FRISCO FIRES EIGHTH SHUTOUT IN 6-0 WIN:

The Frisco RoughRiders notched their second shutout win of the series against San Antonio on Saturday night, taking the series with a 6-0 win over the Missions at Nelson Wolff Stadium. Catcher David Garcia hit his fifth home run in a perfect 3-for-3 night at the plate to lead the Frisco offense. Saturday's shutout win was the second of the series for Frisco and their fourth since the start of the month of July. Since July 1st, the RoughRiders hold the best ERA of any full-season MiLB staff at a 1.21 ERA. Even further, Frisco holds the best ERA of any team since the start of the second half of the season (1.60 ERA) by a full 0.77. Frisco designated hitter **Dustin Harris** slugged his team-best 14th home run in the top of the first inning to give Frisco the early lead, as the Riders have scored first in four of the five games against the Missions this series. The series win for Frisco marks their second series win in their last three weeks, dating back to taking four-of-six games against the Arkansas Travelers to end the first half of the season. With Saturday's win, the Riders are now 10-1 at Nelson W. Wolff Municipal Stadium against the Missions this season. The Riders paced the shutout with a five-inning start from **Tim Brennan** (2-3), who threw five hitless innings before surrendering a pair of hits in the bottom of the sixth inning and exiting the game. San Antonio southpaw Ben Krauth (0-1) gave up four earned runs on six hits in his three innings against Frisco. The Riders scored first for the fourth time this series on the solo home run from Harris in the top of the first on the sixth pitch of the game. Frisco pushed two more across to take a 3-0 lead off a two-run single from second baseman Trey Hair, driving in Garcia and center fielder Josh Stowers to take the early lead. Frisco's biggest offensive inning came in the top of the fourth against Krauth, who promptly departed following Garcia's solo blast to lead off the inning. Facing Missions reliever Henry Henry, center fielder Stowers and third baseman Jax Biggers singled to put two aboard. Left fielder Kellen Strahm groundout out to first but gave enough time for Stowers to score from third, giving the Riders a 4-0 lead. On an RBI base hit from Harris, Biggers came around to score before Harris attempted to leg a single into a double and was tagged out at second to end the inning with Frisco leading, 6-0. With relief efforts from **Seth Nordlin**, **Tyler Thomas** and **Nick Starr**, Frisco pieced together another shutout from a strong bullpen effort as the three gave up no runs, hits or walks on four strikeouts to end Saturday's game.

RoughRiders starter Owen White had an incredible start last week, throwing 5.1 innings without allowing a hit while ceding just one base runner on a walk. He struck out seven before leaving with a minor left ankle injury. For his start, he won Texas League Pitcher of the Week, becoming the first RoughRiders pitcher to take home the award. After his first quality start at the Double-A level on Thursday in San Antonio, White is now 2-0 with a 1.62 ERA in his three starts with Frisco

WELCOME BACK, JACK:

Riders starting pitcher Jack Leiter was reinstated off of the Development List on Sunday before his start against San Antonio. The Rangers No. 1 prospect and the No. 17 prospect in baseball was recently selected to represent the Rangers in the Sirius XM All-Star Futures Game in Los Angeles on Saturday, July 16th. After **Cole Winn** and **Cole Ragans** were selected to play in the game last season, Leiter will be the lone Rangers player in the contest in 2022. On the season, among those with at least 48 innings pitched, Leiter is ninth in the Texas League with a 26.9 percent strikeout rate and 13th in opponent batting

MISSION POSSIBLE:

The Riders have dominated the Missions over their last two seasons. This season, they are 13-4 against San Antonio and 10-1 at Nelson Wolff Stadium, but including last season, Frisco is 26-9 against the Padres affiliate. Dating back to mid-June of 2018, the Riders are 38-17 against San Antonio in their last 55

JUST KEEP PITCHING, JUST KEEP PITCHING:

The Riders threw back-to-back shutouts on Sunday and Monday and - following a shutout on Saturday - they have tossed four in their last eight games in July. It was the first time since April of 2019 that the RoughRiders had thrown back-to-back shutouts. Until allowing the first run of the series in the eighth inning on Tuesday, the Riders set a new franchise record with 30-consecutive scoreless innings streak (24 innings in April of 2019 was the previous franchise record). Over the last eight games, the Riders have allowed just 10 earned runs (1.21 ERA, best in MiLB) and in the second half of play - in the last 11 games -Frisco has a 1.60 ERA, which is the best in all of Minor League Baseball (second is Low-A Rome, 2.39).

