Today: It's Lugnuts Comic-Con Night... Lug-Con! A free comic book will be passed out to fans as they enter the ballpark, vendors will be on site throughout the concourse, and much more, including a costume contest! Inside the foul lines, the Lugnuts play the fifth of a six-game series against the Dayton Dragons. Dayton has won three of the first four games in the series and needs only one more win this weekend to clinch a series victory. Overall, the Nuts are 5-5 during their 13-day, 12-game homestand against Dayton and Quad Cities.

Starting Matchup: The No. 27 prospect in the Oakland A's system, right-hander Jacob Watters, makes his team-leading fifth start for Lansing, opposed by Dayton right-hander Julian Aguiar. Watters was selected by Oakland in the fourth round from West Virginia last season, while Aquiar was acquired in the 12th round in 2021 from Cypress Junior College.

Last Night: Dragons 6, Locos 3. Trailing 2-0, Tyler Callihan doubled in the 6th with one out and Jack Rogers singled him in with two outs to bring Dayton within one. An inning later, Callihan and Rogers teamed up to slug two-run homers in a five-run rally, carrying the Dragons to the come-from-behind win. In the loss, Lansing received strong pitching performances from Jack Owen (3 2/3 scoreless IP, three strikeouts), Luke Anderson (2 1/3 scoreless IP, three strikeouts) and Tyler Baum (1 perfect IP, three strikeouts).

### Lug•Notes

Roster Stability: Lansing has made only six transactions this year, with only one player promoted to Double-A Midland Lazaro Armenteros) and no players yet received from Single-A Stockton. The only players to join the Nuts' roster after Opening Day have been pitchers Grant Holman and Brady Basso, each activated from the Injured List, and John Beller, signed as a minor league free agent.

Checking In: Speaking of Armenteros, the 23-year-old outfielder from Cuba has played in two games with the Midland RockHounds, drawing three walks in his debut and drilling a triple in his second contest.

Over in Omaha: 2018 Lansing second baseman Samad Taylor was traded last year by Toronto to Kansas City with Max Castillo in exchange for Whit Merrifield, and he's been outstanding this season. Taylor was named the Triple-A Omaha StormChasers' Player of the Month in April after slashing .333/.398/.462 with six doubles, two homers and 11 steals, and has followed up in May with a four-steal game two days ago. Three former Lugnuts have already debuted this season in the Majors (Ryan Noda, Hogan Harris and Mason Miller for Oakland), and Taylor is angling to be the fourth.

Master Noda: Speaking of Ryan Noda, Taylor's former Lugnuts teammate in 2018, the A's Rule 5 selection from the Dodgers' system went 3-for-4 with two doubles, two walks and three runs scored last night in the Athletics' 12-8 victory at Kansas City. 30 games into his rookie season, Noda is slashing .247/.408/.442 and has established a regular slot in the 2-hole in the A's offense.

Do We Hear Fight? C Daniel Susac went 1-for-3 with a walk and an RBI single last night, extending his hitting streak to seven games – which ties the longest hitting streak this season, previously established by Caeden Trenkle and Lazaro Armenteros. Susac is hitting .462 (12-for-26) during the streak.

First-Round Pedigrees: The Lugnuts' roster boasts the A's last two first-round selections. 20-year-old Max Muncy was the 25th overall selection in the 2021 draft and enters the season ranked the A's No. 1 shortstop prospect by MLB Pipeline. 21-year-old Daniel Susac was taken 19th overall in 2022 and is the A's No. 2 catching prospect behind 1B/C Tyler Soderstrom.

They Know Their Trade: Lansing has four players acquired by the Oakland Athletics via trade on its roster: Christian Fernandez (Tampa Bay Rays, 7/9/22, for Christian Bethancourt); Euribiel Ángeles (San Diego Padres, 4/3/22, for Sean Manaea); Junior Pérez (San Diego Padres, 6/30/20, for Jorge Mateo); and Alexander Campos (Seattle Mariners, 11/15/17, for Ryon Healy).

#### TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

**2010:** South Bend C Errol Hollinger's single leading off the 5th was the Silver Hawks' only hit in a 5-0 Lugnuts shutout victory at Cooley Law School Stadium, thanks to the combined efforts of Evan Crawford (5 IP), Matt Wright (2 IP) and Dustin Antolin (2 IP). Ryan Schimpf went 4-for-5 in the win.

**2016:** On his 21st birthday, Francisco Rios set a career high with 10 strikeouts in 5 2/3 innings, and the Lugnuts blanked the Quad Cities River Bandits, 6-0, in front of 9,816. Rios was promoted to A-Adv. Dunedin three days later.

**2018:** The Quad Cities River Bandits completed a three-game sweep of the Lugnuts at Cooley Law School Stadium, 2-0, ending Kevin Smith's 16-game hitting streak and 27-game on-base streak.

Retrospective: Watters made his Midwest League debut on August 31, becoming the Lugnuts' 55th different player used during the season, the 20th different starting pitcher and the 895th all-time Nut... at the time, he joined Micah Dallas (8th round) and TJ Czyz (12th round) as 2022 draftees on Lugnuts roster; both Dallas and Czyz start 2023 with Stockton.

