LAST TIME OUT...

MOOSIC, Pa. (June 4, 2021) – The Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders fought back and brought the tying run to the plate in the bottom of the ninth inning, but ultimately fell short in a 5-4 loss to the Lehigh Valley IronPigs on Friday night at PNC Field.

In his first start with the RailRiders since May 22, Deivi Garcia struck out the side in the first inning and turned in a strong performance. The right-hander allowed only two hits and struck out seven while walking three in a season-long 5.1 innings of work.

Thomas Milone gave the RailRiders a 1-0 lead in the bottom of the fourth with a solo home run to right field off Bailey Falter. That was the only run of the game allowed by Falter (2-0) in 5.0 innings of work. The blast was Milone's first long ball of the season with Scranton/Wilkes-Barre.

Garcia (1-1) left the game with one out and runners on first and second in the top of the sixth, with the RailRiders still leading 1-0. Nick Goody entered and allowed a three-run home run to Mickey Moniak, and the IronPigs grabbed a 3-1 advantage.

The RailRiders clawed closer in the bottom of the seventh, when back-to-back doubles for Andrew Velazquez and Armando Alvarez tallied a run to cut the deficit to 3-2. However, Moniak connected for a two-run home run in the top of the eighth off Addison Russ to pad the lead to 5-2.

In the bottom of the ninth Max McDowell lofted a two-out single against Neftali Feliz, and Andrew Velazquez followed with a two-run opposite field home run to bring the RailRiders to within a run. Feliz struck out pinch-hitter Socrates Brito to end the game and seal the win.

NEWS & NOTES

TWIN STREAKS: Entering play on Saturday afternoon two Scranton/Wilkes-Barre players carry 11-game on-base streaks. Outfielders **Estevan Florial** and **Trey Amburgey** have both reached base safely at least once in 11 consecutive games played. However, their on-base percentages during their respective streaks are starkly different. Florial has reached base at a .294 clip in his last 11 games, while Amburgey checks in at .465. The dual streaks are tied for the longest on-base streak for a RailRider this season with **Chris Gittens** who also reached safely in 11 straight games from 5/4-16. The SWB franchise record for longest on-base streak belongs to **Brandon Drury**, who reached safely in 32 straight games in the 2018 season.

FAST OUT OF THE GATE: With 18 wins in 26 games, the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders have kept themselves in elite company across minor league baseball. Entering play on Saturday there are only 16 teams across minor league baseball with at least 18 wins, with only Nashville, Durham and Omaha at that mark among Triple-A East teams. Bowie (AA, BAL) has the best record in minor league baseball at 21-5 on the season, and is one of only two teams with 20 wins. Overall, the Yankees have the best organizational record in baseball (69-35, .663), a 1.0 game better than Baltimore (68-36, .654), who has the second-best record.

A WALK IN THE PARK: Since his promotion from Double-A Somerset, infielder **Hoy Park** has been a hitting machine for Scranton/Wilkes-Barre. After a 2-for-4 performance on Thursday, Park is hitting .362/.474/.638 with 4 doubles, 3 home runs and 9 RBIs in just 13 games played. In 113 games with Trenton in 2019, Park totaled three home runs, and is already almost halfway to his career-high of 7 HR (2017 with Charleston and Tampa). Signed as an international free agent in 2014, Park already has five multi-hit games with the RailRiders, including a pair of three-hit contests. He has reached base safely in 12 games and recorded a hit in 10 of his baker's dozen contests.

BULLISH ON THE 'PEN: Before allowing three runs (plus two inherited runners to score) in 3.2 innings of work Friday night, the RailRiders bullpen had been on an incredible run. SWB relievers had combined to allow just two runs in 30.2 innings (0.59 ERA) against the Bisons and IronPigs in a six-game span dating to last Wednesday. Overall, the SWB bullpen ERA is down to 3.18 on the season, while the unit is averaging 11.87 K/9. That ranks as the third-best bullpen ERA in Triple-A East behind only Buffalo (2.26) and Durham (3.17).

