STORYLINES AND HEADLINES

DOWN TO THE WIRE: Last season, the Whitecaps took their playoffs chances down to the final pitch, but The West Michigan Whitecaps fell short of their first postseason berth since 2018 as part of a 4-1 loss to the Great Lakes Loons to end the season in front of a sellout crowd of 8,414 fans at LMCU Ballpark on September 10. The Whitecaps entered the day needing to beat the Loons and get a Fort Wayne TinCaps loss at Dayton. While the TinCaps fell in a 4-2 defeat to end their regular season, the 'Caps failed to take advantage of the opportunity. Defensive miscues plagued the 'Caps on Sunday, as of the four runs the Whitecaps allowed, just one was earned, as West Michigan committed three errors in the contest. Meanwhile, the 'Caps finished just 1-for-7 with runners in scoring position in the defeat. Great Lakes grabbed the lead in the first inning as Griffin Lockwood-Powell lifted a sacrifice fly, delivering the Loons the 1-0 lead. Meanwhile, Loons starter Jared Karros tossed four scoreless innings with three strikeouts to maintain the early advantage. 'Caps starter Jackson Jobe allowed just the one run through five innings with seven punchouts before the Loons added two insurance tallies in the sixth - featuring an RBI single from Kenneth Betancourt - before Taylor Young added a sacrifice fly in the seventh, ballooning the lead to 4-0. The Whitecaps scored in the ninth as Eliezer Alfonzo crossed the plate on a passed ball, but it was too late, as Loons closer Carlos De Los Santos collected back-to-back strikeouts to end the game and the 'Caps season, 4-1. The Whitecaps finished the season with nearly 361,000 fans coming through the gates - grossing more than any season since 2004.

GETTING BLANKED: The Whitecaps pitching staff collected a Midwest League-best 15 shutouts of their opponents this season, with the most recent one occuring on August 20 in a 5-0 win over the South Bend Cubs at LMCU Ballpark. The 'Caps also hold the Midwest League record for shutouts in a season with 27 back in 2017.

SWING FOR THE FENCES: The Whitecaps totaled 109 home runs on the season - breaking the franchise record of 101 set in 2022.

PROSPECTS APLENTY: The Whitecaps hold six of the Top 30 Detroit Tigers prospects, and are mentioned near the top right corner of this page.

Previously a Top-30 Prospect in the Detroit Tigers farm system, the 24-year-old has done little to change his prospect status. Only the improved state of the farm system has pushed him below the cut line. Burhenn played three college seasons with the Ohio State Buckeyes, compiling a career 15-8 record with 189 punchouts through 192.2 innings, earning All-Big Ten Third Team honors his Junior season with Ohio State.

LAST GAME: N/A

2023: Burhenn's 2023 campaign was spent in its entirety at West Michigan, where his strikeout totals dropped off to just 70 in 93.2 frames on the hill, but he appeared in a single-season high 24 games, making 18 starts.

2022: Burhenn spent most of 2022 at Low-A Lakeland, racking up 103 strikeouts in 78.2 innings while compiling a 3.43 ERA in 78.2 innings pitched, earning himself a spot in the Detroit Tigers Top-30 prospects at the time.

2021 (Junior): Earned All-Big Ten honors after a standout season, finishing 7-2 with a 3.81 ERA and 103 strikeouts to just 19 walks. Burhenn also enjoyed a complete game shutout in his home city of Indianapolis, allowing just one run while striking out a career-high 10 batters in a 3-1 victory over the Indiana Hoosiers on May 23, 2021.

2020 (Sophomore): Burhenn struggled with hard contact early, posting a 2-2 record with an 8.02 ERA in the COVID-shortened season. However, he maintained a walk-to-strikeout ratio of 25-to-1 (ranked third in the BIG 10) while also compiling 29 strikeouts in just four games pitched.

2019 (Freshman): Earned Big Ten All-Freshman Team after going 6-4 with a 3.96 ERA in 15 starts. Burhenn struck out 69 batters while walking only 31 through 91 innings of work before missing the Big Ten Tournament due to injury.

