#4 George Valera #7 Brayan Rocchio #8 Aaron Bracho #15 Tanner Burns #24 Jose Tena #26 Bryan Lavastida SUNDAY: The Captains were shut out by the South Bend Cubs, 3-0, in the finale of their six-game series at Classic Park. A threerun home run by Nelson Velazquez in the third inning supplied all the game's runs. Lake County starter Mason Hickman surrendered that long ball and took the loss, despite turning in a quality start with six innings pitched, three runs, two hits, two walks and six strikeouts. He retired the final 10 men he faced, following the home run. The Captains' offense mustered just four hits, but still brought the tying run to the plate in the ninth inning. Cubs reliever Tanner Jesson-Dalton struck out José Tena to end the game and secure the save. Tyler Suellentrop notched the win in relief after 2.1 scoreless frames.

LAST SERIES: The Captains took four out of six games from the Cubs. After games were postponed on Tuesday and Wednesday, Lake County and South Bend played two doubleheaders (Thursday and Saturday). The Captains swept both doubleheaders, while the Cubs won both nine inning games. Five of the games were decided by three or fewer runs.

THAT WAS WEIRD: In game one of Saturday's doubleheader against South Bend, the Captains won on a walk-off error when Cubs reliever Samuel Reyes dropped the throw back from catcher Harrison Wenson and Bryan Lavastida raced home to score in the bottom of the eighth inning. The Cubs entered that inning pitching a combined perfect game with six perfect frames by starter Ryan Jensen and one by Reyes. Lavastida broke up the perfect game with a leadoff double.

HOME COOKIN' TASTES BETTER: The Captains are 18-6 at home, compared to 11-19 on the road. Captains pitchers have experienced the biggest home/road disparity. Lake County has a 3.01 ERA at Classic Park and a 5.19 ERA on the road.

HOT LAVA: Bryan Lavastida is riding a nine-game hitting streak, during which the Captains' catcher has three three-hit games. Over that stretch, Lavastida has hit .471 (16-for-34) with three homers and three doubles.

WELCOME BACK: In 16 games since returning from an oblique injury, George Valera has slashed .280/.419/.460 (.879 OPS) with wo home runs, a double and a triple. Quentin Holmes returned from a groin injury on June 1 and has hit .358/.390/.472 (.862 OPS) since returning with a homer, a double, a triple and six steals.

HOT, THEN COLD: Brayan Rocchio wrapped up June with hits in nine of 11 games and hit .326/.408/.581 during that span. At the start of July, however, Rocchio has gone 2-for-16 (.125/.222/.125) with seven strikeouts and no walks.

BRENNAN BASHING: Captains OF Will Brennan is second in the High-A Central League (HAC) in doubles (17), tied for sixth in ktra-base hits (20) and tied for seventh in batting average (.289).

RELIEF ACES: Three Captains relievers have been the linchpins of the bullpen recently. RHP Nathan Ocker has a 1.35 ERA since June 1 with 25 K and 5 BB in 20 IP. LHP Tim Herrin has not allowed an earned run in his last four outings, dating back to June 15, with 11 K and 5 BB in 8.2 innings. RHP Jared Janczak has a 1.13 ERA since June 17 with 14 K and 4 BB in 8 IP.

ALUMNI UPDATE: 2017 Captains RHP Justin Garza became the 102nd former Captain to reach the major leagues when he bebuted for Cleveland on June 27. A record 10 former Captains have made their major league debuts this year – OF Ka'ai Tom (2016), RHP Luis Oviedo (2018-19), LHP Sam Hentges (2016), RHP Louis Head (2012-13), RHP Nick Sandlin (2018), INF Ivan Castillo (2014), Jean Carlos Mejia (2018), RHP Eli Morgan (2018), INF Ernie Clement (2018) and Garza. That breaks the record or the most former Captains to debut in a single year, besting the nine alumni that debuted in 2013 and 2016.

DEFENSIVE FLEXIBILITY: The Captains' have shuffled their defenders in 2021. Lake County has used four different first paseman, six different second baseman, six different third basemen and two different shortstops. Raynel Delgado, Brayan Rocchio and José Tena have each played three different infield positions. Victor Nova and Daniel Schneemann have played two

YOUNGSTERS: The Captains have five of the 10 youngest players in the High-A Central League – 1B Joe Naranjo (20), INF Aaron Bracho (20), INF José Tena (20), INF Brayan Rocchio (20) and OF George Valera (20). Naranjo, Bracho and Tena are he three youngest players in the league. Naranjo, who turned 20 on May 11, is the youngest player in all of High-A. Bracho (born 4/21/00) is the second youngest in all of High-A. The Captains have eight players who are age 21 or younger.

