Today: It's the finale of a six-game series between the Lansing Lugnuts, the High-A affiliate of the A's, and the host West Michigan Whitecaps, the High-A affiliate of the Tigers. This is the 461st all-time matchup, coming in the Nuts' 3803rd all-time game; 12% of all of the regular season games the Lugnuts have ever played have come against West Michigan. The Nuts are 5-6 vs. West Michigan this season with 13 meetings remaining.

Yesterday: Whitecaps 7, Lugnuts 1. This one was all West Michigan; **Joe Miller** tossed five scoreless innings, **Max Anderson** and **Bennett Lee** laced two-run doubles and **Seth Stephenson** added a two-run single in the Saturday night victory. **Ryan Lasko** went 2-for-3 with two singles and a walk in the loss.

On the Air: Today's game is on MiLB TV and Bally Live, with a Lugnuts audio stream via StreamGuys, **Adam Jaksa** and **Jesse Goldberg-Strassler** on the call.

On Deck: The Lugnuts enjoy an off day on July 29, and then welcome in the Dayton Dragons for a six-game series running from July 30 - August 4. Only three more homestands remain in the Nuts' 28th season.

Closing With a Flourish: The Nuts have been at their best this season in Sunday finales, posting a 10-7 record thanks to averaging 5.9 runs per game: an even 100 total runs scored in the 17 games. Notably, **Euribiel Ángeles** has posted an .857 OPS in Sunday finales, hitting four of his six home runs, and **Danny Bautista, Jr.** is slashing .383/.463/.447, going 18-for-47 with three doubles and six walks in 14 games.

Care for Déjà Vu? The last time the Lugnuts faced West Michigan ace **Jaden Hamm**, as they will today, Hamm tossed six innings of two-hit, three-run, five-walk ball, and the Nuts won 3-0 in one hour and 44 minutes, the quickest nine-inning game in franchise history.

Team Effort: The Nuts' offense is 1st in the Midwest League in at-bats (3154), base hits (790), total bases (1212) and triples (33) and ranks 2nd in runs (477) and slugging percentage (.384), and tied for 2nd in batting average (.250) and doubles (155), and 3rd in on-base percentage (.340) and OPS (.724).

All-Star Alumni: The Lugnuts were represented in the MLB All-Star Game by 2017 Nuts alum **Vladimir Guerrero, Jr.**, who went hitless, and 2022 Lansing standout **Mason Miller**, who tossed a perfect frame for the A.L., striking out **Shohei Ohtani** and **Trea Turner** and hitting 103.6 mph, the fastest pitch in All-Star Game history.

Prospecting: The Nuts have five Top 30 A's prospects on their roster: pitcher **Luis Morales** (No. 2), outfielder **Ryan Lasko** (No. 14), first baseman **Will Simpson** (No. 23), pitcher **Will Johnston** (No. 26) and third baseman **Luke Mann** (No. 30) as ranked by MLB Pipeline.

The Future is Here: 21-year-old **Luis Morales**, the youngest player on the Lugnuts, tossed 2/3 of an inning in the 2024 All-Star Futures Game at Globe Life Field in Arlington, Texas, striking out Jeral Perez and Deyvison De Los Santos alongside an HBP and BB. Morales was the A's sole representative in the Prospect Showcase, and the fifth all-time Lugnut to participate in the game.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2011: Through six innings in Game 1 of a doubleheader the Lugnuts had been held without a hit by West Michigan's Kyle Ryan and trailed 4-0, three outs away from being no-hit. Then Ryan left, Nate Newman came in, Jake Marisnick led off the 7th with a single to bust up the no-no. and the offense was alive. The Lugnuts went on to score four runs, tying the game on a Garis Peña two-out two-run single. In the 8th, the Nuts scored four more runs, capped by an Oliver Dominguez two-run homer. In Game 2, the Nuts overcame an early 2-0 deficit for a 3-2 victory, completing the doubleheader sweep at Fifth Third Ballpark. The game was shortened to one out into the bottom of the 6th due to rain.

2013: Catcher Dan Klein committed three passed balls, tying Santiago Nussy for the most in a game this season, and the Lugnuts lost at home to Bowling Green, 7-1. Hot Rods leadoff hitter Andrew Toles went 4-for-5, but was picked off base twice.

Last Time Out: Won his first professional game! Tossed four innings of two-hit, one-run ball at Lake County in relief of Will Johnston, and the Lugnuts rallied for a 6-5 win on a Brayan Buevas two-run go-ahead double in the ninth inning off league-leading closer Magnus Ellerts.