2022 Midwest League Debut: Opposed MLB rehabber Wade Miley in his debut, 8/31 at South Bend... retired Jordan Nwogu on immediate broken-bat grounder to first, walked BJ Murray and wild-pitched him to second, RF Joshwan Wright then dropped a Luis Verdugo fly ball to allow Murray to score... issued two more walks but retired Kevin Made on a flyout to center field to end the inning, allowing one unearned run.

Pro Debut: Watters had made just one prior appearance in the minors before joining the Lugnuts on August 23 for the Arizona Complex League Athletics vs. the Ariz. Complex League Cubs: he walked Esmarly Tatis, who stole second base, retired Raino Coran on a groundout, tossed a wild pitch to move Tatis to third base, struck out Dilan Granadillo and then ended the inning with a Christian Olivo flyout to Austin Beck.

Entering Draft Day: Rated Keith Law's No. 68 draft prospect for The Athletic, with Law writing, "Vatters started the year in the Mountaineers' bullpen, where he hit 99 mph a few times, so the team moved him to the rotation around midseason, where he struggled more with control (37 walks in 50.2 innings) but also showed enough that some scouts think he can start in pro ball. Watters sits 94-97 mph with a power slider in the mid-80s that can miss bats ... when he locates it. It's not a bad delivery, with a reasonably short arm stroke and strong finish, so that's not the reason he doesn't throw strikes, but it's true across all of his pitches. It's much more likely he ends up a power reliever with two plus pitches. But with enough of a changeup to start and a delivery that looks like it should work, I wouldn't be surprised to see a pro team keep him in the rotation."... Fangraphs' No. 96 draft prospect.

Inked: Selected 124th overall by the A's in the 4th round and signed for \$491,750... highest pitcher taken by the Athletics in 2022 following first-round catcher Daniel Susac (currently starring at Stockton) and three straight outfleiders (high schooler Henry Bolte in the second round, Michigan Wolverine Clark Elliott in the compensatory round B, and Mercer slugger Colby Thomas in the third round).

WVU to the Pros: First of three Mountaineers selected in the 2022 draft... the 2021 Fort Wayne TinCaps featured two WVU teammates in 2021 draftees Jackson Wolf (4th rd.) and Ryan Bergert (6th rd.)... the last West Virginia player taken in the first round was Alek Manoah by Toronto in 2019, who in 2022 joined John Means as the only two Mountaineers to be named MLB All-Stars... the last West Virginia player to suit up for the Lugnuts was Ryan McBroom, who won the 2015 Midwest League Most Valuable Player award.

Current Ranking: MLB Pipeline ranks Watters the No. 30 prospect in the A's organization and the No. 11 pitching prospect... his grades: Fastball 60, Curve 60, Changeup 45, Control 40, Overall 40... his scouting report: "The 6-foot-4 Watters has the chance to have two at least plus pitches. His fastball was up to 99 mph as a starter this past spring, averaging close to 96 mph, and he can touch triple digits in shorter relief stints. He complements the heater with a true 12-to-6 power curve thrown in the mid-80s that can miss a ton of bats. He does have some feel for a mid-80s changeup, but it's well behind the two other offerings. For Watters to be able to have a chance at starting at the next level, he's going to have to continue improving his command. He has gotten better at finding the strike zone after walking 10.7 per nine in 2021. In all likelihood, he'll end up back in the bullpen, where he could have an 80 fastball to go along with a 65 or 70 curve."

Off to College: Did not receive much notice before his high velocity was discovered at a tryout in Morgantown... named to the Academic All-Big 12 Rookie Team as a freshman (5 G, 4.70 ERA, 7 2/3 IP, 4 R, 6 BB, 11 K)... as a sophomore, made 19 appearances: 3.33 ERA, 27 IP, 15 H, 11 R, 32 BB, bullpen-leading 53 K, . 165 aby, allowed, tied for team lead with four saves; named Academic All-Big 12 Second Team; NCBWA Stopper of the Year Midseason Watch List... made first college start in the 2021 Big 12 Championship vs. Texas: 3 IP, 0 H, 1 R, 4 BB, 8 K... as a junior in 2022, named preseason All-American; obminated early as team closer and was moved into role as Friday starter; struck out 15 Texas Longhorns in 6 1/3 IP on May 7; overall: 18 G, 11 GS, 3-7, 6.22 ERA, 59 1/3 IP, 64 H, 44 R, 41 BB, 75 K; named All-Big 12 Honorable Mention.

Hometown Hero: Home city of Rocky Gap, Virginia, is in the Ridge-and-Valley Appalachians, located near the West Virginia border... neighboring city: Bluefield, home of the Bluefield Ridge Runners, previously known as the Bluefield Orioles and Bluefield Blue Jays, which fed such stars as Alejandro Kirk and Vladimir Guerrero, Jr. to the Lugnuts when both were part of the Jays' system.