MORE: Son of Heather and Dave Burhenn. Has one brother, Nick. Loves hockey and enjoyed going to see games at Ohio State Ice Rink. Graduate of Lawrence North High School in Indianapolis, Indiana where he hearned First Team All-State honors his senior season. Went to school for accounting and financing.

Hamm dominated in a small sample size during the 2023 season, but it was enough to put him on the radar heading into 2024. The 21-year-old's a popular sleeper breakout pick among Tigers Minor Leaguers in advance of the season. Despite having thrown only 12 innings of pro ball, Hamm began the 2024 season in High-A.

LAST APPEARENCE: N/A

2023: Hamm started the season in college and struggled (especially in the second half), posting a 5.31 ERA in 17 games. Despite the college struggles, Hamm shined in limited pro ball work, totaling 12 scoreless innings and giving up just one unearned run on three hits while walking only one and striking out 12.

2022: Hamm put himself on the draft radar with a solid junior season at Middle Tennessee State, posting a 3.34 ERA in 16 games (5 starts). In 59.1 innings, the righty with the big curveball struck out 65 batters and allowed just 46 hits in that timespan.

2023 First-Team Conference USA

Named to Geoff Pontes (Baseball America) 2024 All-Breakout Tm:

From BA: Hamm was one of the names with the most helium during minor league spring training. The Tigers' fifth-round pick in 2023 from Middle Tennessee State, Hamm dominated on the backfields. He struck out nine of 10 batters in one notable performance. Hamm mixes four pitches in a cut-ride fastball at 92-94 mph that averages around 20 inches of induced vertical break, a changeup at 83-86 with tumble and fade, a low-80s curveball with depth and a newly developed baby sweeper. It's an interesting pitch mix and Hamm shows the ability to command his arsenal. He debuted last season following the draft and didn't allow an earned run over 12 innings of work.

From MLB Pipeline: Hard-throwing Eriq Swan was the main attraction at Middle Tennessee State's scout day last fall, but evaluators also stumbled upon Hamm, who touched 97 mph and showed a big-breaking curveball. A hot start to the season that included a one-hit shutout with 11 strikeouts against Evansville built up momentum that could have carried him into the top three rounds, but he struggled in the second half. He surpassed big leaguer Zac Curtis (sixth round, 2014) as the third-highest drafted pitcher in school history, behind only Dewon Brazelton (No. 3 overall, 2001), and Swan, who was taken just 6 picks before Hamm in 2023.

Hamm's best pitch is a 78-82 mph curveball with good depth, though there are days when he struggles to land it for strikes. His fastball sat at 91-93 mph and peaked at 96 this spring, showing good carry at times but getting hammered when he worked lower in the zone. His low-80s changeup lacks consistency as well.

Hamm's control and command fluctuated throughout his junior season, and he struggles to locate his pitches when he gets under the ball in his delivery. Though he's mostly a finished product, he looks like a three-pitch starter with a solid fastball and a plus curveball when he's on. His curve and competitiveness could make him a useful bullpen piece if he can't stick in the rotation.

LAST START: N/A

2023: Smith began his season with the Erie Seawolves and struggled - allowing nine runs through 5.2 innings before being placed on the injured list. Before his promotion to West Michigan on August 6th, Smith made two rehab appearances down in the FCL, where he tossed five scoreless innings with three strikeouts. The 23-year-old finish the year in West Mich., going 1-1 with a 3.67 ERA in 27 innings and six starts.

2022: Smith began his season with the Low-A Flying Tigers before finishing the year in West Michigan, where he posted an 8-6 record with an even 4.00 ERA and a 86-to-21 strikeout to walk ratio in 19 starts

2021: Went 2-8 with a 3.84 ERA in 16 starts in a breakout season at the University of Alabama. Struck out 113 batters in 98.1 innings on the mound.

MORE: An outstanding athlete, Smith played basketball, soccer, ran track, and was good enough to warrant Division 1-football scholarships before deciding to play baseball at the University of Alabama.