Back Home: Signed for \$75,000... high school teammates with current Lugnuts teammate Hunter Breault, who was one year older at Kamehameha-Kapalama H.S... graduated HS with 3.5 GPA... played club ball for Team California Baseball, top 10 nationally ranked... First Team All-State as junior (0.95)... 2022 - junior year at Hawai'i: First Team All Big West, ranking 3rd in the conference in ERA (1.90) and leading Hawai'i in strikeouts (88)... notable Rainbow Warriors in the pros include Cleveland's Cade Smith, Seattle's Josh Rojas, longtime infielder Kolton Wong and former Brewers closer Chuck Crim.

The Aloha State: The most career MLB games for any Hawaiian: former A's catcher Kurt Suzuki, 1,635, who also owns the most career homers (143); among pitchers, Charlie Hough's 25-year career stands alone. Former Lugnuts from Hawai'i include Dustin Antolin (also from Mililani) and Bryson Namba. 2009 lights-out closer Matt Daly is the only other Lugnut in team history to play ball at the University of Hawai'i at Manoa.

Minor League Path: Made pro debut in the Arizona Complex League in 2022 with a pair of scoreless innings, moving up to Stockton for two relief appearances by year's end... spent all of 2023 with the Ports, serving as their relief ace (11 saves in 15 chances) and only allowing three home runs in 61 1/3 innings... limited left-handed batters to .198 batting average / .530 OPS; right-handers hit .305 with .753 OPS.

In a Nutshell: Watters first appeared for the Lugnuts on August 31, 2022, pitching against Cubs rehabber Wade Miley at South Bend in his second professional appearance... he then spent the full 2023 season for the Nuts... he has spent all but one MiLB inning (of 93 total professional innings) with the Lugnuts... opened the 2024 season in a piggyback tandem with Wander Guante, who was promoted to Double-A Midland on May 14... on May 29, needed only 39 pitches to fire five scoreless innings against Peoria... promoted to Triple-A Las Vegas for an emergency relief appearances on June 23 at Tacoma, earning the win in a 20-10 victory; allowed first five batters to reach before recovering to record the next nine outs scorelessly...

In a Nutshell: After not pitching in 2023, dominated in Stockton to open the season, earning promotion to Lansing May 29 and making his Lugnuts debut in Game 2 of a doubleheader on June 2, becoming the 942nd all-time Lugnut and the 13th different starting pitcher this season... name is pronounced "Chen Jong-Ow Jwahng"... works with interpreter Yen Po "Rambo" Wang... nicknamed "Z."

First Lugnuts Start: Struggled in the first inning vs. Peoria, June 2, after promotion from Stockton, allowing three runs on two walks and three hits, including a two-out, two-run triple by Michael Curialle... set down the final ten batters faced, with five strikeouts, in a 5-3 Lugnuts seven-inning victory.

Temporarily Inactive List: Inactive from June 28-July 4, returning to Taiwan in connection to compulsory military enlistment.

Hometown Heroes: Giants pitcher Kai-Wei Teng is the only 2024 Major Leaguer from Taiwan, though Teng is currently with the Sacramento River Cats... there have been 17 Major Leaguers all-time from Taiwan, the first being Chin-Feng Chen of the Dodgers, who played from 2002-2005... the Yankees' Chien-Ming Wang (2005-09, 2011-13, 2016) has the most career wins (68), the Orioles/Marlins' Wei-Yin Chen (2012-19) has the most career innings pitched (1,064 2/3), and Cleveland's Yu Chang (2019-23) has the most offensive records, from games played (235) to runs (72) to hits (121) to homers (20).

Record-Setters: In Lugnuts franchise history, the first Taiwanese players were Po-Hsuan Keng, who pitched primarily out of the bullpen for the Nuts from 2005-2007, and Chi-Hung Chen, who a starting pitcher in 2005-06 and 2008... last year, Brock Whittlesey broke Keng's franchise record of most career appearances... Whittlesey pitched in 103 games from 2021-23, while Keng appeared in 94... Cheng owns the Lugnuts' franchise record for most career innings pitched (374), with Keng ranking second (202); Cheng also ranks first in games started (67), career wins (23), losses (20), starts (67), strikeouts (367), runs (188), hits (360), and walks (189).

Path to Lansing: Pitched at National Taiwan Sport University, signing with the Athletics in November 2021 for approx. \$500,000... debuted in 2022 with Stockton, making eight starts from April 12 - June 1, 2022... did not pitch again until April 10, 2024, a hiatus of 679 days between professional appearances... excelled with Stockton this season, never allowing more than one run in an appearance... of nine total appearances with the Ports, did not walk a batter in seven of them.
