcher rolled an RBI fielder's choice, trimming the deficit to 7-2. Cardinals reliever Nathanael Heredia induced a strikeout and a groundout to secure the win. Springfield starter Max Rajcic (2-3) pitched 5.2 shutout innings, surrendering just one hit. Frisco starter **Florencio Serrano Jr.** (1-2) picked up the loss, allowing five runs across three innings.

#### WIN, WIN, WIN, WIN:

The Riders have been playing well as of late, winning nine of their last 12 games. During that 12-game stretch, the Riders are averaging 4.4 runs per game (2nd in TL to Springfield) and are second with 14 home runs. Because of a few big losses of nine, 12 and five runs, Frisco has a -1 run differential in their last 12 games.

#### NO SWING AND A MIESES:

RoughRiders outfielder Luis Mieses has been fantastic at the plate. Mieses is third in the Texas League in slugging percentage (.528), fifth in OPS (.884) and tied for sixth with 18 extra-base hits. He won Texas League Player of the Week last week, hitting .364 (8-for-22)/.462/.955/1.417 with four doubles and three home runs. In his last 13 games, he is hitting .310 (13-for-42)/.408/.738/1.146 with six doubles, four home runs and 10 RBIs.

On Thursday night, **Janser Lara** became the 11th different Riders pitcher to record a save in 2025. Frisco is the only team in Minor League Baseball to accomplish the feat this season. Current Triple-A Round Rock pitcher **Robby Ahlstrom** and **Gavin Collyer** are tied for the lead in saves (four) for the Riders and Skylar Hales has recorded two saves. Frisco's 18 saves are tied for the most in Minor League Baseball and tied for the third-most in franchise history through their first 50 games.

Rangers top prospect **Sebastian Walcott** has been displaying the power as of late. In his last 17 games, he has blasted six home runs while slashing .257/.329/.586/.915 with five doubles, 14 RBIs and 15 runs scored. On Friday, he became the fifth Texas League teenager since 2005 to record a multi-homer game, joining the company of Keibert Ruiz (2018, 2x), Fernando Tatis Jr. (2018, 3x), Alex Verdugo (2016) and Mike Trout (2011). His eight home runs for a 19-year-old in Double-A are tied for the fifth-most since 2005 through 52 team games, trailing Vladimir Guerrero Jr. (11), Delmon Young (11), Oscar Taveras (10), and Tatis Jr. (9).

#### ABIM-ELECTRIC ORTIZ:

Abimelec Ortiz has been on fire at the plate for the Riders. In his last 21 games, Ortiz is hitting .300 (24-for-80)/.411/.538/.949 with four doubles, five home runs and 18 RBis. In that 21 game span, his .949 OPS is the fifth-best in the Texas League while his five home runs are tied for seventh.

#### **MAY FLOWERS AND HOMERS:**

The RoughRiders both hit and gave up their fair share of long balls last month. They hit 28 this month, which was second in the league and allowed 31, which is the second-most. Frisco's 4.60 ERA was seventh in the league during the month while they went 16-10 in May despite a -6 run differential.

#### **DOUBLE-A DOUBL-A RON:**

Aaron Zavala has been on fire at the plate for the Riders. After a dreadful start, batting just .077 (2-for-26) through 10 games, he is hitting .306 (34-for-111)/.431/.477/.908 over his last 32 games. He leads the Texas League in walks (37) and is second in OBP (.419) while leading the league in walk rate (20.7 percent), a mark which also ranks 6th in Minor League Baseball (min. 150 PA). In May, he hit .305/.436/.463/.899, ranking 11th in average, second in OBP and 10th in OPS in the Texas League. It was his first career month finishing with a .300 or better batting average since August of 2022.

#### **BRATT SUMMER IS BACK:**

Mitch Bratt has been one of the stronger arms for Frisco to start the year. Through his first nine starts, his 1.89 ERA is first in the Texas League. He has the best start to a season through nine starts in recorded franchise histroy by ERA. His 3.6 percent walk rate, 7.9 K/ BB and 91.1 percent left on base rate are the best in the Texas League. His 55 strikeouts are the second most in the Texas Rangers organization and his 47.2 innings are the most thrown among Rangers farmhands.

**ABOUT KOHL** -While he was born in Orem, Utah, Drake grew up in Sachse, Texas (25 minutes from Riders Field) and attended Wylie High School. The Wylie Pirates produced NFL players Kyle Fuller, Chris Givens, Kameron Kelly and Nikita Whitlock.

REPERTOIRE

-Began his collegiate career at Arkansas Tech (2019), spent 2020 at San Joaquin Delta College in Stockton, California and ended with his final two seasons at Walters State Community College in Tennessee. WSCC is the same program which produced Texas LHP Brett Martin.

-In 2022, he was named NJCAA D1 Pitcher of the Year with WSCC after setting a program record with 160 strikeouts (15.43 K/9) while just walking 17 batters. He went 14-0 with a 1.93 ERA (20 ER/93.1 IP) in 17 starts as a redshirt sophomore.

-He and teammate Jake Knapp (3rd TM NJCAA All-American) led the pitching staff at WSCC, tying for the national lead with 14 wins.

#### 2025 SEASON

-Entered 2025 as the No. 13 prospect in the Rangers organization by MLB.com

-Tied a career high with 10 strikeouts in third start against Corpus Christi on April 23rd.

-On May 7th at San Antonio, threw 6.0 innings of no-hit baseball, at one point retiring 16 batters in a row. **Ryan Lobus** and **Skylar Hales** then finished out the sixth no-hitter in RoughRiders franchise history.

#### **2024 SEASON**

-Made first start of the season with Down East on 4/9/24, allowing just four baserunners (3 H. 1 BB) in 4.0 scoreless innings while striking out six.

-After spot start with Frisco on April 18th, he returned to Down East and pitched eight games for Hickory before coming back to Frisco for an August 25th start.

-Entering into August 25th, he has a 38 percent strikeout rate. That and his 131 strikeouts are first among Texas Rangers farmhands and his K/BB of 5.04 is fourth in the organization.

-In home debut with the RoughRiders on August 25th, Drake struck out six over six innings, allowing just two base runners (one hit, one walk), in win.

-In game two of the 2024 Texas League South Division Series, Drake threw 5.0 shutout innings, allowing just two hits and walking one while striking out six against Midland on September 19th.

#### **2023 SEASON**

-Made his professional debut for the ACL Rangers (Rk.) and Down East (A), totaling a 2-5 record, 6.86 ERA (33 ER/46.2 IP), and 55 strikeouts (10.6 SO/9) over 14 G/4 GS.

-His only scoreless outing of the season came in third appearance (6/22/23 @ A-MRN): 3.0 IP, 2 H, 0 R,0 ER, 1 BB, 5 K.

-Participated in Rangers' Fall Instructional League program.
