#### **RIDERS THUMPED BY MISSIONS:**

The Frisco RoughRiders struck early with a first-inning homer by Luisangel Acuña, but the San Antonio Missions got just enough offense to win 2-1 on Saturday at Nelson W. Wolff Municipal Štadium. Ácuña homered to right field for a 1-0 lead with one out in the first inning, his 27th extra-base hit of the year and sixth home run, but the RoughRiders never scored again. San Antonio tied the game in the fourth inning on a solo homer by Ray-Patrick Didder and took the lead in the next frame when Kervin Pichardo scored on an errant pickoff. **Nick** Krauth (1-5) delivered five strong innings for Frisco, giving up just three hits and one earned run. The go-ahead run came with two outs and two strikes in the fifth inning. With runners on the corners in a tie ballgame, Krauth's pickoff throw got loose up the right field line and scored a run. He ended the inning on the very next pitch with a strikeout to finish his day but took the loss. Krauth walked one batter on Saturday and has conceded just two walks in his last four starts, totaling 18 innings in that span. Jackson Wolf (7-7) gave up just one earned run for San Antonio in six innings to capture the win. Kevin Kopps saved the lead in the ninth with a 1-2-3 inning. Evan Carter went 1-for-4, just barely ending his five-game multi-hit streak but still has at least one hit in seven-straight contests. Trevor Hauver pushed his hitting streak to 11 games with a single and a double. Thomas Saggese reached three out of four trips to the plate, walking twice and singling once. Frisco's bullpen covered three innings with just one hit, with one inning each from **Theo McDowell**, **Danny Duffy** and **Antoine Kelly**. McDowell and Kelly had two strikeouts apiece in perfect innings and Duffy added a strikeout of his own. Lasting just 2:09, Saturday's game was the shortest of the year for Frisco.

#### WELCOME BACK, CARTER:

Evan Carter has been fantastic since returning from the Injured List on June 21st against Springfield. Over his last nine games since his return, he has five multi-hit games, batting .457 (16-for-35)/.500/.743/1.243 with two doubles, one triple, two home runs, 11 RBIs and seven runs scored. Carter is now sixth in the Texas League in batting average (.308), fourth in OBP (.420) and 10th in OPS (.869).

### TO HAUV AND TO HOLD:

Trevor Hauver has been one of the best hitters for the RoughRiders recently. He is currently riding a 11-game hitting streak, batting .385 (15-for-39)/.510/.538/1.048 with three doubles, one home run, four RBIs, seven runs scored, 10 walks and a steal.

#### RISP-ECT THIS:

This season, the Riders are just seventh in the 10-team Texas League in batting average with runners in scoring position, hitting .254, though Frisco is fourth with 281 RBIs with RISP. Over the last 15 games (6-9 record), Frisco is hitting .252 (35-for-139) in those situations.

#### THOMAS THE TANK ENGINE.

Thomas Saggese has been incredible for the RoughRiders on offense. He had a 15-game hitting streak ended on Thursday. In that streak, Saggese hit .443 (27-for-61)/.507/.803/1.310 with five doubles, five home runs, 17 RBIs, eight walks, 13 runs scored and a steal. For his efforts against Springfield, Saggese was named the Texas League Player of the Week, hitting .591 (13-for-22)/.654/.955/1.609 with three doubles, one triple, one home run, seven RBIs, seven runs scored and four walks.

### AMBUSH EARLY AND OFTEN

Thomas Saggese has been fantastic on first pitches this season, second in the Texas League with a .565 average (13-for-23) when he puts the first pitch of an at-bat in play. He has a 1.540 OPS on the first pitch, which is second in the league as well. Luisangel Acuña has also been great, hitting .449 (22-for-49) on the initial offering while his 22 hits on the first pitch lead the league and are second in the minors.

#### SPEED KILLS:

Luisangel Acuña leads the league in steals with 33 and is on pace for a career-best 64 swipes. The RoughRiders are second in Texas League steals with 104 bases in 123 attempts (85 percent).

### ONE HOME RUN, PLEASE. AND MAKE IT GRAND:

The RoughRiders have had a knack for grand slams this year with Thomas Saggese hitting Frisco's seventh grand slam of the season on last Friday. They are one of two teams with seven grand slams in all of Minor League Baseball. Six different players have accounted for the grand slams (Hicks, Luisangel Acuña, Jax Biggers, Dustin Harris, Trevor Hauver, Thomas Saggese (2)).

#### ACUÑA MATATA:

RoughRiders infielder Luisangel Acuña has been on fire at the plate. The Rangers No. 3 prospect is hitting .300 (83-for-277)/.359/.448/.807 through the first 63 games. In June, Acuña hit .300/.336/.460/.796. When the 21-year-old arrived in Frisco in 2022, he had a wRC+ of 68 while it has nearly doubled this season (114).

#### WALK THIS WAY

On the season, Frisco's 354 walks are first among Texas League teams while their .352 team OBP is third in the Texas League. The Riders have four in the top seven players in Texas League walk rate this season: **Dustin Harris** (4th, 15.8%), **Trevor Hauver** (5th, 15.5%), **Jax** Biggers (6th, 15.5%) and Evan Carter (7th, 15.1%). Though he is not qualified for the standings, Aaron Zavala is walking at a 17.4% rate so far this season.



-Grew up in Berkeley, California and played under father, Matt, at Berkeley High School. Mother, Shelly Neufeld played basketball at University of California. Older brother, Tyler, played baseball at Baylor and was drafted in the 27th round by the Cubs in 2012 (Finished his minor league career with Double-A Jacksonville in 2017 after 164 career outings).

-Went to University of Washington for college. Earned Louisville Slugger Freshman All-American honors in 2015, going 6-3 with a 2.41 ERA. In 2016 and 2017, garnered All-Pac-12 honors with a 2.98 ERA and 3.15 ERA, respectively.

-Broke into the UW career and single-season record books including: career starts (T6th, 40), innings pitched (3rd, 284), career strikeouts (6th, 205) and single-season strikeouts (7th, 103) over his three seasons.

### 2023 SEASON

-Returned from Tommy John Surgery on June 5th and pitched four games with AZL Rangers. Surgery was performed on March 30th, 2022.

### **2021 SEASON**

-Named Double-ACentral Pitcher of the Week for 7/19-25 after fanning 7 batters, walking none, and allowing just 2 hits over a pair of scoreless relief outings (6.2 IP total).