J.P. STANDS FOR JUST PERFORM:

Riders outfielder J.P. Martinez has been lethal at the plate this season for the Riders. After cracking his ninth home run on Friday at home, Martinez now has an active-team-high .897 OPS while leading the team in OBP (.412), runs (52), triples (5) walks (43) and stolen bases (25). His OBP is also seventh in the league while he is second in triples and third in stolen bases.

IT'S ABOUT STRAHM TIME:

Riders outfielder Kellen Strahm started off slowly, but he has started to turn his offensive game around. Since May 27th, over his last 33 games, Strahm is hitting .348 (40-for-115)/.453/.461 with four doubles, three home runs, 22 walks, 27 runs and 10 RBIs. In that stretch, Strahm has raised his average from .148 to .265 and his OPS from .528 to .750. The Eugene, Oregon native is riding an 26-game on-base streak (the longest streak on the Riders this season), in which he is hitting .327/.426/.459 with 17 walks. The streak is the longest active in Double-A. The on-base streak is also the 8th-longest streak in franchi history. Up next on the list, both Ryan Rua (2014) and Leonys Martin (2011) had 27-game on-base streaks, tying them for sixth. In 2012, Jurickson Profar had the longest streak in franchise history at 50 games.

THREE IS A MAGIC NUMBER:

Frisco has played a lot of close games this season and when scoring or allowing three runs, the Riders have seen a pretty predictable result. This season, the Riders are 4-23 when scoring three runs or fewer and 24-4 when allowing three runs or fewer

ABOUT IACK											

-Leiter was drafted in the first round (No. 2 overall) in 2021 by the Rangers out of Vanderbilt University. With the Commodores, Leiter was a unanimous First Team All-American and a finalist for both the Golden Spikes Award and the Dick Howser Trophy.

-Threw first regular-season, complete-game no-hitter to start SEC play since 1971 against No.16 South Carolina on March 20th, 2021. He walked the first batter of the game before retiring the last 27 he saw with 16 strikeouts on 124 pitches. Followed up that no-hitter with 7.0 no-hit innings in his next start (20.2 consecutive no-hit innings over three starts from March 20th - April 2nd).

-Drafted in 20th round in 2019 by NYY out of Delbarton School (NJ). Named 2019 New Jersey Gatorade POY, striking out 95 in 57 innings as a senior.

-The family lineage is strong with Jack. His father, Al, pitched in 19 MLB seasons (1987-2005), making two All-Star teams and winning both the 1993 and 1997 World Series. His uncle, Mark, played 11 seasons in the majors (1990-99; 2001) and his cousin, Mark Jr., pitched two seasons (2017-2018) with Philadelphia and Toronto. Al now works as an analyst for MLB Network.

2022 SEASON

-Leiter entered the 2022 season as the No. 17 prospect in baseball according to MLB.com. He is listed as the No.1 prospect in the Rangers organization as well.

-Leiter dazzeled in his professional debut, striking out seven over his three innings against the Arkansas Travelers on April 9th. The righty helped draw the largest crowd since 2019 at Riders Field for the debut (9,322).

-Threw the Riders first quality start of the season on May 7th against Arkansas. Leiter retired the last 15 batters he saw, allowing just two hits (one in the first and one in the second inning).

-Leiter came out of the bullpen is a "start" to finish a suspended game on May 31st (game was finished on June 1st) and recorded a career-best eight strikeouts against Wichita over 5.2 innings. The game resulted in a 3-0 win for Frisco, the Riders second shutout win of the season to that point.

-The righty allowed just one home run over his first nine outings before allowing two against Amarillo on June 7th. The two home runs were a grand slam and a two-run shot in a 7-4 loss to the Sod Poodles.

-Leiter was placed on the Development List on June 28th and was activated on July 10th before his start against San Antonio.

2021 SEASON

-After being drafted second overall in the 2021 draft, Leiter did not pitch in the minor leagues. Instead, he returned to Vanderbilt to workout, continue college and prepare for 2022. Did not finish degree, but got closer.

MORE INFO

-Leiter was high school teammates with Yankees No. 1 prospect (No. 8 in baseball) Anthony Volpe at Delbarton School (NJ).
