Team Stats

Today's Game

The Fightin Phils remain on the road and finished a six-game series at the Binghamton Rumble Ponies, Double-A affiliate of the New York Mets. It is the 11th-of-17 games between the teams this season and and fifth-of-five at Mirabito Stadium. The Rumble Ponies took four-of-six games at Reading from Apr. 15-20 and return to FirstEnergy Stadium from July 22-27. Binghamton leads the season-series 7-3.

Game 28/29 Recap

The Fightin Phils split Saturday's doubleheader at Binghamton. Reading won the first game 7-5. Trent Farquhar hit a grand slam and Reading raced out to a 5-0 lead. Chuck King allowed two runs over five-strong innings of work. Binghamton tied the game against Gunner Mayer in the bottom of the sixth inning to make it 5-5. Hendry Mendez hit a two-run home run in the top of the seventh inning to give Reading the lead and Travis Kuhn finished off the win. In game two, Jonah Tong started and 6.2-perfect innings with 13 strikeouts. TJ Shook entered with two outs in the seventh and struck out Hendry Mendez to secure the first perfect game in Rumble Ponies' history. Gabe Mosser didn't allow a hit over the first four innings, then was tagged for six runs in the bottom of the fifth.

A Grand Swing

In the first game of Saturday's doubleheader, Trent Farquhar lifted a grand slam in the top of the second inning. The grand slam was the first of the season for Reading and the R-Phils' first since Justin Crawford on Aug. 10, 2024, at Akron. It was the first grand slam, and only the third-career home run of Farquhar's career. His four RBI in the game one win was a career-high as well for Farquhar.

Moore Please

Robert Moore turned in another excellent game against Binghamton on Saturday in the first game of the doubleheader. He had two hits, two runs and a double. So far this week, Moore is slashing .500/.588/1.000 (1.588), with seven runs, four doubles, a home run and two RBI. In nine games against the Rumble Ponies this season, Moore is slashing .444/.529/.963 (1.492 OPS), along with 11 runs, five doubles, three home runs, nine RBI and two stolen bases.

Keaton Crushing It

Keaton Anthony turned in the best game of his pro career on Wednesday night. He had four hits, one run, two doubles, a home run a and five RBI. The four hits matched a career high for the second time, with the last time being Sept. 5, 2024, at Aberdeen. The two doubles also matched a career best for the second time (8/11/24 at Wilmington). His five RBI in the game were a career-high and the second time this season a Fightin Phil had five RBI in a game (Robert Moore 4/15 vs Binghamton). Anthony's four hit game was the first time a R-Phil had four hits in a game since Carson Taylor on June 21, 2024, at New Hampshire. Anthony snapped a season-high 11-game hit streak and 16-game on-base streak after having no hits in the first game of Saturday's doubleheader.

On the Other Side of History

Saturday's second game was the first perfect game in Binhamton Rumble Ponies history. Jonah Tong went 6.2 innings pitched and struck out 13, then TJ Shook came in and retired the only batter he faced to finish off the perfect game. The perfect game was the first against Reading since August 25, 1990, when Kevin Morton of New Britain tossed a perfect game against Reading in seven innings. It was also the first no-hitter of any king thrown against the Fightin Phils since Bryan Bello of Portland did it in a seven-inning game on May 5, 2022.

Double Double

The Fightin Phils turned in seven doubles and eight extra-base hits in Wednesday night's game, both of which are season highs. The eight extra-base hits are Reading's most in a game since having eight on June 28, of last season, against Bowie. It was the first time the R-Phils had seven doubles in a game since hitting eight on June 29, 2018, against Hartford.

This Day in Baseballtown History

May 11, 2018: At Reading, the Fightin Phils battle back from a 7-4 deficit to beat Altoona, 9-8. The 8th inning is the big one for Reading as they take the lead for good with a 5 spot. Malquin Canelo starts the inning by scoring on a 4-base error as his fly to the warning track hits off the glove of Curve left fielder Logan Hill and rolls out toward center, allowing Canelo to come all the way home. Later in the inning, Deivi Grullon belts the team's first grand slam of the season into the pool. Grullon finishes 2-for-4 with 5 RBIs.

Rumbling into Binghamton

Binghamton enters today with an 18-12 record, sitting tied for first in the Northeast Division. In 2024, the Rumble Ponies finished with a 69-67 record. Binghamton was in Erie last week and went 3-3, having to play two doubleheaders due to two games being rained out. After this week, the Rumble Ponies are back on the road and face Hartford in a seven-game series at Dunkin' Park. Six of the Mets' top-30 prospects are on Binghamton's roster: Jett Williams (2), Ryan Clifford (4), Jonah Tong (6), Nick Morabito (17), Jonathan Pintaro (23) and Jack Wenninger (28).

Ponies Pitcher

Righty Joander Suarez makes the start this afternoon for Binghamton. This season, Suarez has made four appearances/three starts between Syracuse (AAA) and Binghamton this season, and is 1-1, with a 4.24 ERA (17.0 IP, 14 H, 2 BB, 17 SO). His last game was on May 1 with Syracuse against Scranton/Wilkes-Barre and Suarez took the loss, allowing eight runs on eight hits over three innings, with three strikeouts. Against Reading on Apr. 18, Suarez allowed no runs on two hits, with three strikeouts over 4.2 innings pitched in a no-decision. Suarez spent most of last season with Binghamton, but made two starts with Syracuse, combining to go 10-6, with a 4.49 ERA over 25 games/23 starts. The 25-year old signed with the Mets in 2018 out of Venezuela.

Fausnaught entered the game in the top of the sixth inning in relief of Jean Cabrera. Fausnaught inherited two base runners and allowed a home run to Carlos De La Cruz on the first pitch he threw in the sixth inning. From there, Fausnaught stelled into post zeroes in the seventh and eighth innings. He did allow a run in the top of the ninth, but was able to work out of a jam to give Reading the win and earn the victory in relief. Fausnaught was incredibly efficient, throwing strikes on 79% of pitches.
