TODAY'S GAME: The Memphis Redbirds continue a six-game homestand against the Nashville Sounds (Triple-A Milwaukee Brewers) on Friday night at AutoZone Park. Right-handed pitcher Michael McGreevy gets the start for Memphis opposite left-handed pitcher Bruce Zimmerman for Nashville.

YESTERDAY'S RECAP: The Memphis Redbirds fell in game three of a six-game series against the Nashville Sounds (Triple-A, Milwaukee Brewers) on Thursday afternoon by a final score of 3-1 at AutoZone Park. Second baseman Thomas Saggese smacked his fourth home run of the series, a solo shot in the first inning to give Memphis its first run and first lead of the series. Saggese finished 2-for-4 in the game. The Redbirds stranded seven runners on base, six of which were stranded in the sixth inning or later and four were left in scoring position. Memphis has scored one run in the first 23 innings of the series. Starting pitcher Curtis Taylor provided 4.0 scoreless innings. The right-handed pitcher allowed two hits, walked three and struck out three in his first scoreless start of the season. Right-handed pitcher Roddey Munoz (1-1) allowed two runs on three hits and a walk in the ninth inning to take the loss.

WINS CHASE: Memphis Redbirds manager Ben Johnson is currently three wins from becoming the all-time winningest manager in Memphis Redbirds history. The Memphis native began the season 23 wins from tying Chris Maloney (367 wins).

FIVE-GAME SKID: The Memphis Redbirds are currently on a season-long five-game losing streak since game two of a doubleheader on Saturday against the Charlotte Knights. The losing streak surpassed a previous season-long losing streak of two games, which had happened four times this season. Memphis looks to Michael McGreevy to shut down the losing streak, who earned the Redbirds most-recent win in game one of the Saturday doubleheader at Charlotte. The right-handed pitcher allowed one run on five hits, walked one and struck out nine, a Redbirds season-high, in 5.0 innings.

MANAGER BEN JOHNSON

Ben Johnson enters his seventh season as manager of the Memphis Redbirds and his seventh year in the Cardinals organization.

COACHING CAREER

- 348 - 367 managerial record entering 2025 season, including postseason
- Oversaw a franchise record 15-game winning streak in 2021 (7/9-7/25); tied for longest in MiLB that season
- Oversaw a franchise record 200 home runs in 2019; team won 29 of final 40 games and were in contention for division until 2nd to last day of the season
- Spent 2018 as third base coach for the Durham Bulls (Rays' Triple-A)
- Spent 2014-2017 as a scout in the Arizona Diamondbacks organization
- Coached at Millenium HS in Goodyear, AZ from 2011-2013
- Previously managed Arizona Centennials in the Independent League in 2012

PLAYING CAREER

- Drafted by the Cardinals in the 4th Rd. of 1999 Draft; traded to Padres in 2000
- Made MLB debut on June 26, 2005 with the Padres; played 98 games over next three seasons with the Padres and Mets
- Named Padres Minor League Player of the Year in 2005 when he hit a career-high .312 with 25 home runs and 83 RBIs as a member of the Portland Beavers
- Played 901 MiLB games over 10 seasons with Cardinals, Padres, Mets and Tigers; hit .262 with 115 career home runs and 473 RBIs

PERSONAL

- Born in Memphis and played baseball at Germantown HS; named Memphis-area HS Player of the Year in 1999; lives with his dad during the season
- He and his wife, Elizabeth, have two children, Ethan and Ruby; reside in Phoenix, AZ

PITCHING COACH DARWIN MARRERO

- Marrero, 44, is beginning his 13th season in the Cardinals organization and third with Memphis.

COACHING CAREER

- Joined the Memphis Redbirds coaching staff following five seasons (2018-22) with Double-A Springfield Marrero's career with St. Louis began as pitching coach for the Gulf Coast League Cardinals (Rookie) from 2013-14, followed by the same role with the State College Spikes (Class-A) from 2015-17.

PLAYING CAREER

- Marrero's playing career spanned seven seasons from 1998-2004 with the Montreal Expos organization, attaining his highest level at Double-A with the Harrisburg Senators in 2002 and 2004.

HITTING COACH HOWIE CLARK

- Clark is beginning his third season in the Cardinals organization and second with Memphis

COACHING CAREER

- In 2015, Clark was named the hitting coach of the Delmarva Shorebirds, the Class-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. In February 2017, Clark was named the assistant hitting coach for the Orioles. He was named hitting coach of the Charlotte Knights, Triple-A affiliate of the Chicago White Sox, for the 2020 season. [9] On December 1, 2020, Clark was named assistant hitting coach for the Chicago White Sox.

PLAYING CAREER

- Clark played parts of six seasons in MLB with the Baltimore Orioles, Minnesota Twins and Toronto Blue Jays from 2002 to 2008.
- Clark batted .262 with three home runs and 26 RBI in his career

CAREER NOTES

- Cardinals 1st round pick in 2021 made his Major League debut vs. Texas on July 31, 2024, throwing 7.0 innings and allowing one run in a 10-1 victory.
- Sports a 1.96 ERA (5 ER/23.0 IP) through his first four career games, best by a Cardinal through his first four career games since RHP René Arocha's 1.52 ERA (4ER/23.2 IP) in 1993 (min. 20 IP).
- Over the past three seasons, led Minor League Baseball in wins (31), games started (82), complete games (4), innings pitched (447.1), and number of pitches (7,254).
- Has thrown 47.1 more innings and 655 more pitches than any other pitcher in minor league baseball since 2022.
- Enters the 2025 season ranked as the No. 10 prospect in the Cardinals organization by Baseball America.
- Was rated as having the "Best Control" in the organization in the 2022 and 2023 seasons by Baseball America.
- Has walked one batter or fewer in 54-of-89 career starts (23-12) and posted zero walks in 29 starts (11-6).
- Threw 7.0 or more innings in eight career starts, holding his opposition to two runs or less in all eight (four with one run and two scoreless).
- Led all Cardinals 2023 minor leaguers in wins (11), innings pitched (134.1), and games started (24) while finishing 2nd in strikeouts (107).

