LAST GAME

The Bowie Baysox fell to the Somerset Patriots in a 13-3 blowout on Sunday afternoon, which saw the home team stumble for the first time since Wednesday. Bowie allowed four home runs on the day, and at least one run in seven different innings. Somerset clubbed four big home runs to easily take the contest, as Garrett Stallings was saddled with eight runs in the losing effort. While Bowie did collect two home runs of their own, a solo blast by Maverick Handley, and a two-run shot by Andrew Daschbach, Somerset took four different Bowie pitchers deep to force the series split. Colton Cowser went 3-for-4 at the plate for Bowie with three singles and a walk, but Bowie never pushed him past first base.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

When Bowie and Altoona met less than a month ago, they were the top two teams in the league. Bowie took five-of-six in the series to send Altoona into the bottom half of the second half standings, where they've been slowly making a push back into playoff contention. The Curve have been run by their pitching staff in the second half, while they are among the bottom half in the league in runs scored, home runs, batting average, and OPS in the half. Despite allowing 56 runs in the six-game series to Bowie in late July, the most runs allowed in the league by nine that week, Altoona still sports a sub-4.00 ERA in the half, the third-best in the league.

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Pittsburgh's 2019 first round selection has been a prospect darling to scouts, but missed the start of the season due to an oblique injury suffered at the tail end of spring training. Following two brief rehab outings, he made his Double-A debut with the Curve in mid-June, and has looked right at home, perhaps even a bit better. As he navigated for efficiency over some of his starts, he has still just been able to finish the fifth inning in just over half of his Double-A starts. Outside of his control, Priester has been served losses on lack of support, notably when Bowie bested him 2-1 in July. While his fastball has been noted to lose a bit of its velocity lately, it still tops in the mid 90s, and pairs with his well-graded curveball. He also brings in a sinker, a changeup, and a newer slider that moves hard in the upper 80s and lower 90s.

MEAT LEFT ON THE BONE

Some of Bowie's offensive woes this season have not been from a lack of effort. In fact, the Baysox are the team most likely to start an inning with a runner on base in the Eastern League. Bowie leads the league in OBP and SLG (.369/.471) from the first batter of an inning this season. They also lead the league in lead off doubles. All of those numbers combine to Bowie leaving 845 runners on base this season, the most in the league, and an average of 7.4 per game. Inversely, Bowie has the second-most strikeouts in the league when batting with runners on base.

I'VE GOT A FEVER, AND THE ONLY PRESCRIPTION IS MORE COWSER

Bowie outfielder Colton Cowser has been staying hot since his call up to Double-A to start the second half. Cowser went 3-for-4 on Sunday with a walk. Already established as a patient batter, Cowser leads the Eastern League with 33 walks since he debuted to start the second half. Cowser sports a 16.7% walk rate across the full season, third-best in the Orioles minor leagues. Cowser is ranked as the Orioles #4 prospect and #54 overall prospect by MLB Pipeline at the time of his promotion.

FRESH RANKINGS

With mid-season updates to top prospect lists, Bowie has reloaded themselves with some of the best talent in the Orioles organization. Ranked as the best farm system in baseball by *MLB Pipeline*, Bowie sports nine players among the update top-30 Orioles prospects. CAREER NOTES

- Finished two-plus year career at Ball State going 12-4 with a 3.43 ERA, including 199 strikeouts in 139 innings pitched.
- Redshirted his freshman season at Ball State in 2018 while recovering from Tommy John surgery
- Comes from a long legacy of Indiana basketball.
 - Older brother Sean, played in the NBA for the Memphis Grizzlies during the 2020-21 season, and collegiately at Butler
 - Mother, Kim, played at Indiana State
 - Grandfather, Alan Darner, was a high school basketball coach who won two Indiana state championships, and is in the Indiana state basketball hall of fame.
 - Uncles, Linc and Tige, played at Purdue and Appalachian State, respectively.
 - Uncle Linc was head men's basketball coach at D2 Florida Southern, and won a national championship in 2015. Also coached Wisconsin-Green Bay, and reached the March Madness tournament in 2016. Was Associate Head Coach at Ball State in 2022.

WHAT THEY'RE SAYING

BASEBALL AMERICA: "McDermott has a solid set of four pitches. He misses bats with an aboveaverage fastball that sits 92-96 mph and can get up to 98 on occasion. He pairs his heater with two potentially above-average breaking pitches in his 12-to-6 curveball in the mid 70s and a titling slider that gets chase swings out of the strike zone. McDermott's changeup is still a major work in progress, as is his control of both breaking pitches. Even during his excellent pro debut, he walked 10 batters in 18 innings at Fayetteville."

8/17 v SOM Double-A Debut. Career-highs in runs, home runs, and walks. Hit two snags in the second inning where he walked a batter and allowed a two-run home run. Walked three more batters and allowed a grand slam before being lifted in the fourth.
