YESTERDAY'S RECAP

The Chesapeake Baysox lost their fourth game in their last five in a 3-2 loss to Altoona on Wednesday afternoon. **Trevor Rogers** gave up a two-run homer two batters in but settled in to deliver three innings pitched with three strikeouts on 44 pitches. **Braxton Bragg** punched out eight in 4.1 innings in his Double-A debut. **Silas Ardoin** tied the game in the seventh with a two-run homer. However, Aaron McKeithan drove in the winning run with a two-out RBI single in the eighth.

ARMS RACE

Chesapeake pitching has allowed four earned runs or fewer in 14 of the 17 games played this season (2.07 ERA in 122 innings pitched), which leads the Eastern League. The Baysox have also already collected nine saves on the year, which leads all Double-A staffs, and have yet to blow a save. Last season, the Chesapeake bullpen led all of Double-A in strikeouts (724) and innings pitched (653.2).

CREED CRUSHES

C **Creed Willems** is on a seven-game hit streak, which leads the team, and has reached base in 12 consecutive games. Over his last five games, Willems is batting .412 (7-for-17). The Orioles No. 12 prospect has tallied six doubles, which are tied for the second-most in the Eastern League. The 21-year-old is the youngest position player on the team.

TEACH ME HOW TO DOUGIE

OF **Doug Hodo** has been an on-base machine for the Baysox to start his first full season at Double-A. The 24-year-old is on a 14-game on-base streak, which is the longest on the team and is the second-longest in the league. The Orioles 6th rounder in 2022 is second in the league in walks (14) and is eighth in OBP (.410).

ACTION JACKSON

IF **Jeremiah Jackson** is tied for fourth in the Eastern League in hits (18) and tied for second in doubles (6) to start the season. Over his last seven games, Jackson has five multi-hit performances and is batting .375 (12-for-32) with four doubles and four RBI. The 25-year-old has struck out only four times in 66 total plate appearances (6% strikeout rate), while averaging a 27.5% strikeout rate in his career.

BRIGHT LIGHTS

IF **Trace Bright** makes his fourth start of the season for the Baysox. In his most recent start on Friday in Richmond, Bright gave up four first inning runs but settled in to pitch four innings while scattering seven hits. The Orioles No. 25 prospect earned his first Double-A win in 32 career starts in his last home start on April 12 vs Erie. The Orioles 5th rounder in 2022 struck out the eighth-most batters in the Eastern League last year (120) and holds a 3.96 career ERA in six starts against Altoona.

ONE RUN WONDERS

Despite having scored the third-fewest runs in all of Double-A (47), Chesapeake currently leads the Eastern League and all of Double-A in one-run victories with six so far this season. Last year, the Baysox had the third-most one-run wins in the Eastern League (25).

TROUBLE WITH THE CURVE

The Altoona Curve are the Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates. The Curve won their most recent series over Somerset after winning four of the last five against the Patriots. Chesapeake won two of three on Opening Weekend in Altoona. Altoona's active roster features five Pirates' Top 30 prospects (MLB.com): IF Termarr Johnson (No. 4), LHP Hunter Barco (No. 7), IF Jack Brannigan (No. 11), UTL Mitch Jebb (No. 13) and LHP Anthony Solometo (No. 14).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP J.C. Flowers makes his third career start for the Curve tonight in what is expected to be a bullpen game. The 26-year-old last pitched on Friday against Somerset and allowed six runs on five hits in just 1.2 innings in a no decision. Last season, Flowers went back-and-forth between Double-A Altoona and Triple-A Indianapolis, pitching 69.2 innings and posting a 5.04 ERA. Flowers has faced the Baysox 10 times in his career and holds a 3.68 ERA in 14.2 innings against them.

Arsenal: Fastball, Cutter, Curveball, Changeup, Splitter
Ranked the Orioles No. 25 prospect, via MLB Pipeline
Delivered 1,305th Baysox strikeout last year, setting new franchise single-season record
2025: Earned first Double-A win in 32 career starts after delivering first hitless start of AA career on 4/12 vs ERI (Gm 2) with 5.2 IP. Enters third stint (second full season) with Chesapeake.

2024: Completed third season in Orioles organization and first full season in Double-A with Bowie as a full-time starter. Eclipsed 100.0 IP for first time in career with 112.0 IP but allowed a career-high 60 BB. 2nd on team in IP and K (120). Led Eastern League in walks but finished 8th in K. Delivered 1,305th strikeout of the season in final start of year, which set a new Baysox single-season franchise record. Threw 4th-most IP, struck out 8th-most batters, and allowed 2nd-most BB in O's system. One of two winless starters in all of Double-A (minimum 20 starts). Went 5.0+ IP in only four starts. Baysox went 9-18 when Bright started. Started season strong with a 2.41 ERA in month of April (9th-lowest in EL) over 18.2 IP with 23 K. Ended season strong with a 1.93 ERA in 14.0 IP in September.

Career Notes: Began '23 in High-A Aberdeen and struck out 127 batters in 82.2 IP. Led IronBirds in K. Finished 4th in South Atlantic League in K. Earned promotion to Double-A Bowie on August 22. Went at least 4.0 innings and struck out at least four batters in each of his first four Double-A appearances. Completed first Double-A stint with a 2.12 ERA in 17 innings over 20 strikeouts.... Debuted professionally in '22 with FCL Orioles. Assigned to Single-A Delmarva on August 27.

College: Pitched three seasons at Auburn. Best season was his junior year in 2022 where he struck out a career-high 94 batters in 80.2 innings over 18 appearances (17 starts). Led team in starts, innings and strikeouts. Was only Auburn pitcher to start all 17 weekends of the season. His 94 strikeouts were 4th-most by an Auburn pitcher since 2000. Helped Auburn reach Men's College World Series and earned the win in Tigers first CWS win since 1997.

Personal: Drafted in the 5th round of the 2022 MLB Draft by the Baltimore Orioles out of Auburn. Highest drafted pitcher signed by Baltimore that year after not coming to terms with 3rd round pick Nolan McLean... Full name is Bob Ike Bright. Grew up an Orioles fan because he has family that lives in Havre de Grace.

The Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake (Chesapeake Ghost Crabs) are a part of MiLB's "Copa de la Diversión™" or "Fun Cup™" - a season-long event series specifically designed to embrace the culture and values that resonate most with Minor League Baseball™ teams' local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.

BOWIE PIT BEEF



The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Chesapeake Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s.