2024

- Began the season in Memphis (AAA) and made a team-leading 27 starts for the Redbirds, which ranked tied for 4th in the International League. Finished the season with wins in four straight starts (4-0, 2.35 ERA, 23.0 IP, 6 R, 28 SO).
- Was selected to the St. Louis roster on July 31 and made his Major League debut vs. Texas that afternoon. Fired 7.0 innings for the win allowing just one run in the 6th inning, as the Cardinals rolled to a 10-1 victory.
- Compiled a 1.96 ERA (5 ER/23.0 IP) through his first four career games, best by a Cardinal through his first four career games since RHP René Arocha's 1.52 ERA (4ER/23.2 IP) in 1993 (min. 20 IP).
- Became the first Cardinals rookie to pitch at least 8.0 IP in one of his first four career starts since RHP Alan Benes on Sept. 30, 1995 at Pittsburgh (3rd career start).
- First Cardinals pitcher to earn a win in his MLB debut at Busch Stadium since Nick Greenwood (6/16/2014 vs. NYM). First Cardinals pitcher to throw 7.0 or more innings in his MLB debut at home since Jason Simontacchi vs. ATL (5/4/2002). First Cardinals pitcher to throw 7.0 innings with 1 ER or less in his MLB debut since Michael Wacha vs. KC (5/30/2013), and first to do so and earn the win since Tyler Lyons (5/22/13 at SD). Started the game with 5.0 scoreless innings, most since Austin Gomber with 6.1 scoreless innings at CIN (7/23/2018).
- Became the 8th player to make his MLB debut with the Cardinals in 2024 and 6th pitcher.
- Optioned to Memphis (AAA) following his debut and was recalled on Sept. 18 and made his second appearance earning a win in relief with 3.0 scoreless innings in relief vs. PIT in a 10-5 win at Busch Stadium.
- Is the only Cardinal in franchise history to earn a win as a starting pitcher and then a relief pitcher in his first two appearances (7/31 vs. TEX & 9/18 vs. PIT).
- Threw a career-high 8.0 innings at on Sept. 29 at San Francisco on the final day of the regular season, allowing one run in a win. Marked the longest outing by a Cardinals starting pitcher in 2024. Struck out a career-high six batters in the 6-1 win.
- His outing on 9/29 at SF made him one of 11 rookie pitchers in 2024 (12 instances) to throw 8.0 or more innings.
- His 0.78 WHIP was the best in franchise history among Cardinals pitchers with 20.0 or more innings and three or more starts and best mark since Bob Gibson (0.85) in 1968. Was also the best among MLB rookie pitchers with the same qualifications.
- Ranked 5th among pitchers with 20.0 innings or more with a 64.1 ground ball percentage.
- 2024 Baseball America Triple-A All-Star.
- Led Memphis in innings pitched (150.0), strikeouts (138) and qualifying opponent BA (.259). Ranked among International League leaders in ERA (4.02, 3rd), wins (9, T-10th), innings pitched (150.0, 2nd), strikeouts (138, 3rd), WHIP (1.31, 4th) and winning pct (.529, 6th).
- His three complete games were the most in his career and was tied for the most in all of Minor League Baseball with Ian Mejia (Mississippi-AA & Gwinnett-AAA) of the Braves organization. Did not pitch more than 8.0 innings in any of the three complete games.
- Struck out a career-high 11 batters at Durham (5/23) over 8.0 innings pitched in a complete game 1-0 loss.

BACKGROUND/PERSONAL

- Graduated from San Clemente (Calif.) High School where he was a high school teammate of Andre Pallante.
- Earned freshman All-America honors as a reliever at UC Santa Barbara.

- Named semifinalist for National Pitcher of the Year award by the College Baseball Foundation in 2021.
- Two-time First Team All-Big West Conference: as a freshman in 2019 and again as a junior in 2021.
- Ranked second among qualified NCAA Division I pitchers in walks/9 IP (0.97) and strikeout-to-walk ratio (10.45) in 2021.
- Led the 2021 Big West Conference in innings pitched (101.2).
- Named 2019 First Team Freshman All-American by Baseball America.
- Is an avid fan of the Los Angeles Chargers.
- Planned to pitch for the Yarmouth-Dennis Red Sox in the 2020 Cape Cod League before it was cancelled due to the coronavirus pandemic.

- Signed by the Cardinals as a non-drafted free agent with an invitation to 2025 Major League Spring Training, four days prior to pitchers and catchers reporting. St. Louis become his eighth organization (Twins, Marlins, Rays, Braves, Royals, Dodgers and Orioles) and fifth in the last three years.
- Originally drafted by the Milwaukee Brewers in 2012, but did not sign. Played three seasons of Independent League baseball in the Frontier League for the Rockford RiverHawks and Aviators (2012-13), and a season in a men's baseball league in 2014, then the Greys (2015), before the Minnesota Twins signed him as a minor league free agent in August 2015.
- Made his MLB debut with the Miami Marlins on March 28, 2019, and retired Ryan McMahon as his only batter faced. Struck out the side in his next appearance two days later (Trevor Story, Ryan McMahon, Ian Desmond).
