GRAY & MESA JR. HOMER IN 6-3 WIN

Thanks to home runs from Tristan Gray and Victor Mesa Jr., the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp beat the Memphis Redbirds 6-3 Friday night. Trailing 3-1 in the top of the fifth, Jacksonville (33-40) plated their first of five unanswered runs. With one out, Xavier Edwards singled off Memphis (38-35) hurler Michael McGreevy. A ground out coupled with a wild pitch allowed Edwards to advance to third and then score on a base hit from **Troy Johnston** to cut the deficit to 3-2. The Jumbo Shrimp kept the momentum going tving the game in the top of the sixth. Gray (14) started the inning with a solo shot to even the game at three. In the seventh, Jonah Bride drew a walk to extend the inning and Johnston tripled home Bride putting the Jumbo Shrimp ahead, 4-3.

X MARKS THE SPOT

In 2023, Xavier Edwards registered one of the most illustrious seasons in Jacksonville's Triple-A/Double-A history (1962-present). His .351 batting average was the best in club single-season history, with his .429 on-base percentage ranking second. Despite starting the season on the IL, Edwards has picked up right where he left off in 2024. The Coconut Creek, Fla., native has hits in 14 of his first 18 games with the Jumbo Shrimp, compiling a remarkable eight multi-hit contests. In all, he is 24-for-74, slashing .324/.359/.419/.778 with five doubles, one triple, three RBIs, four walks and six runs scored.

LITTLE GUY, BIG RESULTS

Over his first 11 games in Triple-A, Javier Sanoja was just 6-for-39 (.154) at the plate. However, the 5-foot-7 Venezuelan struck out in only two plate appearances. His contact ability has manifested itself in a huge way of late; Sanoja has reached base safely in 35 of his last 40 games, notching 18 multi-hit contests. During this span, he is 57-for-158 (.358/.410/.503/.913) with 11 doubles, three triples, two home runs, 27 RBIs, 16 walks and 22 runs scored.

STARTING FROM SCRATCH

Jacksonville starting pitchers have tossed scoreless outings in five of the last 12 games. During this stretch, Jumbo Shrimp lid-lifters have ceded only 16 runs, 14 earned, on 39 hits (7.2 H/9) in 48.2 innings for a 2.59 ERA. Jacksonville starters have combined for 39 strikeouts against 18 walks during this stretch.

FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

A remarkable 48 of Jacksonville's 73 games (65.8 percent) in 2024 have been decided by three runs or fewer, including 30 of the club's last 42 contests. After beginning the year 12-3 (.750) in these narrowly-decided contests, the Jumbo Shrimp have suddenly struggled in games determined by no more than three runs; Jacksonville has lost 24 of its last 33 games decided by three runs or fewer for an overall record of 21-27 (.778) in these affairs.

GRIFFIN-DOR, WHERE DWELL THE BRAVE AT HEART

In eight games from April 26-May 5, Jacksonville outfielder Griffin Conine suffered through a 2-for-30 (.067) stretch with 12 strikeouts. In the 39 games since, however, the former Duke Blue Devil has gotten hot. Conine is 41-for-hislast-131, slashing .313/.397/.634/1.031 with nine doubles, 11 home runs, 30 RBIs, 19 walks and 26 runs scored. Among the 126 qualified hitters in the IL. Conine ranks T-11th in HR/ FB (26.9 percent). The 26-year-old has has driven in at least one run in 20 of those 39 games.

ROAD IS WHERE THE HEART IS?

Jacksonville's 14-25 (.359) home record is the worst such mark in the IL, while the club's 19-15 (.559) road record is one of only eight winning away records in the circuit this year. On the road, the Jumbo Shrimp have scored 177 runs in 34 games (5.2 per game), more than a full run better than what they average at home (second-fewest in Triple-A) 149 runs in 39 games, 3.8 per game). The Jumbo Shrimp have surrendered 196 runs (13th-most) in 39 home games (5.0 per game) compared to 150 (T-third-fewest) on the road (4.4 per game).

WALKIN' IN MEMPHIS

Jacksonville returns to Memphis for the first time since taking four-of-six from April 23-28. Since joining the International League in 2021, the Jumbo Shrimp have had a lot of success playing in the friendly confines of AutoZone Park. Since that inaugural 2021 Triple-A season, the Jumbo Shrimp are slashing .289/.356/.477/.833 with 54 home runs, 229 RBIs at AutoZone Park. Those 54 homers since 2021 are the third-most in an opposing team's ballpark, trailing Durham Bulls Athletic Park (Durham, 60) and Truist Field

ABOUT TRISTAN

-Tristan is the son of Preston and Marsha Stevens. Played his high school ball at Kickapoo High School (Mo.) under head coach Jason Howser. Started and lettered in three seasons while also earning all-conference honors. As a senior, he posted a 1.75 ERA with 55 strikeouts in 35 innings of work. In his junior year as a starter and closer, he struck out 35 batters and did not allow an earned run in 25 innings of work.

-A native of Springfield, Mo. started his collegiate baseball career at Maple Woods Junior College (Kansas City, Mo.) for a season, made five appearances while going 3-1 in 20.2 innings of work before undergoing Tommy John Surgery. In 2018, he moved up a rung, transferring to the University of Texas in Austin, Texas. As a redshirt freshman, he made two starts for the Longhorns.

-As a senior in 2021, Stevens was named a First Team All-Big 12 starting pitcher with an 11-3 record while posting a 3.31 ERA, fanning 77 hitters. Started in the Super Regional win over South Florida that sent Texas to the College World series in Omaha. Stevens took advantage of his extra year of college eligibility (COVID) and returned to Texas in 2022. The Missouri native fanned a career high eight batters against Oklahoma State on 4/30.

2024 SEASON

-Transferred to Jacksonville from Low-A Jupiter on June 22, 2024.

-Has made 6 starts in 12 appearances with Low-A Jupiter. Posts a 5-3 record with a 3.30 ERA and 1.19 WHIP in 46.1 innings of work. Struck out 39 batters while surrendering 41 hits and 17 earned runs.

2023 SEASON

-Split time between FCL Marlins and Low-A Jupiter in 2023. After making two appearances with FCL Marlins, he was promoted to the Jupiter Hammerheads on April 5.

-With Jupiter, Stevens made four starts in 11 appearances as he posted a 3-0 record with a 5.71 ERA and 1.67 WHIP. In 34.2 innings of work, he fanned 37 hitters while surrendering 47 hits and 22 earned runs.

2022 SEASON

-Stevens was signed by the Miami Marlins on July 20, 2022. Made three appearances with the FCL Marlins, tallied one save in four innings of work while striking out three batters and surrendering 3 hits.

ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES

-His brother, Ryan also played at Maple Woods JC before committing to Lipscomb University $\,$

-He was a Fundraising Assistant for the Language Stuttering Institution, a program at the University of Texas. They used philanthropic activities to collect donations and spread awareness about the cause.
