- The Blue Jays won their fourth straight, scoring six runs in the final three innings to defeat Clearwater 6-3 on Wednesday night in Clearwater.
- Dunedin was shutout through the first six innings by Clearwater starter Enrique Segura, who didn't allow a hit through four.
- Toronto No. 1 prospect Ricky Tiedemann made his third rehab start with the Jays, working 3.2 innings, allowing 3 hits and 1 ER with six strikeouts.
- Trailing 2-0 in the seventh, the Blue Jays rallied for three runs without recording an out to take the lead. Jean Joseph tripled, then Cristian Feliz launched a two-run, game-tying home run. Braden Barry walked, and came home on Tucker Toman's go-ahead triple.
- Victor Arias pushed the lead to 4-2 with a solo home run in the top of the eighth. Clearwater got the run back in the bottom half, but Yondrei Rojas left the tying run on third base to end the inning.
- Dunedin added two runs of insurance in the ninth on an RBI from Robert Robertis and a stolen base from Manuel Beltre.

BLUE JAYS BATS ARE BASHING

In the first three games of the series with Clearwater, Dunedin's bats have surged. Across the last three games, the Jays are hitting .318 with 16 extra base hits (10 doubles, 2 triples and 4 home runs). The Blue Jays' 14-run output on Tuesday marked a season-high. Dunedin has at least 10 hits in each of the last three contests.

BACK ON THE HOMESTEAD

The Blue Jays finished a nine-game road trip with last night's 6-3 victory over Clearwater. Dunedin lost four of the first five games of the trip at Lakeland, but then finished with four consecutive victories.

TUCKER TOMAN'S TURNAROUND

After going 61 games without one, Tucker Toman has collected back-to-back three-hit outings for Dunedin. Before his double on Tuesday night, Toman had gone eight straight games without an extra base hit.

CRISTIAN CRUSHES

Cristian Feliz's seventh inning two-run home run Tuesday left the bat at 116 MPH - the hardest hit ball recorded in the Florida State League this season, surpassing Jordan Viars' 114 MPH home run on June 2nd. Feliz's seventh inning home run last night left the bat at 113 MPH. Feliz has hit four home runs with an exit velocity of 111 MPH or harder this season. Four of Feliz's 12 home runs this season have come against Clearwater.

JOEY VOTTO STILL BANGS

After opening his minor league rehab assignment 0-12, Joey Votto has four hits in his last two games, including a three-hit performance on Tuesday at Clearwater. Votto stole a base on Monday, his first stolen base since June 18, 2021.

NICE TO SEE YOU, NIMMALA

In five games since his return to Dunedin from the FCL Blue Jays, Arjun Nimmala is 7-19 (.368) with four extra base hits. Nimmala was placed on Dunedin's development list on May 14, and then was assigned to the FCL Blue Jays on June 3. Nimmala was the Blue Jays first round draft pick last season, and is the organization's third-ranked prospect according to MLB Pipeline.

FERNANDO IS THE FUTURE

It was announced Tuesday that Blue Jays RHP Fernando Perez would represent Toronto in the All-Star Futures game on Saturday July 13 in Arlington. In 13 starts this season, Perez ranks among the Florida State League leaders in ERA (3.60), Ks (76), innings (70), and WHIP (1.04). Perez is the first active member of the Dunedin roster to be selected since Francisco Rios in 2016.

REHAB CITY, USA

Including last night's starter Ricky Tiedemann, Dunedin has hosted 14 MLB/MiLB rehab players this season. Joey Votto's rehab assignment from AAA-Buffalo continues tonight. Other notable rehabs include Alek Manoah, Damiano Palmegiani (AAA), and Riley Tirotta (AAA).

SERIES SUCCESS STYMIED

Last week's four-games to two series loss to Lakeland snapped a streak of six straight sets with at least a split for the D-Jays. The team's last series loss came on the road at Fort Myers, May 7-12. Dunedin can get back in the series win column with a win tonight.

EIGHT OR MORE MEANS WINS GALORE

Including Monday and Tuesday night's wins, the Blue Jays are 16-1 when scoring eight runs or more this season.
