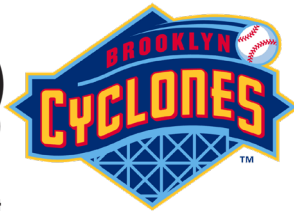

LAST TIME OUT: The Cyclones dropped Thursday's contest to Wilmington, 6-4...Brooklyn held a 3-1 lead entering the 9th...Blue Rocks scored 5 runs in the top of the 9th to take the lead for good on a 3-run C **Caleb Farmer** double and a 2-run CF **Andrew Pinckney** triple...Brooklyn scored in the bottom half on a DH **José Mena** sacrifice fly, but stranded the tying runs on base...1B **William Lugo** collected 2 hits and an RBI for the Cyclones...Pinckney and DH **Will Frizzell** each accrued multiple knocks for Wilmington...Brooklyn's RHP **Jawilme Ramírez** took a no-decision after allowing just 1 run on 3 hits over 6.0 innings.

ON THE FINAL FEW CORKSCREWS: Brooklyn is looking to secure a second-straight playoff appearance...The Cyclones are 36-27 in the second half and tied with Jersey Shore (36-27) atop the North Division of the SAL with 3 games left to play...The Blue-Claws hold the tiebreaker over Brooklyn because of winning the season series (15-11).

THE GUEST OF HONOR: INF **Luis Guillorme** joins the Cyclones on Friday to start a Major League rehab assignment...The 28-year-old has been on the Mets' 10-day injured list since July 22 with a right calf strain...Guillorme has appeared in 50 games at the Major League level this year, posting a .238/.304/.347 slash line with a .651 OPS, adding a home run and 9 RBI...The left-handed swinger started the year on the Mets' Opening Day roster before being optioned to Triple-A Syracuse on May 17...He was recalled back to New York on June 9...In 331 MLB games with the Mets since 2018, Guillorme is a .263 (188-715) lifetime hitter with a .683 OPS in addition to 5 home runs and 48 RBI...The Venezuelan-born infielder appeared in 125 South Atlantic League games with Single-A Savannah in 2014 and 2015, composing a slash line of .319/.391/.354 with a .745 OPS.

JETT THE MET: INF **Jett Williams** has been stellar since he made his Cyclones debut on August 1 and all summer long...Since returning from the All-Star break on July 14, the 19-year-old is slashing .308/.466/.585 with a 1.051 OPS, 35 runs scored, 12 doubles, 4 triples, 8 home runs, 21 RBI, 45 walks, and 16 stolen bases in 46 games between Brooklyn and Single-A St. Lucie...Since that date, no player in Minor League Baseball (min. 205 PA) has a higher on-base percentage (.466) ...On the season, Williams is tied for 4th in Minor League Baseball in walks (99)...**With one more walk, the Texas native will be the first teenager in MiLB to reach the century mark in free passes since the stat portal started in 2005**...Since making his SAL debut, the Rockwall, Texas, native has led the circuit (min. 120 PA) in on-base percentage (.446), OPS (.998), and walks (30)...He is also tied for 1st in extra-base hits (16), 3rd in slugging percentage (.552), tied for 3rd in stolen bases (10), 7th in batting average (.293), and tied for 4th in doubles (8) and 5th in hits (34)...Among SAL players with at least 140 plate appearances in 2023, Williams is 2nd in the circuit in walk rate (20.3%) and OBP (.446) and 3rd in wRC+ (.172), wOBA (.448), and OPS (.998).

TOP OF THE LADDER: With his leadoff double in the bottom of the 6th on Thursday vs. Wilmington, OF **Alex Ramírez** broke a tie with INF **José Peroza** (162) for the Cyclones' all-time hit record with 163...The 20-year-old is scattered among the Cyclones' all-time leaderboard despite joining the team last July 4...Entering Friday, the Dominican native also surpassed Peroza for 1st in doubles (37), is 2nd in walks (70), tied for 2nd in runs scored (86), 3rd in RBI (87) behind OF **Stanley Consuegra** (88) and Peroza (91), and 3rd in total bases (241).

