CIRCLE CITY ROUNDUP

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Sean Sullivan, Eddy Yean, Kyle Nicolas, Tanner Rainey and Yohan Ramirez combined for the sixth Indianapolis Indians shutout of the season to defeat the Omaha Storm Chasers 2-0 on Friday night at Victory Field. On a scheduled bullpen day, the five Indians pitchers combined for three hits, three walks and nine strikeouts across 9.0 scoreless frames while allowing just one runner to reach scoring position. After Sullivan's 3.0-inning, five-strikeout spot start, Yean and Nicolas bridged the middle-inning gap. Rainey and Ramirez closed out the contest. Meanwhile, a solo home run by Shawn Ross in the third inning and RBI single in the sixth as part of a two-hit day for Nick Solak provided the offense for Indy. Omaha starter Stephen Nogosek surrendered Ross' home run as one of three Storm Chaser pitchers on the night.

NO RUNS FOR YOU: The Indians put together their sixth shutout of the season last night, which surpasses their total of five from 2024. Their six shutouts this season are tied with Iowa for the sixth-most of any Triple-A team. It is the first time the Indians have recorded six or more shutouts through June 27 since 2018, when they had eight shutouts to this point in the season. Indy deployed five pitchers in the clean bill, which is the first time they have done so since June 19, 2024, when Braxton Ashcraft, Brady Feigl, Ryder Ryan, Ben Heller and Brent Honeywell combined to hold Iowa scoreless.

WINDIANAPOLIS: With last night's win, the Indians improved their Triple-A best home winning percentage to .725 (29-11) and moved to third among all full-season minor league teams. Indy's home winning percentage is its highest through June 27 (min. 20 G) since at least 2005, surpassing 2012, when they had a .718 winning percentage (28-11). The Indians have won 19 of their last 24 home games since May 11, which is tied for the most in Minor League Baseball in that span, and 27 of their last 34 dating back to April 16, which is the most in MiLB.

SO' HOT: Nick Solak recorded his team-high fifth straight multi-hit game dating back to June 22 at Columbus last night, which is also tied for the third-longest streak of multi-hit games in the International League this season. It is the first time an Indians hitter has had five straight games with multiple hits since Miguel Andujar did so in five games from July 29-Aug. 3, 2023. He has the highest batting average (.579, 11-for-19), the most hits and the second-highest OPS (1.583) of qualified Indianapolis hitters across his streak. Solak is also rocking a 14-game hitting streak since the first game of a doubleheader vs. St. Paul on June 12, which is tied with Arika Williams for the longest on the Indians this season and stands as the second-longest active streak in the International League. He has reached base safely in 18 of 19 games played and has hit safely in 17 games since returning to Indy on June 5. On the season, Solak leads qualified full-season minor league hitters in batting average (.376, 70-for-186) and ranks third in OPS (1.027). Solak's batting average is the highest by an Indians hitter (min. 100 PA) through this point in the season since at least 2005, surpassing Nick Gonzales'.358 average (43-for-120) through June 27, 2024.

ROUND-TRIPPING ROSS: Shawn Ross ripped his second home run in a three-game span after hitting the first of his Triple-A career on June 21 at Columbus. Ross has recorded a hit in each of his last four games and has a .357 batting average (5-for-14) with a 1.295 OPS across that stretch. He's reached base safely in eight of nine games since returning to Indy on June 8 after a two-game stint with the Indians earlier this season. Since his return, he is hitting .286 (8-for-25) with two doubles, two homers, six RBI and a 1.000 OPS.

RONNY'S RACKING 'EM UP: In last night's contest, Ronny Simon recorded his fifth multi-hit game since joining Indianapolis on June 6. Simon has reached base safely in 15 straight games since June 11 and in 17 of 18 games with Indy overall. Since debuting with Indy, Simon leads the team in home runs (3), RBI (12), walks (11), total bases (34) and stolen bases (9).