MAY VS. JUNE: Royalty had a strong May with Double-A Akron, in which he posted a 3.18 ERA across four starts. In June, however, Royalty had a 6.26 ERA in five starts.

2021 OVERVIEW: Started the season on the Captains' roster, but was called up to Double-A Akron before he made a start. Royalty made nine starts for the RubberDucks and went 1-2 with a 4.95 ERA. He was transferred back to the Captains on July 4

2019: Royalty pitched for the Captains in 2019 when Lake County was Cleveland's Low-A affiliate. The right-hander made went 6-9 with a 4.54 ERA and his 24 starts were good for third in the Midwest League, even though he missed two weeks on the Injured List in May. Royalty enjoyed his best month in June when he posted a 2.88 ERA. The former eight-round pick did struggle with control, however. Royalty led the Midwest League and set a Captains single-season record with 21 hit-batsmen.

GOT 'EM: Royalty's 100 strikeouts led the 2019 Captains, who set a Lake County single-season record with 1,207 strikeouts as a staff

**COMPLETE?:** Royalty pitched two complete games in 2019, though neither outing lasted longer than six innings. On June 13, 2019, Royalty pitched all 5.1 innings of a rain-shortened contest against the Great Lakes Loons and earned the victory. On August 5, 2019, Royalty pitched game two of a doubleheader at Dayton and went the full six innings in a 1-0 loss. If Royalty threw one more complete game, he would have tied **Keith Ramsey's** single-season Captains record, set in 2003.

**THE WEATHERMAN:** Weather affected five separate Alex Royalty starts in 2019, including his first three starts of the season. Royalty's first start (April 8) was postponed due to field conditions, his second start (April 14) was suspended after Royalty pitched just one inning and his third start (April 19) was postponed by rain. Royalty also had a start delayed by one hour and 16 minutes by rain (May 22) and a start that was shortened due to rain after 5.1 innings (June 13).

**RECORD-TYING DRAFT CLASS:** Royalty was one of six UNC-Wilmington players to be selected in the 2018 MLB Draft, tying a Seahawks program record that was set in 2006 and equaled in 2017. Royalty was joined in his draft class by C Ryan Jeffers (Twins – 2<sup>nd</sup> Round), RHP Austin Warren (Angels – 6<sup>th</sup> Round), RHP Clark Cota (A's – 10<sup>th</sup> Round), RHP Austin Easter (Blue Jays – 31<sup>st</sup> Round) and 1B Mason Berne (Braves – 33<sup>rd</sup> Round).

COLLEGE ACCOLADES: 2018 CAA All-Tournament Team, 2017 ABCA 1st\_Team All-East Region, 2017 CAA Pitcher of the Year, 2017 1st\_Team All-CAA, 2017 NCCSIA 1st\_Team All-State, 2016 Louisville Slugger Freshman All-American, 2016 CAA All-Rookie Team

**JUNIOR YEAR HIGHLIGHTS:** The reigning CAA Pitcher of the Year posted a 4.76 ERA in his junior season, but came back with a stellar showing in the CAA Tournament. Royalty pitched a complete game to beat Northeastern, striking out five and walking none, en route to a CAA All-Tournament Team nod. The Seahawks went on to win the CAA title.

**CONTROL:** Royalty walked just five batters over 22.2 innings in his pro debut season (1.99 BB/9). During his collegiate career, the right-hander walked 74 in 262.2 innings (2.53 BB/9).

**BASEBALL LINEAGE:** Royalty's father, Doug Royalty, pitched for San Diego State University and was drafted by the Houston Astros in the 18<sup>th</sup> Round of the 1987 MLB Draft. He pitched two years in the minor leagues with Short-Season Auburn (1987) and Low-A Asheville (1988), posting a 15-15 record with a 3.45 ERA. Doug showed similar control to his future son with just 45 walks over 234.2 career innings (1.7 BB/9).

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: Royalty's mom, Pam, and step-father, Rob Lease, were known for taking road trips up and down the east coast with their dogs, Bear and Roscoe, to watch Alex's home and road games at UNCW. On one occasion in 2018, Rob drove with the two dogs from Raleigh, NC to Phoenix, AZ to watch Alex play Arizona State. The journey spanned over 6,000 miles, round trip (Pam and other family flew to Colorado for skiing and then drove down to Arizona).