WALK-A-THON: Through 24 games this season, the RailRiders have drawn 140 walks, the second-most in all of Triple-A baseball, trailing only Gwinnett (154). No other team in the minors' highest level has taken more than 133 bases on balls (Lehigh Valley). Overall, the RailRiders are tied for 11th in all of minor league baseball in walks, with St. Lucie (Low-A, NYM) leading the way with 177 walks. The top four teams in walks all play in the Low-A Southeast, which is using an automated balls and strikes (ABS) system this season. SWB's team .362 OBP is tied for second in Triple-A East, and ranks tied for ninth across all levels of the minors. There are currently four teams in Triple-A East with team OBPs of .350 or higher. Lehigh Valley (.338) has the ninth-best OBP of the 20-team league. Among qualified hitters, the RailRiders boast **Chris Gittens** (2nd, .486), **Andrew Velazquez** (36th, .353) and **Socrates Brito** (43rd, .344) in the top 50 in OBP in Triple-A East.

THREE DOZEN SIDES OF BACON: The COVID-19 pandemic has created one of the most unusual season schedules in the history of the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre franchise. With the season beginning a full month later than traditional, all teams in Triple-A East will play 120-game schedules. The RailRiders, along with the rest of the Northeast Division teams, will exclusively play teams within the division. This leads to a schedule where SWB plays the rival Lehigh Valley IronPigs an unprecedented 36 times. For perspective, the RailRiders play the Rochester Red Wings and the Buffalo Bisons a combined 36 times. The RailRiders currently lead the 2021 IronRail Series 6-4.

BIG TEN: The RailRiders' 10-2 win over the Lehigh Valley IronPigs on Wednesday was the fourth time this season that the Baby Bombers have scored at least 10 runs in a ballgame this year in 24 games. Before Wednesday night, the last time the RailRiders had accomplished the feat was on May 18 at Rochester in an 11-6 win. It also marked the first time that SWB scored double-digits at PNC Field this season, having also done so twice in the opening series of the season at Syracuse.

LAST TIME OUT: Koerner continued what has been a strong start to the season on Saturday, May 29 against Buffalo, picking up his first win of the season. The right-hander lasted 5.1 innings, still the longest start of the season for a Scranton/Wilkes-Barre pitcher and scattered seven hits while allowing two runs and striking out three. The key for Koerner was that he did not allow a walk in the outing, after yielding five free passes in his previous start against the Rochester Red Wings.

WELCOME BACK, KOERNER: After not playing in the 2020 season due to the COVID-19 pandemic, Brody Koerner returns to the RailRiders for his third season with the club. He has the distinction of being the longest-tenured pitcher on the team who has stayed within the Yankees organization, with 30 appearances (21 starts) spread out since the start of the 2018 season. Teammates Adam Warren (54 G), Nestor Cortes, Jr. (42 G) and Nick Goody (32 G) have all made more appearances with SWB than Koerner, but all have left the Yankees organization and have returned in 2021.

STAFF WORKHORSE: During the 2019 season, Koerner logged 138.2 innings between Double-A Trenton and Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, tying him for most among Yankees minor leaguers (Miguel Yajure -- Charleston, Tampa). The right-hander also finished t-3rd in GS (22), 6th in AVG (.289) and Winning Percentage (4-8 combined), 7th in ERA (5.00) and WHIP (1.53), and 10th in K (109).

HEADING OVERSEAS: Following the 2019 season, Koerner left the country to play for the Gigantes del Cibao in the Dominican Winter League. It was the first time in his career that he played in a foreign winter league after the regular MiLB season. Koerner went 1-3 with a 2.17 ERA in seven starts with the Gigantes, striking out 21 and walking 17 in 29.0 innings. The right-hander was teammates with several former SWB RailRiders in the DWL, including Abiatal Avelino, Greg Bird, José DePaula, Anyelo Gómez and Adonis Rosa. Also appearing for the team were Wander Franco (No. 1 prospect in baseball) and Eloy Jimenez. Tonight's Syracuse Mets starter, Jesus Reyes, appeared in 17 games out of the bullpen for the Gigantes.