MALCOM MASHES: Malcom Nunez has racked up a hit in four of five games and has smacked three doubles since returning from the 10-day IL on June 19 at Columbus. Before being placed on the seven-day injured list on May 11, Nunez was hitting .320 with a .830 OPS while leading Indians hitters in extra-base hits (12) and ranking second in hits (30), RBI (15) and total bases (46). Since April 8 at Louisville, Nunez has reached base safely in 24 of 29 games played and has turned in a multi-hit performance in 10 of those games. He has a .330 batting average (32-for-97) with 12 doubles, two home runs, 15 RBI and a .870 OPS in that stretch.

CHEFFING IN JUNE: Outfielder Billy Cook was named the Indians June Player of the Month yesterday. In the month, Cook has picked up multiple hits in nine games, which is tied for the second-most of any International League hitter. Six of those multi-hit efforts came in his first seven games played through June 7. Across that span, he tied for the second-most hits (12) among full-season minor leaguers, only trailing Pirates No. 2 prospect Konnor Griffin, who had 13 hits in Bradenton. Cook also ranked seventh in batting average (.522, 12-for-28) and eighth in on-base percentage (.607). In June, he leads qualified Triple-A hitters with a .391 batting average (25-for-64) and ranks second with a .473 on-base percentage.

TONIGHT'S MATCHUP: The Indianapolis Indians and Omaha Storm Chasers play the penultimate game of their six-game series tonight at 7:05 PM from Victory Field. With a win, Indianapolis would clinch their first series split or better against Omaha at Victory Field since April 5-10, 2022, when they took four out of six. Since then, Omaha has taken three straight series in Indianapolis. MiLB's No. 2 prospect, Bubba Chandler, will take the mound for Indy against John Gant. Indianapolis is 10-5 in Bubba Chandler starts this year. He has made one start against Omaha, earlier this year on May 1, and held the Storm Chasers to three hits and one run while striking out nine in 5.0 innings of work. On the other hand, this will be Gant's first career start against the Indians.

ON THIS DATE IN 2009: In his first appearance with the Indians since Aug. 31, 2005, vs. Toledo, right-hander Ian Snell again toed the rubber vs. the Mud Hens for a history-making outing. Snell struck out a Victory Field era record 17 batters in 7.0 two-hit innings as the Indians won, 2-1, in 10 innings against their divisional rival. The record-setting performance didn't stop there as 13 of those strikeouts were consecutive, another Victory Field era best.

TONIGHT'S PITCHER

Bubba Chandler: Right-hander Bubba Chandler is currently rated the No. 2 overall prospect in Minor League Baseball according to MLB Pipeline and is the Pirates No. 1. In 20 career starts with Indianapolis, Chandler is 6-1 with a 2.28 ERA (23er/90.2ip) and 124 strikeouts. He has struck out eight-plus batters in eight of those starts and six-plus in 12.

Last Outing: Chandler matched a career high with six earned runs allowed across 2.2 innings on June 22 at Columbus.

Against the Clippers: Chandler has made one start against Omaha, earlier this year on May 1 at Werner Park, and allowed three hits, one run, and struck out nine across 5.0 innings of work.

IL Pitcher of the Month: Chandler was named the 2025 International League April Pitcher of the Month after he led all minor league pitchers with at least 20.0 innings in fewest hits allowed (seven) and batting average against (.106, 7-for-66). He is the first Indianapolis Indians pitcher to win a league monthly award since Zach Duke in May 2005. He went 1-0 with a 1.33 ERA (3er/20.1ip), 27 strikeouts and a 0.64 WHIP across five starts in the month. In addition to his minor league leading marks, he led IL pitchers with at least 20.0 innings in WHIP and finished third in ERA.

IL Pitcher of the Week: Chandler was named the International League Pitcher of the Week for Aug. 5-11, 2024, after tossing 7.0 shutout innings with two hits, one walk and six strikeouts while he secured the win.

Miscellaneous: Selected by Pittsburgh in the third round (72nd overall) of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft out of North Oconee (Bogart, GA.) High School. . Selected to the 2024 All-Star Futures Game and struck out Royals prospect Gavin Cross.
