**PAPILLION, NEB.** – In the first meeting between the Storm Chasers and the Jumbo Shrimp, the Chasers won 8-6 Tuesday at Werner Park, the team's sixth straight win.

♣ Jacksonville led off with 3 runs in the top of the 1st inning, with a **Tristen Gray** two-run homer capping the frame for a 3-0 Jumbo Shrimp lead.

♣ Omaha didn't trail for long and the Chasers answered back in the bottom of the 1st with 4 runs to move ahead ... **Nick Pratto** ripped a double into center field to bring in **Drew Waters**, then **Devin Mann** followed with a single that scored Pratto ... **Nate Eaton** then put Omaha ahead with a 2-run homer for a 4-3 lead, his first of 3 hits.

♣ Mann recorded his second hit of the game in the bottom of the 3rd inning and doubled Waters in once more, extending the score 5-3 in favor of the Chasers.

♣ Omaha starter **Zach Davies** held the Jumbo Shrimp in check as he struck out 3 over 4.1 innings of work, only allowing the 3 runs in the 1st inning ... **Evan Sisk** came in behind Davies and offered a scoreless frame for his second win of the year, the first of six relievers the Chasers used.

♣ Omaha added another run to the lead in the bottom of the 5th inning to make the score 6-3 as Pratto drilled his second double of the game and once again, plated Waters' third run scored of the night.

♣ After getting the final 2 outs of the 5th inning, Sisk earned the first out of the 6th inning and passed the ball off to **Dan Altavilla**, who got two outs with one pitch, inducing a double play to work out of trouble ... Major League Rehabber **Carlos Hernández** worked a scoreless top of the 7th inning, then left-hander **Sam Long** worked a perfect 8th inning with a pair of strikeouts to keep Omaha up by three.

♣ The Chasers added two insurance runs in the bottom of the 8th inning as **Tyler Gentry** knocked in Eaton on a single and fresh off the injured list, **Austin Nola** drove in his first run of the year with a sac fly to score Gentry for an 8-3 Omaha lead.

♣ After scoring three in the opening frame, the Jumbo Shrimp were held to 4 hits in seven straight scoreless innings before closing the game in the 9th inning ... **Will Klein** entered the game in the final frame and allowed a pair of walks and hits to score three runs, with only one strikeout before he was lifted for **Walter Pennington**.

♣ Pennington struck out the two batters he faced and silenced the Jumbo Shrimp attack to earn his second save of the season and secure an 8-6 Storm Chaser win, the team's sixth straight victory.

### NOTES AND NUGGETS

#### THE MANN OF THE HOUR

After a strong week in Des Moines, **Devin Mann** was named the International League's Player of the Week yesterday, for the week of April 29 to May 5.

♣ Mann led the league with a .467 average (7-for-15), .579 on-base percentage and 1.446 OPS, while ranking second in slugging percentage (.867) ... 4 of his 7 hits went for extra bases (3 doubles, 1 homer), to go along with 4 walks and 5 runs scored.

♣ With a 2-for-4 day at the plate yesterday, Mann has now reached base in 18 straight games, the longest on-base streak among active players in the International League ... since April 4, Mann is hitting .354 (23-for-65) with a 1.053 OPS ... he has hits in 14 of the 19 games, with 8 multi-hit games during the streak as well ... he has reached base in 20 of 22 games this season with Omaha.

#### I'M DIFFERENT, YEAH, I'M (RUN) DIFFERENT (IAL)

Omaha has outscored its opponents 187 to 142 this season, a +45 run differential.

♣ A +45 run differential ranks as the 2nd-best in the International League and is 5th in Triple-A ... Sugar Land (HOU) leads the Triple-A lead at a +54 run differential.

#### GETTING OFFENSIVE

With six consecutive wins, Omaha has been one of the top hitting teams in the International League in the month of May.

♣ Omaha leads the IL this month in runs scored (47), hits (64) and total bases (113) ... a .380 on-base percentage and .873 OPS are ranked 2nd in the International League, while a .493 slugging percentage and 10 stolen bases are tied second in the league.

♣ Overall in 2024, Omaha's 187 runs scored rank 4th in the International League and tied 10th in Triple-A, with 6 of the 10 Pacific Coast League teams ahead of the Chasers.

#### KICKSTART MY GAME

Storm Chasers starting pitchers have taken a strong step forward in the month of May, consistently putting the team in a position to win.

♣ In May, Omaha's starting pitchers have a 2.15 ERA (7 ER in 29.1 IP), the best mark in the International League and 3rd in Triple-A ... their 0.99 WHIP this month leads Triple-A and a 185 opponents' average ranks 2nd in the level.

♣ Omaha's starters have allowed 3 earned runs or less in 8 straight games (dating back to April 25) with 3 scoreless starts in that span of time.

#### RELIEF AID

Omaha's bullpen remains one of the best in the International League and even across the entire Triple-A level.

♣ The Storm Chasers bullpen has combined to hold opposing hitters to a .205 average (109-for-531), which is the 2nd-best mark among Triple-A teams, while a .663 opposing OPS ranks 3rd-best.

♣ With 30 strikeouts and just 3 walks, **Walter Pennington** boasts a Triple-A best 10.00 strikeout-to-walk ratio (min 20.0 IP) ... his 37.5% strikeout rate (30 K in 80 TBF) is 3rd in Triple-A (also min. 20.0 IP).
