READY TO ROLL: 18-year-old switch hitter Roldy Brito welcomed himself to Fresno with a three-hit night and a pair of steals in his first start with the Grizzlies. Brito had a terrific year in the Arizona Complex League. In 51 games with the ACL Rockies, Brito posted a stellar .368 batting average, a .445 on-base percentage, and a .555 slugging percentage, resulting in an impressive 1.000 OPS. He collected 67 hits in 182 at-bats, including 13 doubles, 6 triples, and 3 home runs, while driving in 21 runs and scoring 46 times. Brito also showcased his elite speed, stealing 22 bases in 29 attempts.

WILDER SHOWING OUT: Wilder Dalis, who turned 19 on his Grizzlies debut Wednesday night, also delivered a multi-hit game while starting at shortstop. Dalis earned a promotion from the ACL after displaying a powerful combination of hitting, speed, and defense. He hit .352 in Arizona with 3 homers and 11 stolen bases in 56 games.

HILL'S HILL: Brady Hill continued a strong stretch with two scoreless innings on Wednesday night. This outing continued a solid stretch, as he has given up only four hits and 1 earned run over his last 5 innings and four appearances. Hill's recent performances have helped stabilize the Fresno Grizzlies' bullpen during late July.
