LAST GAME

The Baysox fell to the Somerset Patriots in 11 innings by a 6-4 final on Sunday night. Bowie grabbed a 2-0 lead early, as Jud Fabian scored on an RBI groundout from James McCann in the first, before belting a solo home run in the third. Right-handed starter Alex Pham pitched well for Bowie, allowing only two hits and two walks through five frames. However, one of the hits was a game-tying two-run home run to Aaron Palensky in the fifth. Somerset then took a 3-2 lead in the top of the eighth on an RBI single by Everson Periera, before Coby Mayo launched a solo home run to tie the game back up in the bottom half. Eventually, Somerset broke through first in extra innings, as they scored three runs on four hits in the top of the eleventh against right-hander Tyler Burch. Mayo countered with a run-scoring single for his second RBI of the game in the bottom half, but Blas Castano was able to keep Bowie at bay through both additional frames to secure the win.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

The Somerset Patriots enter tonight's game with a 46-27 record - the best across the Eastern League and good enough to clinch the first half title in the Northeast division. The Double-A affiliate of the New York Yankees, Somerset has been powered by its pitching staff this season, which holds a league-leading 3.75 ERA, while allowing the fewest home runs (58) across the league and accumulating the most strikeouts (736). Offensively, the Patriots have hit the most home runs (113) and stolen the second-most bases (136) - both notable weaknesses of this Baysox team. Somerset's roster is highlighted by six of the Yankees' top 10 prospects, per MLB Pipeline - OF Jasson Dominguez (No. 1 NYY/ No. overall), C. Austin Wells (No. 2 NYY/ No. overall), OF Everson Pereria (No. 4 NYY), INF Trey Sweeney (No. 5 NYY), RHP Richard Fitts (No. 8 NYY), and RHP Yoendrys Gomez (No. 9 NYY).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Right-hander Yoendrys Gomez gets the ball for Somerset in tonight's series finale. The No. 9 prospect in the Yankees' system, per MLBPipeline, Gomez pitched three one-run frames against Bowie on Wednesday, taking a no-decision. He missed the vast majority of April and May on the injured list, not making his 2023 debut until May 28. He has yet to go longer than three innings in any of his six starts this season, but also has yet to allow more than a single run in any outing. Injuries also hampered Gomez each of the last two seasons, with shoulder issues in 2021, before Tommy John Surgery in August 2021 kept onthe injured list until early June 2022 and limited him to just 47 innings. Still, the right-hander was able to progress quickly and make his Double-A debut with the Patriots by September, helping Somerset win game two of the Eastern League Championship series. Signed by the Yankees as aninternational free agent in 2016 out of Venezuela, Gomez features a mid-high-90s fastball, a sweeping mid-80s slider, a low-80s curveball, and a high-80s changeup.

THE A-MAYO-ZING COBY

INF Coby Mayo has been a balanced mix of power, patience, and run production at the plate for the Baysox. Mayo has five extra-base hits in his past three games, including a home run in three-straight games for the second time this season and the third time in his career. Mayo's 47 extra-base hits on the season are the most in Minor League Baseball. The No. 8 Orioles!/ No. 78 overall prospect, per MLB Pipeline, also leads the Double-A level in doubles (28), OPS (1.054) and slugging (.626) on the campaign. Mayo is coming off back-to-back Eastern League Player of the Week awards. In the month of June, Mayo hit .340 with an 1.178 OPS, consisting of 10 doubles and eight home runs.

RUNNING RAMPANT

Bowie has seen repeated struggles when it comes to the running game. Baysox catchers have only caught 12.5 percent of attempted steals against them in 2023 (12-for-97) - the second-lowest mark in the Eastern League. Active catchers on the Bowie roster are just 3-for-49 (6.1 percent) catching attempted base-stealers at the Double-A level this season. Somerset's 136 swiped bags this season are the second-most in the league, succeeding on 81 percent of its attempts. Offensively, the Baysox have the fewest stolen bases (60) in the league, with the lowest success rate (68.2 percent) as well. So far this week, Somerset is a perfect 10-for-10 on stolen base attempts.

SO, YOU WANNA SEE SOME FIREWORKS?

