#### FROM THE CROW'S NEST

BACK ON TRACK: The Marauders have won three of their last four games, which the team last accomplished July 13-16 at Daytona. The club looks to end a string of three consecutive series without a series win, their longest such stretch of the season; the club split with Daytona July 13-18, lost to St. Lucie 4-games-to-2 July 20-25, and split last week's series with Dunedin. Since July 16 (16 games), the Marauders have gone 5-11.

<u>WELCOME ABOARD:</u> After going 2-for-4 in his Pirates organization debut last Sunday, catcher **Abrahan Gutierrez** went 3 -for-4 in his first full game against his former team last night, with the three hits matching his season-high with three hits. The 21-year-old native of Caracas, Venezuela was acquired from the Phillies on July 30 in exchange for 2019 Marauder, LHP Braeden Ogle.

**KEEPING IT INTERESTING:** Until Friday night, seven of the Marauders' last nine wins came by margins of three or fewer runs. Bradenton, however, still owns the Low-A Southeast's second-best run differential at +52.

E-MAN, MASTER OF THE BATTER'S BOX: Endy Rodriguez has hit safely in 24 of his last 28 games and had both an 11-game hit streak and a 23-game on base streak end last week. Both were season-highs for the Dominican Republic native, and his 11-game hit streak is the longest by a Marauder this season. He currently leads the team with 71 hits (T-3rd in the league), 39 RBI (T-9th), 15 doubles (T-6th), and four triples (T-3rd), and is pacing all Marauders hitters with 19 multi-hit games and 12 multi-RBI games.

THE OPPONENT: Leading into Thursday's game, the Threshers weathered a six-day period without games to allow for testing and contact tracing after a Covid outbreak in the Phillies complex. They took two of three games from Fort Myers before the remainder of the series was cancelled in light of the outbreak. This week's series is the Marauders' first of two visits to BayCare Ballpark against the Threshers; Bradenton will return September 7-12, its second-to-last series of the season.

<u>TOP PROSPECTS:</u> The Marauders roster currently includes eight prospects in MLB Pipeline's Top 30 ranking for the Pirates organization: **Hudson Head** (#5), **Eddy Yean** (#13), **Jared Jones** (#17), **Sammy Siani** (#19), **Nick Garcia** (#21), **Endy Rodriguez** (#25), **Alexander Mojica** (#28), and **Dariel Lopez** (#29). Three of the eight (Head, Rodriguez, and Yean) came to the organization via blockbuster trades: Head and Rodriguez came from the Padres and Mets, respectively, in the three-team Joe Musgrove deal, and Yean came from Washington in the Josh Bell trade.

<u>UNDER NEW MANAGEMENT:</u> New Jersey native **Jonathan Johnston** is in his first season as Marauders manager. The U.S. Naval Academy graduate spent two seasons as a catcher in the Oakland Athletics system in 2008 and 2011 in between a collective five years in the Navy as a Surface Warfare Officer. Prior to joining the Pirates organization in 2020, he held coaching roles at UC San Diego and UNC Asheville.

MISCELLANEOUS: Bradenton pitchers' 874 strikeouts are T-9th in all of MiLB (San Jose leads with 1,005)... The Marauders own the Low-A Southeast's second-best run differential at +52 (Tampa's +221 leads all of MiLB)... Five Marauders players rank within the league's top seven in home runs: Jase Bowen and Hudson Head are T-3rd with 11 HR; Endy Rodriguez and Sammy Siani are T-6th with 8 HR, and Alexander Mojica is T-7th with 7 HR.