KING STANLEY: OF **Stanley Consuegra** broke a tie with C **Francisco Álvarez** for the franchise record in career home runs by blasting his 23rd with Brooklyn in the top of the 5th on August 23 at Asheville...**He added another blast on Wednesday and is 1 home run (21) behind Alvarez (22) for the single-season home run mark**...He and Álvarez are the only two players in franchise history to record a 20-plus home run season...Entering Friday, Consuegra is 4th in the SAL slugging percentage (.477), tied for 4th in home runs (21), tied for 7th in extra-base hits (40), and 8th in total bases (163)...Over his last 19 games since August 17, the 22-year-old is slashing .243/.309/.608 with a .917 OPS, adding 18 runs scored, 2 doubles, 2 triples, 7 home runs, and 20 RBI...Since that date, Stanley has led the SAL in homers (7) and total bases (45) in addition to being tied for the lead in triples (2) and extra-base hits (11).

DON'T TREAD ON US: Brooklyn's outfield has done a marvelous job neutralizing runners on the basepaths in 2023...**The Cyclones have set a franchise record for outfield assists in a single season with 40 dating back to the start of MiLB's stat portal in 2005**...The previous franchise high was 30 set back in the 2006 season...Entering Friday, Brooklyn leads all High-A teams in outfield assists and has 7 more than the squad with the second-most (Asheville & Fort Wayne, 33)...Among all MiLB teams, the Cyclones' 40 outfield assists are tied for 6th...In addition, **Stanley Consuegra and Alex Ramírez** are tied for the team's single-season franchise record for individual assists with 11...That mark is tied for 2nd in the SAL this year behind Greensboro's **Sammy Siani** (12)...Before 2023, the previous single-season high for Brooklyn was 9 held by 6 different players.

CLIFF NOTES: OF **Ryan Clifford** has been an on-base machine since joining the Cyclones on August 3...The 20-year-old has reached base safely in 14 straight games dating back to the start of Brooklyn's two-week road trip...Since making his debut with the 'Clones, Clifford is tied for 6th in the South Atlantic League in home runs (6) and tied for 7th in walks (18)...The North Carolina native already has nearly as many walks (21) as he did in 30 fewer games (29 to 58) and 122 fewer plate appearances (128 to 250) than he had with Asheville before the trade...The 2022 11th-round pick enters Friday leading the SAL in slugging percentage (.494), 3rd in home runs (22), 5th in OPS (.835), and 6th in

vs. WILMINGTON: Brooklyn returns home for the final regular season series in 2023 against the Nationals' High-A affiliate...The Blue Rocks possess 7 of Washington's top 30 prospects per *Baseball America*: 3B **Yohandy Morales** (8), LHP **Jake Bennett** (10), OF **Jeremy De La Rosa** (13), OF **Daylen Lile** (14), OF **T.J. White** (16), RHP **Andry Lara** (19)...De La Rosa is currently on the 7-day IL and White is on the Development List...Through the first 27 meetings of the season, Brooklyn is 14-13 against Wilmington, including 7-8 at Maimonides Park...The Cyclones are 7-5 this year against the Blue Rocks at Frawley Stadium...The 'Clones are 40-37 all-time against the 'Rocks.

RBI (65)...Clifford also leads in isolated power (.250) by percentage points over teammate OF **Stanley Consuegra** (.246) and is 8th in wOBA (.371) and wRC+ (124).

LUGO LAND: INF **William Lugo** has been red hot over the last several weeks for Brooklyn...Lugo has reached safely in 13 consecutive games and is 16-for-46 at the plate (.348) with 7 runs scored, 3 doubles, 8 RBI, and 8 walks...Since August 15, Lugo is slashing .338/.415/.437 with a .851 OPS...Lugo has also scored 9 runs, picked up 5 doubles, a triple, 14 RBI, and 9 walks in 20 games...The Dominican native is tied for 3rd in the league in hits (24), 8th in batting average (.338), and tied for 8th in RBI (14) in that span.