The home run ball has powered a lot of the offense for both teams in what has been a very high-scoring series this week at Prince George's Stadium. Somerset has already launched 13 home runs this week to bolster their league-leading 113 long balls on the season - 19 more than second-place Erie. The Patriots' home run success comes against a Baysox staff that has allowed 66 home runs at home so far this season - second-most in the Eastern League (Reading - 69). The Baysox bats have also had some long ball success this week, as Bowie has hit eight home runs against a Somerset staff that has allowed the fewest (58) in the league.

ALL RHODES LEAD TO HOME

OF John Rhodes put together a month of June to remember. Beyond plenty of highlight reel catches in the outfield, Rhodes posted a .333 average in June - the second-highest average in his career for an individual month. The No. 19 Orioles' prospect, per MLB Pipeline, launched three home runs, two triples, and nine doubles this past month, in addition to four stolen bases. Friday night's 3-for-4, 3 RBI performance was the second three-RBI game of the season for Rhodes, who sits second on the team with 33 runs driven in this season.

COACHING STAFF

Manager - Kyle Moore

2023 will be Kyle Moore's second season as the manager of the Baysox, and his 14th within the Orioles' organization. After leading Bowie to a division-best 41-28 through the back half of last season, Moore continues to display consistency at the helm of recent successful teams throughout the Orioles system. Moore led Class-A Delmarva to a minor leaguest 90 wins as manager in 2019. The Shorebirds were named MiLB.com's Team of the Year and Moore won South Atlantic Manager of the Year honors. Moore's career managerial record sits at 254-216 (540) entering the 2023 season. Prior to his managerial career, Moore also spent three seasons as a player/coach in the Orioles system (2013 Frederick Keys, 2014 Bowie Baysox, 2015 Delmarva Shorebirds). He then took a position as the Shorebirds hitting coach in 2016, before joining the Keys in the same role in 2017. Moore played collegiately at Alabama, before signing with Ballitmore as an undrafted free agent in 2010. He currently resides in Sarasota alongside his wife Whitrey, and his two daughters, Madilyn and Cameron.

Hitting Coach - Sherman Johnson

Sherman Johnson makes his coaching debut, as he joins the Baysox staff as the hitting coach in 2023. Johnson had a brief stint in the major leagues with the Los Angeles Angels back in 2018 and spent parts of nine minor league seasons across the Angels, Reds and Minnesota Twins organizations. Johnson's playing career most recently landed him in independent ball this past season with the Kane County Cougars. Johnson also played two seasons collegiately at Florida State.

Pitching Coach - Forrest Herrmann

Forrest Hermann joins the Bowie Baysox coaching staff in his second season with the Orioles organization. He served as the pitching coach of the Aberdeen Iron-Birds during the 2022 season, helping Aberdeen clinch a first-half division title and make it all the way to game three of the South Atlantic League Championship Series. Hermann guided one of the best staffs in the SAL last season, which led the league in strikeouts. Prior to joining the Orioles organization, Hermann spent two seasons as a pitching coach within the Cincinnati Reds organization hermann also served as a pitching strategist in 2019 for the Seattle Mariners organization at their facility in Peoria. Hermann also worked with current Orioles' left-hander John Means at P3 Premier Pitching Performance center in Missouri. He pitched for three seasons at the University of Evansville prior to his coaching career.

Fundamentals Coach - Tim DeJohn

Tim DeJohn returns to the Baysox in 2023 for a second season as Fundamentals coach. However, DeJohn also received a promotion this season and will also serve as the Minor League Infield Coordinator at all levels. DeJohn has been a part of the Orioles' staff since November 2019. Prior to joining the organization, DeJohn had an extensive background in the college ranks. He served as an assistant coach at the University of Memphis between 2017 and 2019 and was an assistant at the University of Hartford the two seasons prior. DeJohn played at Western Connecticut State from 2003-2008.

Development Coach - Ryan Goll

Ryan Goll, much like pitching coach Forrest Herrmann, is making a jump from High-A in 2023. Goll serves as the Baysox development coach for his first season in Bowie, after filling the same role for Aberdeen last season. Goll has also been promoted to Offseason Camp Coordinator entering 2023. Goll first served as a Player Development Intern for the Orioles organization in 2020, before joining the minor league staff full-time in 2021. Goll attended the University of Minnesota, where he began as a bullpen catcher and Head Student Manager from 2015-2018, before moving no to be a Student Undergraduate Assistant Coach in September of 2018.
