OKLAHOMA CITY BASEBALL CLUB (16-9) AT ALBUQUERQUE ISOTOPES (6-19)

TODAY'S GAME: With the loss last night, the Isotopes have dropped four of their first five series of the year ... Albuquerque has lost 11 of their first 13 home games ... Right-hander Peyton Battenfield is set to make his Isotopes debut while Eduardo Salazar is scheduled to start for Oklahoma City.

SWIPES: Albuquerque has a stolen base in eight-straight games, the longest streak of the year and two off the franchise record set Sept. 8-19, 2023. They have stolen multiple bases five times during the stretch and 11 times on the year.

OUT THE GATE: Albuquerque is 6-19, tied with the 2008 Tucson Sidewinders for the second-worst 25-game start to a season for a Pacific Coast League club since at least 2004. The 2018 lowa Cubs began with a 5-20 record.

FIRST 25 CONTESTS: This is the sixth time in Isotopes history the club has lost at least 19 times in a 25-game stretch (also: Aug. 11-Sept. 4, 2004; June 27-July 21, 2008; July 31-Aug. 27, 2014; April 23-May 18, 2015; Aug. 24-Sept. 22, 2022; May 30-

ONE-RUN GAME: Last night was the 81st time in 270 all-time meetings (30%) between the Isotopes and Redhawks/Dodgers/ Baseball Club that there has been a one-run decision ... In 2024, it was the club's seventh one-run ballgame (3-4) and fourth against Oklahoma City.

VS. OKC: Albuquerque has lost seven-straight games to Oklahoma, their second-worst skid against the franchise. The RedHawks/Dodgers defeated the Isotopes in 12 consecutive ballgames from July 2, 2013-Aug. 23, 2015.

FIRST FOUR: Since Minor League Baseball switched to a sixgame series format in 2021, the Isotopes have dropped the first four contests of a set on nine occassions. It has happened three times at home: also against El Paso (Sept. 6-8, 2022) and Sugar Land (April 9-12, 2024).

BY WAY OF THE K: Albuquerque's pitching staff registered four strikeouts last night, tied for their fewest in a contest in 2024 (also: April 16 at El Paso).

EXIT VELOCTY: The Isotopes recorded just two batted balls in play over 100-MPH last night, their lowest total of the season.

BULLPEN: Last night was just the third time the Isotopes bullpen held their opponent scoreless (also: April 21 vs. El Paso and April 4 at Oklahoma City). Karl Kauffmann started each of those

HITTING STREAKS: Aaron Schunk, Drew Romo and Jimmy Herron all have 13-games hitting streaks, which are tied for the third-longest active hitting streaks in Triple-A (longest: Jonathan Arauz, 15, Oklahoma City).

STOVIE: Hunter Stovall tallied a single last night and is 6-for-9 over his first two games in 2024. All six hits have been singles.

BECK'S BARRELS: Has a 15.1 percent barrel rate (11 barrels/73 BBE), 9th-highest in Triple-A (highest: Joey Loperfido 25.8, min 50 BBE) ... His 11 barrels are tied for T-7th in Triple-A (most: 16, Loperfido).

SAM I AM: Sam Hilliard did not record a hit for the seventh time this season last night, ending a modest five-game hitting streak He is one homer shy of tying Jordan Patterson's Isotopes team record for homers.

TRIPLE-A LEADERBOARD: Jordan Beck is T-2nd in XBH (16), T-4th in RBI (26) and doubles (9), T-5th in runs (22) and T-5th in

NUCLEI NOTES

SKIPPER: Pedro Lopez enters his 20th year as a minor league manager and second guiding the Isotopes, the eighth manager in club history ... Spent 2021 as Albuquerque's hitting coach and 2022 as its bench coach ... Notched his 1,000th career managerial victory June 4, 2023 at Salt Lake, 7-1. Managed in the Texas Rangers (2001-05, 2007) and New York Mets (2011-19) organizations while claiming the 2014 Eastern League Championship with Double-A Binghamton. Lopez was drafted in the 21st round by the San Diego Padres in the 1988 MLB Draft and spent 13 years in the minor leagues, reaching Triple-A on four occasions.

HOMETOWN KID: Jordan Pacheco begins his third season as the Isotopes hitting coach ... An Albuquerque native and 2004 graduate of La Cueva High School, Pacheco then attended the University of New Mexico (2005-07), where he was one of the most prolific offensive players in school history (.384, 59 2B, 25 HR, 145 RBI) ... Drafted by Rockies in the 9th round in 2007 and made his MLB debut with Colorado in 2011.

CHRIS MICHALAK: Begins his second season as Isotopes pitching coach ... Pitched for the Albuquerque Dukes in 2000, followed by stints with the Isotopes in 2004 and 2008 ... Started second-to-last game in Dukes history, giving up two runs in 6.0 innings during Game 4 of a PCL First Round playoff series at Memphis Sept. 9, 2000 ... Appeared in 61 Major League games (24 starts) over five season with the Arizona Diamondbacks (1998), Toronto Blue Jays (2001) Texas Rangers (2001-02) and Cincinnati Reds (2006) ... 12th round selection by the Athletics in 1993 ... Has been in the coaching ranks since 2009, including stops as the pitching coach for the Hagerstown Suns (2010-11), Potomac Nationals (2012-13) and Harrisburg Senators (2014-17). He was also the Minor League pitching coordinator for the Miami Marlins form 2018-20 and coached in the Washington Nationals organization from 2021-22.

MICHAEL RYAN: Enters his first year with the Rockies organization as the Isotopes bench coach ... It's his second stop in Albuquerque after the former outfielder played in 33 games for the club and hit nine homers during the 2008 campaign. He and Michalak were teammates on that squad for four days in late July ... Entered the coaching ranks in 2012 as a coach for the Double-A Altoona Curve (Pirates). He then managed in the Pirates organization at three levels for seven seasons with stops at Single-A West Virginia (2013-14), High-A Bradenton (2015-16) and Double-A Altoona (2017-19), while winning the Florida State League in 2016 and Eastern League in 2017. Ryan compiled a 221-197 managerial record with Altoona—the most wins for a manager in Curve history ... He also managed in the Cubs organization (High-A South Bend, 2021 and Double-A Tennessee, 2022-June 2023) ... A 5th round draft pick by the Minnesota Twins in 1996, played in 149 MLB games over parts of five seasons with the Twins (2002-05) and Angels (2010) ... Last Angels player to wear 27 prior to Mike Trout's call-up in 2011.

SPLIT-SEASON PLAYOFF FORMAT: For the second-straight year, the Pacific Coast League will use a split-season format to determine playoff participants. With one 10 team division, the first half winner (concluding June 23) will host the second half winner (beginning June 25) in a three-game set. The winner will then face the International League champion for the Triple-A Championship in Las Vegas, NV, Sept. 28.

BALLS AND STRIKES: The Automated Ball-Strike System (ABS), now in its third year in the Pacific Coast League, will be used for all Monday-Thursday games while the Challenge System, second year in the PCL, will be used for all Friday-Sunday contests. Each team has three challenges per game, retaining one for each successful challenge.