BEST IN SHOW: Since the start of a 4-game winning streak at Hudson Valley on May 17, the Cyclones' pitching staff has, statistically, been one of the most dominant in Minor League Baseball...Entering Friday, Brooklyn has posted a 3.45 ERA (324 ER in 844.1 IP) over their last 97 games, holding a 53-44 record, which is the 3rd lowest in the minors...Tampa Bay's Single-A Charleston (3.41) holds the lowest mark...The Cyclones have hurled 10 shutouts in that span, tied for 3rd most in MiLB...For the entire season, Brooklyn holds the 7th-lowest ERA (3.76)...Additionally, Brooklyn pitching holds the 3rd lowest opposing OPS (.648), and 4th lowest hits-per-9 innings (7.33) and batting average against (.220).

THE DONUT SHOPPE: Brooklyn collected its 11th shutout win of the season with a 6-0 blanking at Greenville on Saturday...RHP **Robert Colina** (6.0 IP) and RHP **Joe Joe Rodriguez** (3.0) combined on the blanking...**With last Saturday's performance, the Cyclones have set a new franchise record for single-season shutouts...Before 2023, Brooklyn had accrued 10 shutouts in a season that happened on 4 separate occasions**...It previously happened over 76 games in the New York-Penn League in 2014...The 11 shutouts are tied for the 5th-most in all of Minor League Baseball.

GRAB A SEAT: RHP **Robert Colina** became the 6th different Cyclone pitcher to strike out 10 or more batters in a game in 2023 when he whiffed 10 Drive batters on Saturday night...He joins RHP **Joander Suárez** who whiffed 11 vs. Aberdeen on August 11...RHP **Jordany Ventura** punched out 10 vs. Aberdeen on August 9, RHP **Cameron Foster** K'd 12 vs. Wilmington on July 29, RHP **Tyler Stuart** struck out 11 vs. Hudson Valley on June 22, and RHP **Blade Tidwell** accomplished the feat on 4 separate occasions...Only Greenville has as many pitchers (6) strike out 10-plus hitters in a game this year...Since 2005, only one other Brooklyn squad had 5 different arms punch out 10 or more in a single game during a season...In 2013, LHP **Dario Álvarez** (12; 7/24 @ LOW), RHP **Miller Díaz** (11; 8/23 @ VER), RHP **Robert Gsellman** (13; 8/24 @ VER), RHP **Dawrin Frias** (11; 8/27 vs. TRI), and RHP **John Gant** (7/26 @ ABD).

DE RECORD SETTER: OF **Omar De Los Santos** entered as a pinch-runner and caught Hudson Valley napping to steal second base on July 21, giving him 33 stolen bases in 2023...The current 37 swipes breaks INF **Walter Rasquin's** franchise record for single-season stolen bases (32) which was set back in 2017 when Brooklyn played in the short-season New York-Penn League...He is also 4th in the SAL in stolen bases for 2023...De Los Santos remains among the best base stealers in Minor League Baseball since the beginning of 2022...The Dominican native has accumulated 107 stolen bases in that span, which is 8th most in MiLB...De Los Santos has also snagged 58 more bases than any other Mets prospect in that time...Fellow 2023 Cyclone IF/OF **Jaylen Palmer** is 2nd with 49.


AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: *Baseball America* released their updated list of Top 30 New York Mets' prospects...11 members of the 2023 squad are featured...OF **Ryan Clifford** (No. 3), SS **Jett Williams** (4), C **Kevin Parada** (7), RHP **Blade Tidwell** (9), RHP **Christian Scott** (10), OF **Alex Ramírez** (12), 3B **Jacob Reimer** (14), RHP **Tyler Stuart** (22), RHP **Raimon Gómez** (24), RHP **Layonel Ovalles** (28), and RHP **Jordany Ventura** (29)...Williams (No. 98) and Clifford (99) also appear on the publication's list of Top 100 prospects...Former Cyclones listed include INF **Ronny Mauricio** (No. 6), RHP **Mike Vasil** (8), RHP **Dominic Hamel** (19), OF **Matt Rudick** (20), and RHP **Junior Santos** (27)...In all, 16-of-30 members of BA's Top 30 have experience playing on Coney Island...MLB Pipeline released their updated list, as well...8 members of the 2023 team are recognized...SS **Jett Williams** (No. 3), C **Kevin Parada** (5), OF **Ryan Clifford** (6), RHP **Blade Tidwell** (10), OF **Alex Ramírez** (11), RHP **Christian Scott** (12), IF **Jacob Reimer** (13), RHP **Tyler Stuart** (17), and RHP **Raimon Gómez** (25)...Former Brooklyn stars featured are: IF **Ronny Mauricio** (No. 4), RHP **Mike Vasil** (9), RHP **Dominic Hamel** (16), and OF **Matt Rudick** (27)...Williams (No. 84), Mauricio (93), and Parada (96) are recognized in the Top 100.

LAST TIME OUT: Suffered the loss in his High-A debut on Friday night at Greenville...Permitted just 1 run on 7 hits over 5.2 innings...Walked 2 and struck out 6...Tossed 89 pitches and 57 strikes (64.0%)...Relieved by RHP **Dylan Hall** with runners at the corners and 2 out in the bottom of the 6th and Brooklyn trailing 1-0...Bequeathed runners did not score...Drive scored 2 more times in the 8th and defeated the Cyclones, 3-0.

PROSPECT RADAR: Ovalles is ranked as the Mets' No. 28 prospect at mid-season by *Baseball America*...The 20-year-old entered the season deemed New York's No. 17 farmhand by the same publication.

SWING AND A MISS: Despite ranking 18th in the Florida State League in strikeouts (84) fewer pitchers created more swings and misses than Ovalles in 2023...Among FSL arms that tossed 80 or more innings, the 20-year-old ranked second in the circuit in swinging strike percentage (13.8%)...Only fellow Cyclone LHP **Felipe De La Cruz** (15.4%) created more whiffs...Ovalles was also 4th in batting average against (.219) and 6th in strikeout rate (23.5%).

2023: Ovalles joined Brooklyn from Single-A St. Lucie on August 31...Made 22 appearances (18 starts) with the Mets...Composed a 3-6 record with a 4.73 ERA (44 ER in 83.2 IP), 36 walks (10.1 BB%) and 84 strikeouts (23.5 K%)...Thrived in the month of June...Went 1-0 with a 1.77 ERA (4 ER in 20.1 IP), 2 walks and 23 strikeouts in 5 appearances (4 starts).

ON THE RIGHT FOOT: Ovalles' numbers are much stronger as a starter than as a reliever in 2023...In 18 starts, Ovalles is 3-6 with a 4.33 ERA (35 ER in 72.2 IP) with 30 walks (10.0 BB%) and 72 strikeouts (23.9 K%)...The 20-year-old did not receive a decision, but held a 7.36 ERA (9 ER in 11.0 IP), plus 6 walks (10.5 BB%) and 12 strikeouts (21.1 K%).

2022: Assigned to the Florida Complex League Mets on June 5...Accrued a 1-2 clip with a 2.76 ERA (9 ER in 29.1 IP) and 1 save in 11 appearances (1 start)...Walked only 5 (4.2 BB%) and punched out 44 (36.7 K%)...Transferred to Single-A St. Lucie on August 9...Composed an 0-1 record and a 6.23 ERA (12 ER in 17.1 IP) with 1 save in 5 appearances (3 starts) for the Mets...Issued 12 walks (15.0 BB%) and struck out 22 (27.5 K%)...Made 1 start for St. Lucie in the Florida State League Playoffs...Started Game 1 of the FSL Championship Series at Dunedin on September 18...Surrendered 4 runs on 3 hits over 2-plus innings, walking 2 and striking out 3...Mets went on to win the game, 6-5, and take the series in 2 games.
